Vernon Mini-Filibuster Cuts Off Vote On Reducing Education Budget

Action was delayed last night on a motion asking the Board of Education to cut its proposed budget by \$200,000, when Board of Representative member Albert Brookes filibustered until 10:30.

The meeting was called by the Board of Representatives in an effort to determine if the proposed \$2.1 million education budget could be cut.

The motion to cut was made by the Board of Representatives member George Ristey at about one minute before 11 p.m. for both boards. It was seconded by Peter Humphrey "for discussion purposes."

Brookes then said, "It is discussed for one minute. It will be carried over and I'll be back here next week and I'll have it done."

He sat the meeting promptly at 10:30. Only seven members of the board were at the meeting and seven constituencies quorum for the 12-member board.

Prior to Ristey making the motion, the two boards had discussed the budget for the past three hours. At the end of the discussion Brookes referred to the fact that the Board of Representatives had not passed a motion to cut the education budget by \$200,000, made by Ristey at its last meeting. He then asked the education board to say why it could not do it.

Mrs. Marie Herbet, chairman of the education budget committee, proceeded to explain why the budget had increased some \$1 million over the year before.

Each member of the boards was given a minute to state his report and breakdown of the budget. Attention was called to the fact that the \$200,000 cut which did not appear in the current budget account for the increase for the coming year.

"Accounting for the largest amount of the increase is the new 20-room elementary school," Mrs. Herbet said. It will cost \$242,222 just to open the doors.

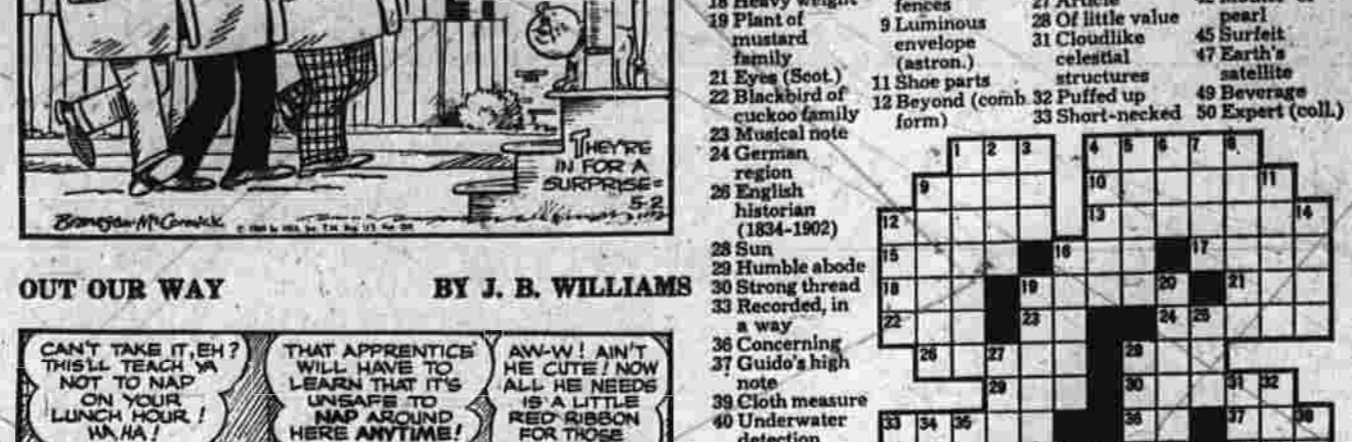

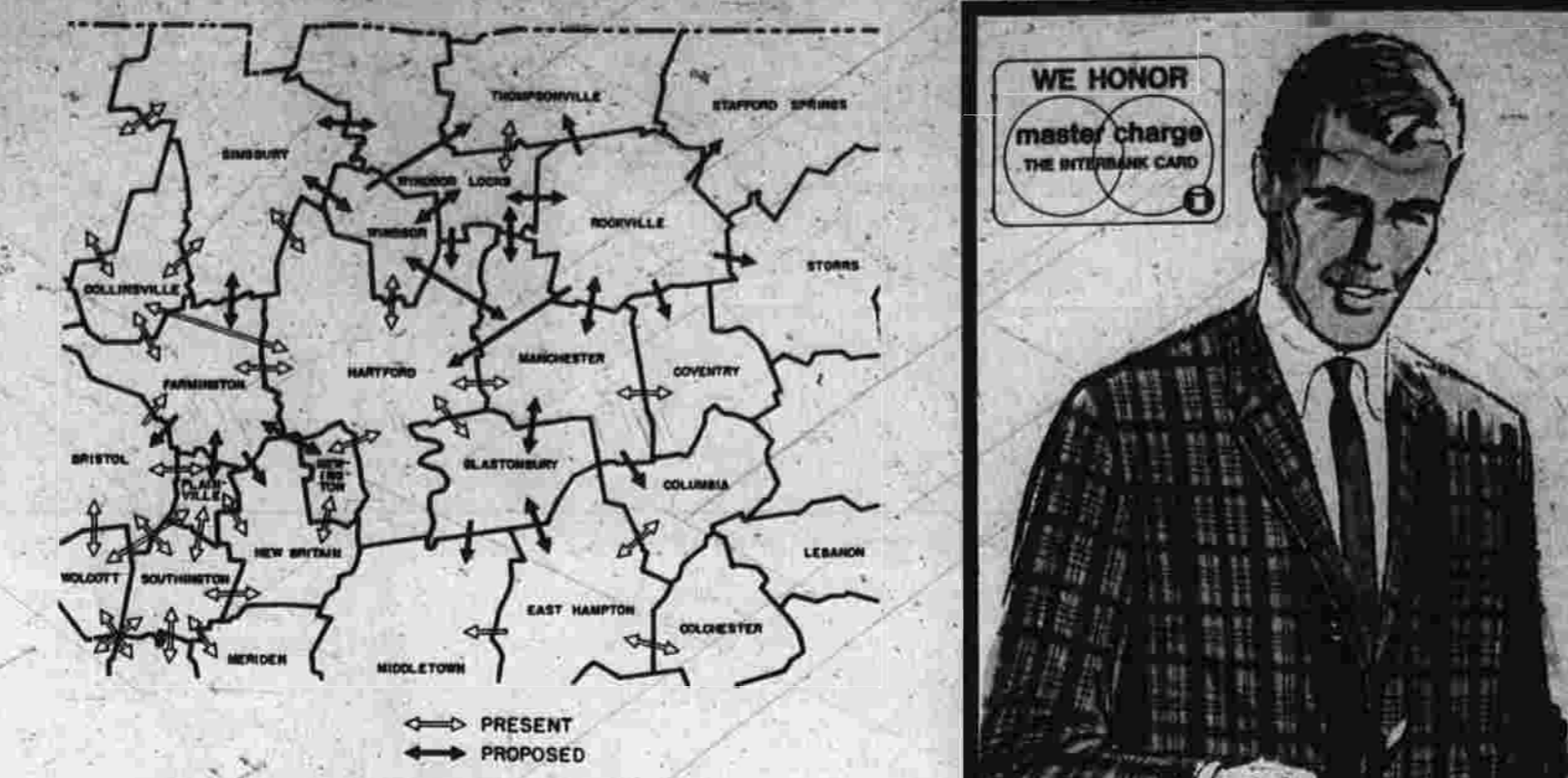
