Most U.S. Negroes Ignore Black Nationalists' Call

WASHINGTON (AP) — Joseph P. Kamp, Jr., director of the National Urban League, said today that most Negroes in the United States ignore the call of black nationalists to "separate and build." He said that most Negroes are interested in a "black power" movement that would give them control of their neighborhood center cities.

Some will work with police and city administrations, others collect guns and ammunition and train youngsters in karate. Some wear colorful African-style robes and jewelry, some, including James Lawson, president of Harlem's United African Nationalist, look like a conservative businessman.

It's impossible to single out even a handful of overall leaders. Every major city has several groups, and the leaders often bitterly compete with each other for control of their small centers.

A decade ago these sentiments were voted only by a handful of Negroes who stood on Harlem street corners, haranguing crowds that largely ignored them.

Bureaus show that American Negroes are still pretty much ignoring the message. More sympathy has not begun to replace integration as an ultimate goal. But the nationalist point of view is enjoying something of a resurgence, not so much because of the groups as because of the groups' actions. Black nationalists have long advocated...

Catholic Nun Serves As Delegate to UN

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (AP) — She was talking with other delegates from the world's leading organizations such as the United Nations.

She witnesses the often controversial drive by young priests and nuns—she counts herself among them—to speak out on individual matters of conscience even in the face of opposition from established authority.

"Very often there is going to be confusion over this," she said, "but I respect the right of the Church to speak for itself and I reserve the right to speak for myself. We must learn to look at priests and nuns as private citizens and as private citizens they are entitled to personal convictions."

But she deplores dissent through violence, and says priests who helped burn draft records recently at selective service offices in Milwaukee acted out of line.

Firm Control Planned for Nixon Visit

A tight security, especially for the press, has been instituted for Richard Nixon's visit to Hartford Friday night.

Nixon will speak shortly after 7 p.m. at the State Armory. No press conference has been scheduled, before or after the speech.

The news media will be furnished with special credentials after applying the Republican State Committee with the names, addresses, and date of birth of each applicant, in addition to naming the newspaper, wire service, and radio or TV station that each represents.

The credentials will be distributed in advance at Republican headquarters.

However, the gathering which starts at 7 a.m. and is to be climaxed with Nixon's speech, will be open to the public, on a first-come, first-served basis, with no tickets required. The Armory holds about 6,000 persons. Local Republicans are expected to charter two or three buses for their strike.

Eight hours after the 1,300 Army troops started their march from the campus, the student strike council met and drew up a statement saying they would stick to their original demands for settlement of their strike.

Coventry Town Gets Advice on Changeover

Two men from the Connecticut Public Expenditures Council attended a meeting of the transition committee last night to discuss hiring procedures of a city manager and other questions relating to Coventry's switchover to a new form of government next November.

Hubert Stone, executive director of the PEC, and Richard Lafferty, director of municipal consulting services, met with the eight-member committee, which is now meeting on a regular basis.

Transition committee chairman Harold Crane, who is chairman also of the committee that drafted the town charter, adopted by voters one year ago, but not effective until next year. The transition committee was formed to discuss and formulate ways of smoothing the changeover, which will do away with the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance. In their place will be a seven-member town council and a town manager, or "chief administrator," as the charter refers to it.
