Economic Profile of a Growing Area

Tolland County is where the action is, and the heart of Tolland reflects this action in its growth, according to the recently released 1967-page Economic Profile of the state.

Tolland County Outstrips Others

The action is growth with its accompanying benefits and problems. Construction activity is proceeding at a heavy rate, and considerably from 1967. Tolland's statistics lead the state in almost every example given in the study prepared by

the Hartford National Bank and Trust Co. The study is used by state and local officials. Tolland County is growing at a rate of 10.4 per cent. It also tops the state's other 16 towns in the percentage increase of employment, up 77.4 per cent from 1960 to 1967. The state average growth rate is 15.1 per cent. Tolland County itself outstrips the other seven counties in growth statistics, placing first across the board. If present trends continue, the county will move out of its position as the second smallest county in the state and surpass Middlesex County which is growing at a much slower rate.

Tolland County, credited with 92,000 people as of 1967, experienced a 9.4 per cent increase in population between 1960 and 1967. The state average growth rate is 15.1 per cent. Tolland County itself outstrips the other seven counties in growth statistics, placing first across the board. If present trends continue, the county will move out of its position as the second smallest county in the state and surpass Middlesex County which is growing at a much slower rate.

On the statewide level, the average increase in manufacturing jobs was 26.8 and 17.9 in manufacturing employment. Although statistics were not given for towns with less than three industries, manufacturing payrolls in Tolland County more than doubled, experiencing a 109.9 per cent increase compared to the state average of 59.4 per cent. Retail sales also boomed between 1960 and 1967 with a 110.9 per cent increase in re-

Hebron

Hebron experienced the second highest county population increase of 44.4 per cent, from 1,900 in 1960 to 2,800 in 1967. The school age population increased by 88.4 per cent, also the second highest increase in the county from 878 in 1960 to 1,654 in 1967.

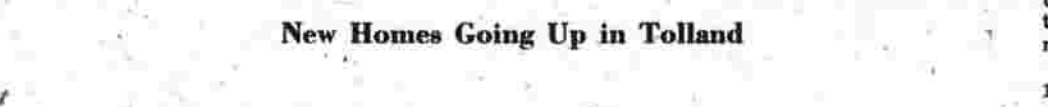

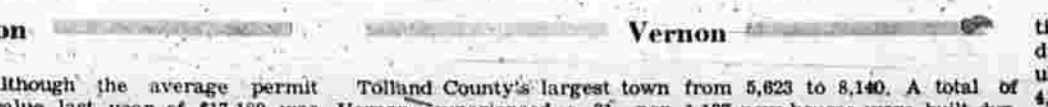

U.S. Giving South Viet 300' Copters

WASHINGTON (AP) - The United States will give South Vietnam about 300 modern helicopters as part of a plan to prepare Saigon's army and air force to stand on their own feet, an American military source said today.

The United States also will train more Vietnamese to fly and maintain the helicopters. The decision to provide the helicopters was made by the Johnson administration, but it is expected to be carried forward by President Nixon.

Some American officials feel that unless the United States moves to furnish the South Vietnamese with sufficient helicopters of their own, the U.S. effort will be unable to range much beyond the border.

The South Vietnamese air force, which operates only four helicopters, has about 70 old-fashioned Sikorsky HO4S.

Officials are not yet certain how many more Vietnamese pilots will be trained. There are some 100 new flying instructors in Vietnam.

The United States also is furnishing South Vietnamese armor, trucks, motorcycles, radios and other equipment.

NEW YORK (AP) — New York is a great place to visit — unless you have to visit it five times a week via the Long Island Rail Road.
As railroads go, the Long Island is something special. Only in a minor portion of its revenue comes from freight, and each day on its 24 miles of track it hauls a quarter of a million commuters.
You have to look behind such figures, however, to get the big picture.
Long Island passengers, dubbed "Dashing Dams" by the railroad's publicity office, are not dashing that fast these days. They have slowed down considerably since the road pulled out of bankruptcy two years ago through its sale by the Pennsylvania Railroad to the state of New York for \$80 million.
In bankruptcy and under the supervision of a hot railroad named Thomas H. Goodfellow, the Long Island spruced up the morale of passengers and crews. Trains seemed to run more smoothly, demands were met. Sixteen a month? That's more than I used to pay although I'm by joining one of those car pools that keep forming and breaking up. But then, how would I read my paper, or make new friends, or kibitz bridge games, or order a Scotch whisky in the bar car? It's hard to think like that in bumper-to-bumper traffic.
Then the Metropolitan Transportation Authority took over under Dr. William J. Ronan. He figured he would have remaining problems straightened out in a year or two. But some of his moves backfired.
New trains ordered are not yet in service. Maintenance was cut on old trains, and union men walked out because they said the trains weren't safe. Passengers complained they were dirty and decrepit. 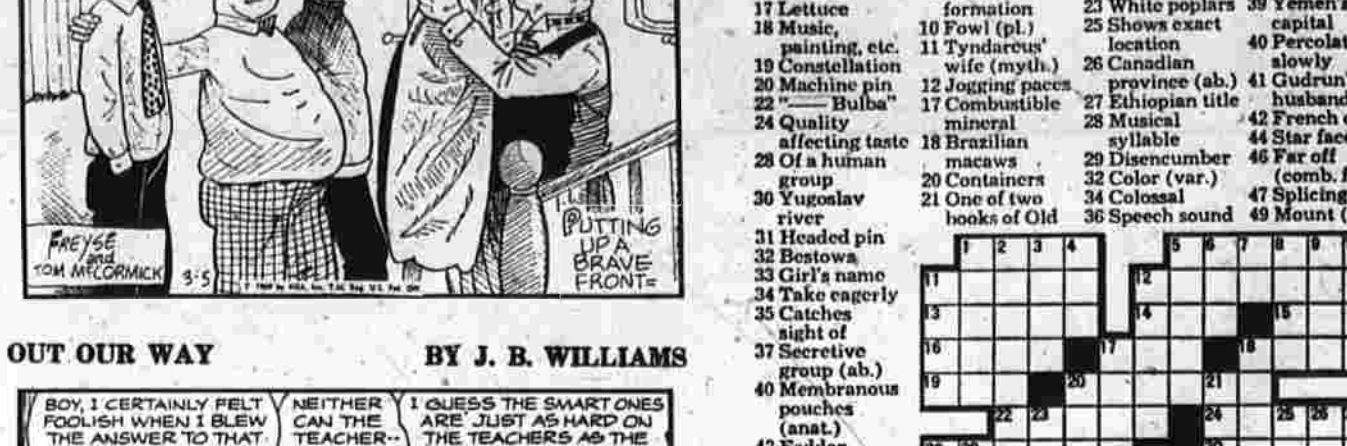
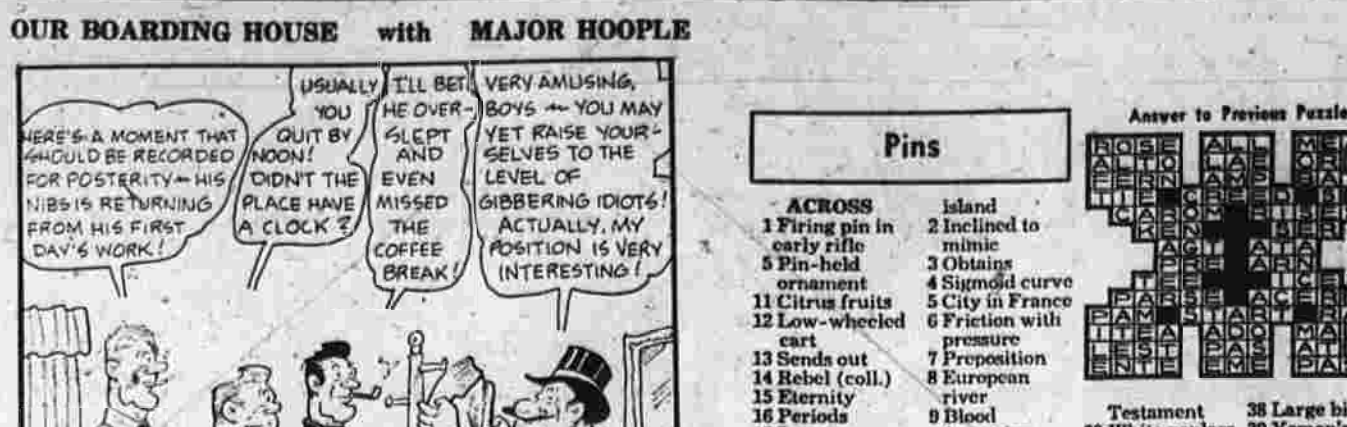
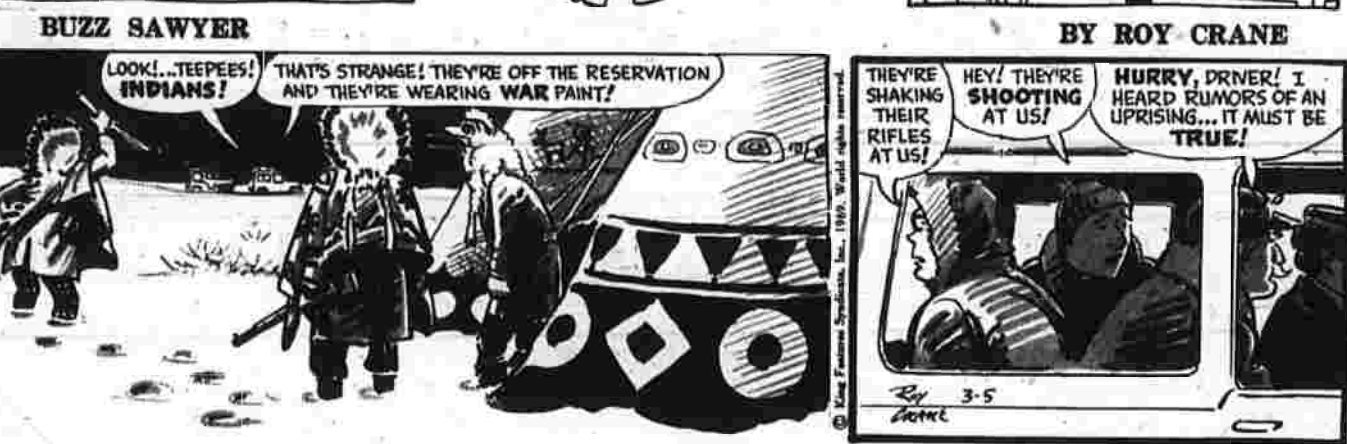
