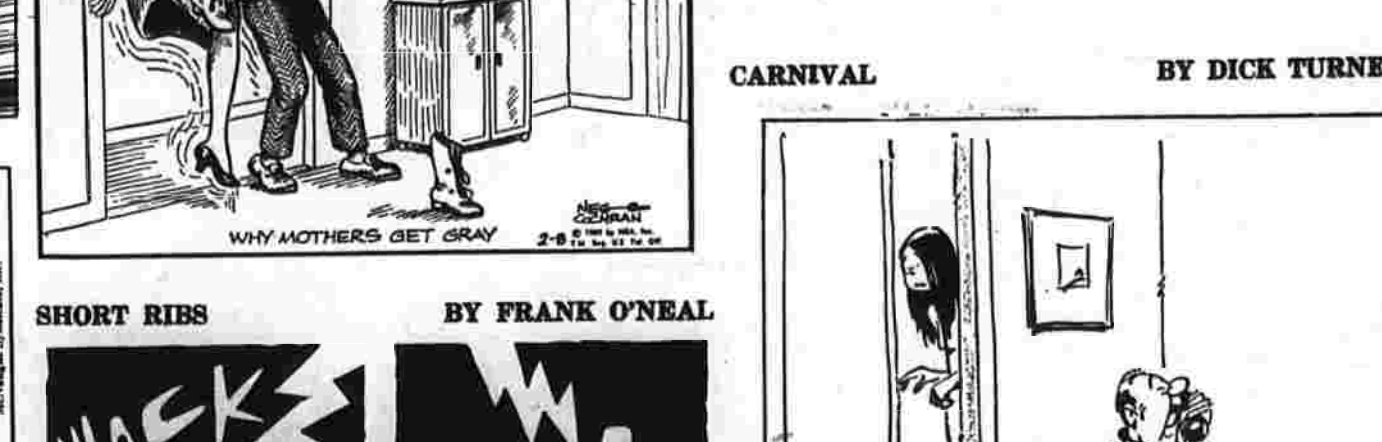
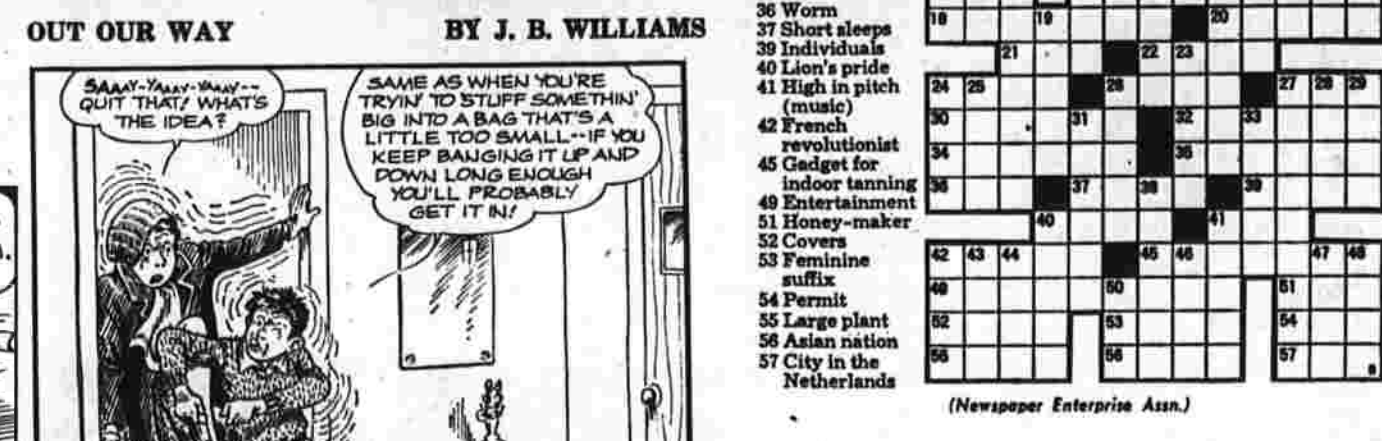

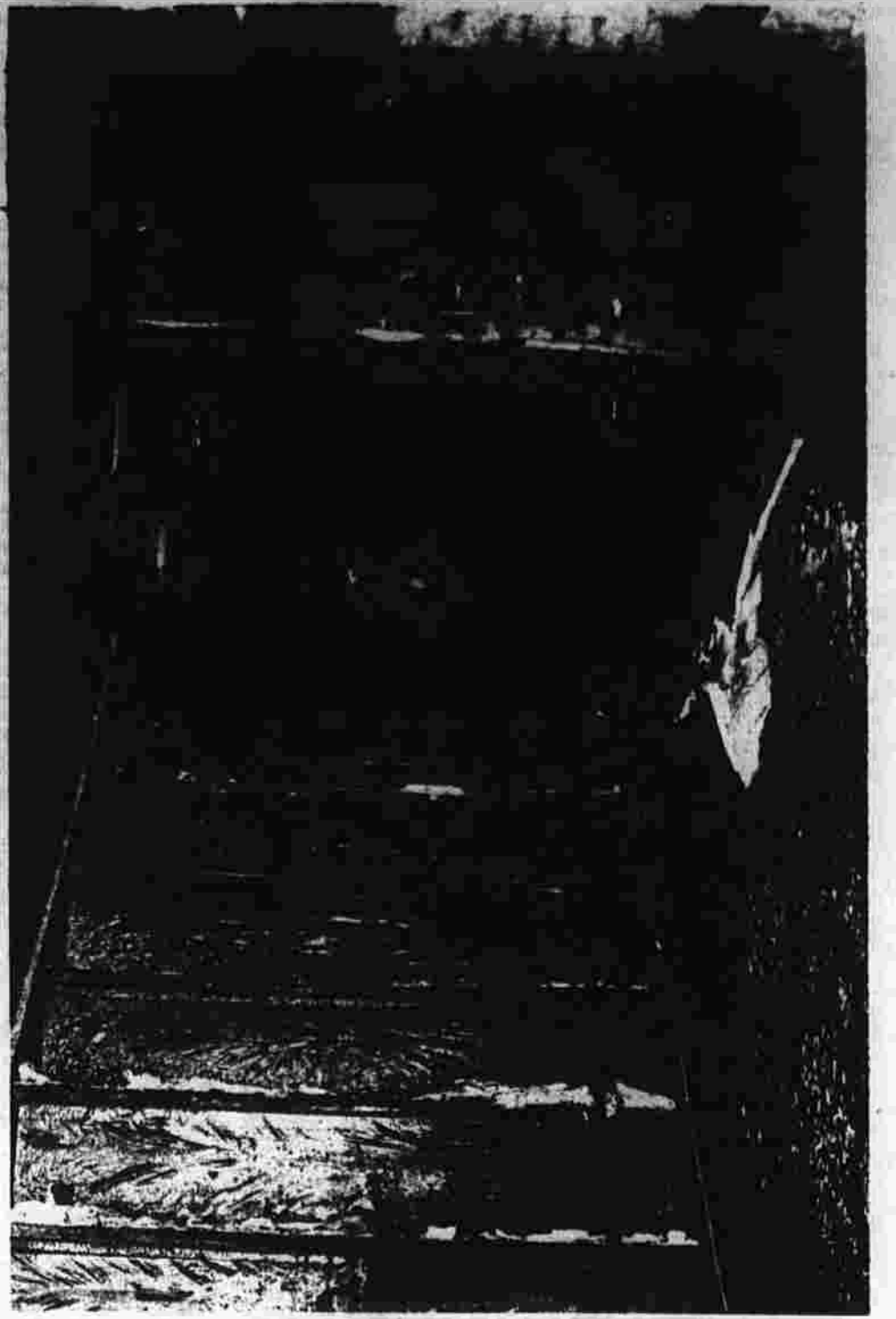

Diana Rigg has no "best side" as far as facial features are concerned, but she has two very different personality profiles—one, classical; the other, modern, provocative, lively and, in mod British, "very gear," as exemplified by her recent television portrayal of Emma Peel in "The Avengers."

The classical actress, of a stature that makes it difficult to believe that she could be the same judo-expert detective who romped through the Emma Peel portrayal, has had wide experience with the famed Royal Shakespeare Company. It is this Diana Rigg who plays Helena in the company's production of "A Midsummer Night's Dream" Sunday 9-11:15 p.m. on CBS.

Miss Rigg joined the Royal Shakespeare Company (then the Shakespeare Memorial Theatre Company) at Stratford-on-Avon in 1959. One of her greatest triumphs was in her present role of Helena in the 1962 production of the Shakespeare comedy.

As a member of the RSC, she was seen in the New York stage production of "King Lear." American television viewers also saw her in "The Comedy of Errors," produced in England by the BBC.

Miss Rigg is neither an op-art symbol nor a grande dame of the classical theater. Her clothes tastes run to simplicity, and she has the directness of her Yorkshire upbringing, the majesty and independence of Britannia and the Statue of Liberty rolled into one, and a witty sense of humor.

The chestnut-haired actress was born in Doncaster, Yorkshire, England, but spent part of her early life in India where her father was with the Indian Government Service.

'Specials' Shatter 'Habit Viewing'

America's great love affair with television that led in an "average home" to viewing programs more than five hours a day used to be explained by citing two factors.

The first was "habit viewing," meaning that the same programs could be expected to appear, regularly, at a set time on a given day.

The second was a national hunger to have a commonplace existence enlivened by the "substitute sociability" provided by the bright, attractive and amusing people across the living room.

The explanations stood up well while TV receivers grew to about 60 million in U.S. homes, and American consumers invested more than 20 billion dollars in TV sets.

Recent TV seasons, however, have shattered both explanations for TV watchings.

Feature motion pictures seven nights a week and "specials" that appear 300 times a year tend to destroy "habit" viewing and interrupt the regularity of the "substitute sociability" visits.

The fluctuations of a Tuesday night schedule offer a good example of the changed pattern in programming.

Only the family that checks the printed listings can be certain that a Red Skelton or a Doris Day or a Dinah Shore ("Julia") Carroll will be available for a "sociability" visit.

The regularity with which personality programs are pre-empted for specials also furnishes a clue to a program's longevity.

Seldom pre-empted are a Red Skelton (currently in 10th place in the ratings) or a "Julia" (ninth place). But "Jerry Lewis Show" (in 58th place with a 15.4 rating) is often replaced by a "special."

A special kind of frustration greets the "reality" viewer (the viewer interested in documentaries and news) at 10 p.m. Tuesdays, on CBS.

Twice a month, he will find

the bright, brisk "60 Minutes" Mod Squad" but the figures continue downward the rest of the evening.

Final elements in the Tuesday night TV jumble are the schedule maker's devices called "limitation" and "counter-programming."

On another Tuesday, however, one may find a "CBS News Special" such as last week's interview of Eric Hoffer by Eric Sevareid.

Or, as a final possibility in this hour, a viewer may find the hour split into two halves. One half will contain the network's "Who, What, When, Why, Where". The other 30 minutes will be filled by a locally produced documentary.

Habit viewing? Impossible. One attempt to set up viewer habits was the scheduling of a block, from 7:30 p.m. to 11 p.m., of similar programs. Situation comedies, for example, used to take up an entire evening. But no more.

ABC-TV's Tuesday night variation has been to book crime programs — "The Mod Squad," "It Takes a Thief" and "NYPD" — from 7:30 to 10 p.m.

A quick switch, however, comes at 10 p.m. with a "book" musical comedy called "That's Life." In most audience studies, good ratings are won by "The

Handsome Glen Campbell looks a decade younger than his 30 years. His two big recording hits, "By the Time I Get to Phoenix" and "Gentle on My Mind," made him a pop star. But he had been an anonymous

success before that as a well-paid studio musician. One year he played 538 record dates.

Recently he made his movie debut, costarring with John Wayne in "True Grit."

"I don't know if I am acting," he says. "The part was not that heavy. I'd trot along on a horse and say 'Yes' to Duke Wayne. Back home in Arkansas, I used to go pick cotton to get enough money to go see Duke's latest picture. He was my favorite. When I met him, I felt just like a fan asking for his autograph. And I did, I'm Joe Idol anyway."

Memorial Theatre Company as a walk-on player.

Her biggest break came when at two days' notice she took over the lead in "The Devils" with such success that she was signed to a five-year contract. For the next five years, she worked almost exclusively in the classics—in Shakespeare and in such productions as "Ondine," "Beckett" and "The Physicists."

Her greatest acclaim came for her portrayal of Cordelia opposite Paul Scofield in "King Lear." She cast aside the traditional heroine portrayal to turn Cordelia into a resolute young Amazon.

Miss Rigg toured Europe and America and played before the British Royal Family in a special command performance of "The Comedy of Errors" at Windsor Castle. She showed every indication of devoting herself to the classical theater until she decided to seek wider fame in television and films. Nevertheless, she has returned to the Royal Shakespeare Company for further productions.

When talking about her apparently contradictory career, the actress points out that the term "classical actress" is often misconstrued. It doesn't necessarily mean heavy drama. Some of Shakespeare's greatest plays were comedies. These provide scope for the talents of a comedienne, and much of Miss Rigg's Shakespearean work has been in comedy.

Imitation means matching the type of program scheduled by the biggest audience winner. Thus, the comedy of "Julia" is placed opposite the comedy of Red Skeleton. (A peculiar result is that both shows do well.)

But most of Tuesday night's schedule stems from counter-or opposite — programming. A Jerry Lewis is opposite a Western called "Lancer" and cop-'n-robbers show for the young opposite "The Mod Squad."

This splits the audience three ways and, in this instance, "The Mod Squad" has been the winner.

None of the later programs do very well. As noted above, the movie audience swells or shrinks with the attractiveness of the film. "That's Life" at 10 p.m., ABC is a loser and, in rating terms, so is the triple variation of news programs at 10 on CBS.

Perhaps the biggest virtue of Tuesday, then, is that most of the viewers turn off the set sooner and get to sleep a little earlier than usual.
