Crabs Invade Island

BARRANQUILLA, Colombia (AP)—An invasion of thousands of crabs has forced authorities of the small island of Balsamano to take emergency measures.

"It is a frightening spectacle," said one official. "There are crabs on the houses, in the beds and even in the trees."

Estimates were that at least 10,000 crabs made up the silent invasion which, among other things, threatened to ruin the island's tourism.

Hijacker Identified As Panther

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—The FBI has identified the tall Negro who hijacked an Oakland-New York jetliner to its way last Tuesday as Willie Lee Brown, a former Black Panther captain who would have gone on trial here Monday on charges of assault with a deadly weapon.

The Black Panthers have branded Brown as an infiltrator and agent provocateur.

FBI special agent-in-charge Charles W. Bates announced Friday that Brown had been arrested in Las Vegas, Nev., for Brent on charges of air piracy and carrying a weapon aboard an aircraft.

The hijacking of the Trans World Airlines plane occurred over Nevada. A man forced the airplane, carrying 80 passengers and a crew of seven, to fly to Havana on the longest hijack flight reported thus far.

The plane and all aboard, except Brown, reached New York safely the same day.

Bates said descriptions of the hijacker by his victims match those of Brown, a 39-year-old native of Franklin, La., who was involved in a Panther gun battle with police here last Nov. 18.

Charles said Brown was arrested after a San Francisco filing station holding and a gun battle with police near the Hill of Justice. Three policemen were wounded.

Court Aides Says Killian

HARTFORD, Conn. (AP)—The bill to amend the state constitution is alive and well and should be sent to the governor's office, says Atty. Gen. Robert K. Killian.

Killian had been asked for a ruling on the status of the bill, which was recalled by the state after being passed by both chambers of the legislature.

The measure will reduce the number of ball bond commissioners in the smaller Circuit Courts.

Senate Majority Leader Edward L. Marcus, who had introduced the recall of the bill, was of the opinion that it was dead, since it had been put back on the Senate calendar and remained there without further action on the closing day of the regular legislative session.

But Killian said Friday that the recall action was not enough to kill the bill.

"Memoranda as the bill was not altered or totally rejected by a concurrent vote of the two houses," said Killian in a letter to Secretary of State Ellis T. Orsano. "It is our opinion that the bill is still in effect."

The navy gave no reason for this action. Reports received in Washington said the four boats—Royal Pacific, Neptune, Bold Venture and Markham—were damaged and that no fines had been imposed.

U.S. diplomats were said to have strongly protested the incident to Ecuadorian officials.

Recent fishing boat seizures have stemmed from a dispute over territorial limits in the Pacific off the coast of South America. Ecuador, Peru and Chile claim their boundaries extend 200 miles offshore, but the United States, like most other maritime nations, recognizes only a 12-mile limit.

Earlier this year, Peru seized four U.S. fishing boats and leveled stiff fines against their skipper.

The U.S. State Department has called for a four-nation conference to settle the dispute and some congressmen have demanded that the United States retaliate for the seizures.

First reports of the seizure Friday said that an Ecuadorian fishing boat had fired on some of the crew. Rep. Thomas M. Pelly, D-Wash., said later a dozen boats were seized.

It was also reported that three Japanese fishing boats were boarded by Ecuadorian naval officials Friday and Pelly's report might have reflected those seizures.

Herrmann was hit in the chest, chewing tobacco and collapsed, falling backward to the ground. It was several minutes before he could get up and be helped off the field and out of the game.

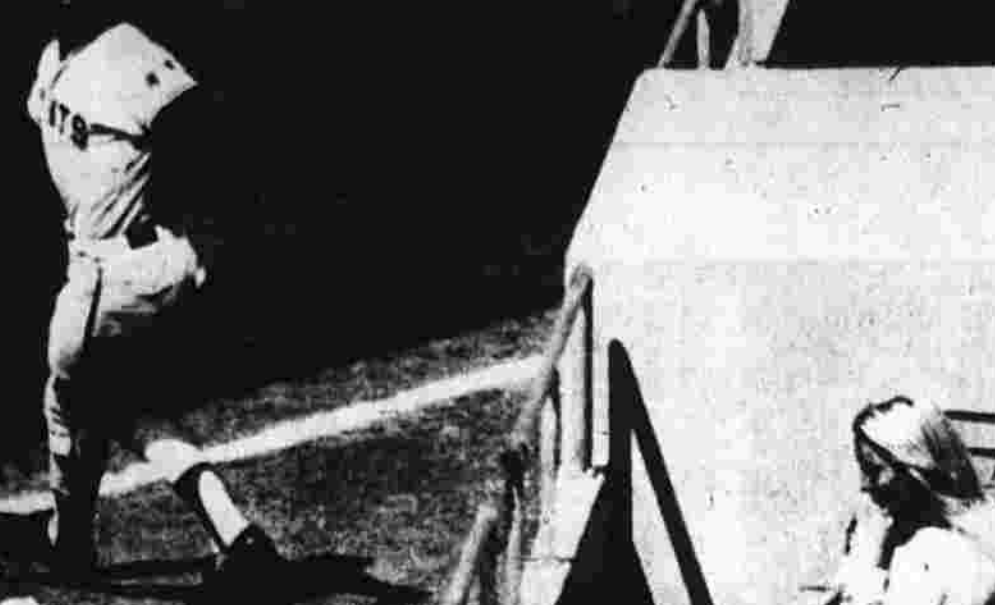

Channel 18 Gets License

HARTFORD, Conn. (AP) — WHCT-TV (Channel 18) has received conditional renewal of its license by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) until April 1, 1972.

The independent station is owned and operated by RKO General, Inc.

A commission spokesman said the renewal is subject to settlement of a federal civil action against RKO General and to FCC action on RKO General's bid for renewal of the license of KTLV-TV, Los Angeles.

The civil suit claims that RKO General "conspired to force suppliers from which defendants (RKO General and others) buy products to purchase products and services from defendants."

It is also alleged that RKO General violated the Sherman Antitrust Act through reciprocal purchasing arrangements, partly involving advertising time sales over RKO facilities.

George Cyr, WHCT-TV general manager, noted that the license renewal does not mean construction of a multimillion dollar building for the station in the Trumbull Street renewal area here will begin immediately.
