COVENTRY — Army Pfc. Douglas P. Fraser, 19, former of Coventry, died July 4, 1968, in Vietnam, the Department of Defense has reported.

A report from the Pentagon said Fraser's death was not a result of hostile action. He was serving with the Army Corps of Engineers at Chu Chi when he was killed. The circumstances of his death were not announced.

Pfc. Fraser was born in Portland, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Harold D. Fraser. His parents now live in North Windham. He attended Coventry High School and enlisted in the Army in October of 1967 arriving in Vietnam on April 10, 1968.

Besides his parents he leaves two brothers, John Fraser and Robert Fraser, and three sisters, Evelyn Fraser, Beth Fraser and Julie Fraser all of North Windham.

He also leaves his paternal grandparents, Mrs. Josephine Fraser of Charlestown, R.I., North Vietnam in operation for the third major enemy offensive of the North with a break into the Cordillera Range in Toland.






