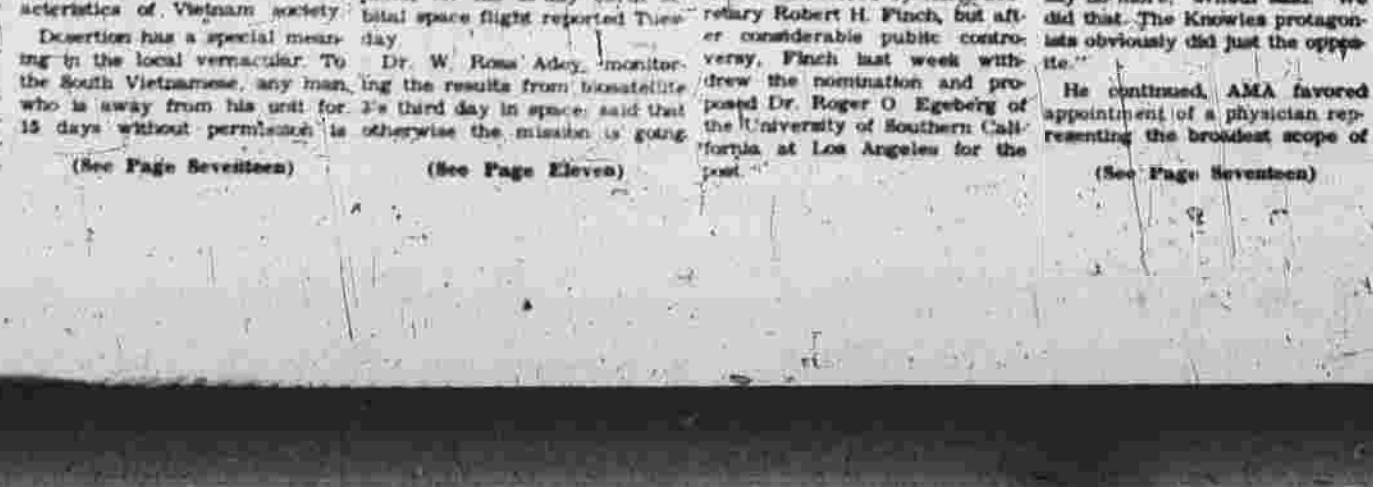

Tolland County Thitfaul Raps Stevenson For Legislative Criticism

Democratic Town Chairman Charles Thitfaul today warned that his Republican counterpart Russell Stevenson to "clean up his own backyard before trying to play a role in state politics."

Replying to Stevenson's charges leveled earlier this week against Gov. John Dempsey and the Democratic-controlled legislature, Thitfaul termed the actions "a law tactic on behalf of the Republican party."

Thitfaul related details of a meeting held last week between the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance which he attended.

Noting that Stevenson was absent, Thitfaul stated, "had he been there he would have found out that First Selectman was VB, a Republican, had permitted 15 different department heads of the town of Tolland to overstep their budgets."

When the president of the Tolland Volunteers Ambulance Association was asked why his budget was over, Thitfaul said it was all right to do so.

The Democrat leader stated that the head of the town defense was questioned about his overdrawn budget.

Stamps In the News

For those who like adventure and exciting outdoor scenes as illustrations, the new 6-cent U.S. stamp honoring John Wesley Powell, intrepid explorer and geologist, is a gem.

The stamp, which will be available on Aug. 1, will be received. The horizontal stamp shows three small boats braving the turbulent Colorado River.

At the tiller of the lead boat stands Powell guiding two oarsmen. His right arm, of which he lost at the Battle of Bull Run, is extended to warn of a hazard ahead.

The new stamp will commemorate the 100th anniversary of Powell's expedition down the Green and Colorado Rivers—a perilous 1,000-mile, 4-month journey.

Following this heroic event, Powell's fame continued and is now regarded as the father of the U.S. Geological Survey.

The Bureau of American Geographical Names stated: "The expedition of the Smithsonian Institution, which was led by Powell, is now regarded as the father of the U.S. Geological Survey."

HAD BREAK IN EMBERS STUMPS MOST EXPERTS

The bad break in the stumps of most of the experts who encountered it during a national tournament. The situation looks fairly easy when you see it in print because all four hands are visible, but most players find such hands more difficult in actual play.

South dealer:
North-South vulnerable.
Opening lead—Five of Diamonds.

New York expert Leonard B. Harmon was one of the few experts who had what it takes to make a slam on the hand shown today—namely, an ambitious partner and real skill of his own.

Harmon saw the first trick with the ace of diamonds, drew three rounds of trumps, and lost a finesse to the king of clubs. East bravely returned a diamond, forcing dummy to ruff.

This was where most players went wrong. They led a club to the jack, discovering the bad break too late. Now only the king of spades remained as an entry to dummy. The long clubs could be established, but they could not be cashed.

Measure for Measure
Harmon saw a way to guard himself against four clubs in the East hand. Instead of leading a club to the jack, he led out dummy's ace of clubs, overruling his own jack.

West's discard revealed the club break. Harmon therefore led the nine of clubs from dummy, offering out East's ten. He could then get back to dummy with the king of spades to lead the eight of clubs and then the rest of the good clubs.

Harmon's plan was likewise sure to work if the clubs broke about four clubs in the West hand, but you can't always have perfect accuracy.

Daily Question
Partner opens with one diamond, and the next player passes. You hold: ♠ spades, 7-5; ♥ hearts, 10-9-7; ♦ diamonds, 9-8-7-4; ♣ clubs, K-10-8-6.

Answer: Bid two diamonds. You have 5 points in high cards, 1 point for the doubleton, and 1 extra point for the queen of partner's bid suit. The total is just barely enough for a raise.

Scatter Housing Units, Chicago Authority Told

CHICAGO (AP) — A federal judge has ordered the Chicago Housing Authority to scatter 75 new public housing units in predominantly white areas.

Judge Richard B. Austin of the U.S. District Court issued the directive Tuesday to implement a ruling by a suit in February.

The decree specified that three housing units must be constructed in a Negro area for every one in a white area of the city.

The decree also said one third of the units could be built outside the city provided some of the occupants had been Chicago residents.

Charles Swibel, director of the CHA, termed the directive "severely restrictive." He said he will appeal it.

Jay Miller, state executive director of the American Civil Liberties Union, predicted the order would lead to "institutional racism."

The CHA is a nonprofit municipal corporation which deals with city, state and federal governments. At present, a spokesman in the news conference said within all its activities are permitted to build outside the city through contracts with

Through the night, the launch crew pumped tons of supercol liquid hydrogen and liquid oxygen into the external tanks of the Saturn 5 rocket while experts monitored systems in the moon mission's two spacecraft. One is the command ship and the lunar module, the spindly vehicle which will support two men to the surface of the moon on July 20.

Leak-checking aimed for a mid-morning to conclude a countdown test that began last Friday.

Once the liftoff simulation has been achieved, the fuels will be drained from the 36-story-tall rocket and the count set back to the six-hour mark. It will be restarted Thursday and the three astronauts will enter the command ship to participate in the final hours just as they will on launch day.

Successful completion of these tests will clear the way for the start of the real countdown July 16, with the actual liftoff set for 9:31 a.m. EDT July 16.

In preparation for Thursday's test, astronaut Neil Armstrong, Edwin E. Aldrin Jr. and several hours' practice in the command ship trainer.

The trio underwent the second of three major preflight physical examinations Monday. The third is scheduled five days before launch.

After Monday's physical, Dr. Charles A. Berry, the astronaut's chief medical officer, reported: "The crew appears to be in excellent physical shape. They look amazingly relaxed as of today."

BOSTON (AP) — A body of Protestants whose roots go back to the nation's beginnings wants President Nixon to grant amnesty to young men who have been punished or driven into the Vietnam war.

The United Church of Christ, at its policy-making assembly Tuesday night, urged "in the name of Christian love" a pardon for those imprisoned, indicted or caused to flee the country in resistance to service in Vietnam.

This has happened to an unknown number of young Americans because of the moral ambiguity of our nation's Vietnam policy," the church said in a statement adopted by delegates.

A general amnesty, the church said, would be "in the interests of reconciliation and the healing of wounds, but the sake of our freedom and to show our respect for conscience."

The two-million-member church said, "The reputation of the United States as a strong and confident democracy would be enhanced by amnesty."

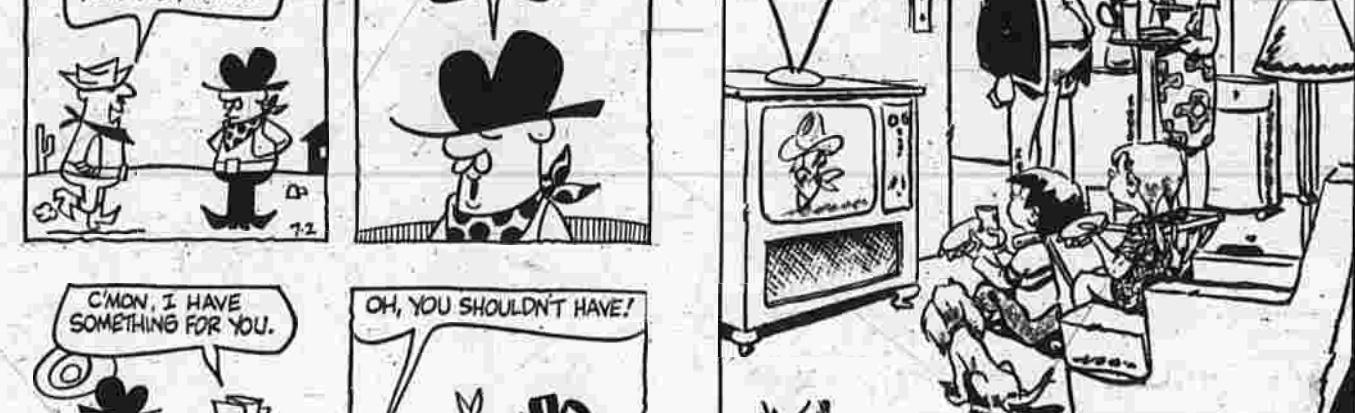
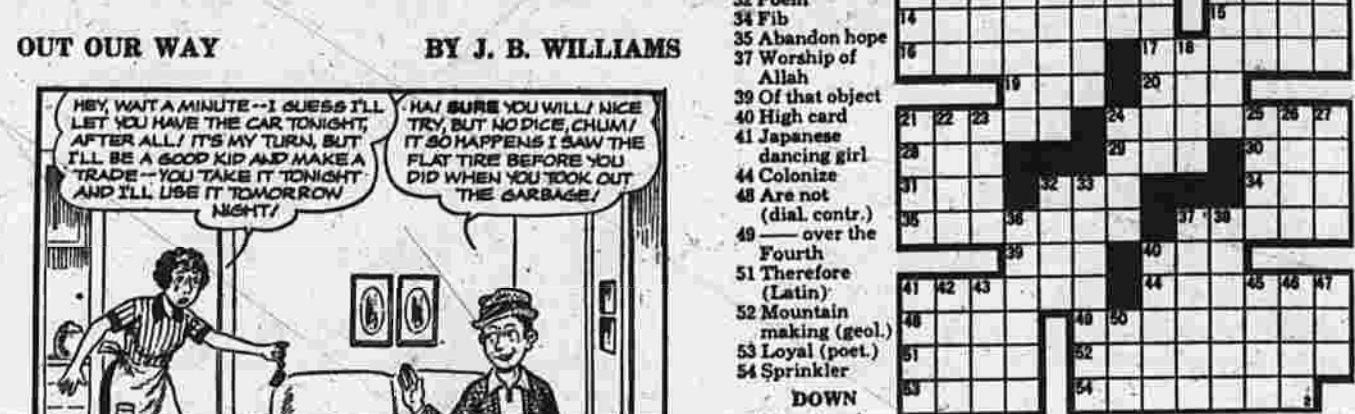

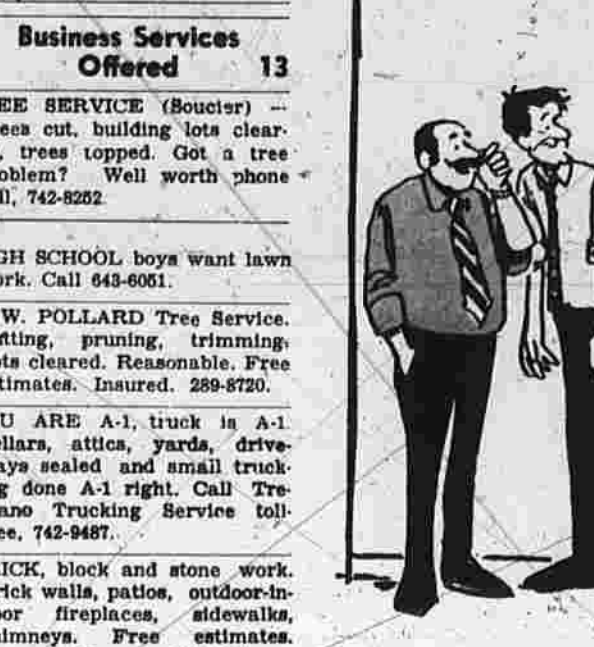
