Pfizer, Six Other Firms Face Drug Monopoly Charge

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Nixon administration, trying to "crumble" to adjust to revised patent law, the State Welfare Dept. also demanded that Pfizer, six other firms and all seven firms could sell it in dosage form.

The complaint also asked the court to cancel the Pfizer patent and prohibit the firm from collecting royalties on tetracycline.

An antitrust task force appointed by former President Lyndon B. Johnson recommended last year the government attack Pfizer prices by challenging patent abuses.

Since taking office, the Nixon administration's antitrust chief, Asst. Atty. Gen. Richard W. McClaren, has taken the task force advice and directed probes of several licensing arrangements.

The tetracycline suit, involving a product with annual sales of well over \$100 million, followed a complaint last week against Ciba Corp. and CPC International Inc., challenging restrictive licensing agreements on drugs known as benzodiazepines, which are used as diuretics and antihypertensives.

Sales of the drugs total more than \$3 billion annually. Responding to the latest government action, the Pfizer Co. labeled the suit "outrageous" and claimed it had obtained the tetracycline patent "in good faith."

The other firms did not comment immediately on the charges.

State's New Law Cuts Aid to 88

As the first step in its "re-orientation" to revised welfare law, the State Welfare Dept. has cut off Aid to Families and Dependent Children payments to 88 families and referred them to local agencies.

In addition, the department will review the cases of about 500 other families with 19 and 20-year-old youngsters in school.

Honduras Strikes, Truce Debated

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras (AP) — Honduras announced today that it had struck into northern El Salvador today, capturing both sides in the Central American war was bagged over the conditions for a cease-fire.

The announcement said the Honduran forces had thrust into an area near Polesera about five miles inside El Salvador, and that the enemy troops were abandoning their arms and fleeing.

The Hondurans claimed to have captured tanks and heavy artillery. The government announced that Honduran forces dominated the area while other ground troops had moved into Honduras' southern front.

El Salvador's ground forces have thrust about 30 miles into the city of Naonome, 75 miles from the capital, San Salvador. A thrust by the Hondurans into the Polesera area of El Salvador could be an attempt to outflank the Salvadoran column.

In Tegucigalpa, the peace envoys of the Organization of American States worked into the early morning hours trying to work out the cease-fire.

Both sides agreed Wednesday to stop shooting but each nation attached conditions which delay the truce. The OAS peace committee has asked the warring neighbors to agree to a cease-fire which would allow the United States to return to territorial conditions that existed before the fighting broke out with each nation's forces pulling back three miles behind its borders.

Kennedy, Mansfield Oppose Mars Target

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Senate Space Committee, heavily weighted with Pentagon supporters, has approved a \$2.75 billion program to launch the nation's first manned mission to Mars by the end of the century.

A source close to Don Juan, the 86-year-old dynamic head of his branch of the Borbon family, said recently that the father planned to fly to Madrid from his home in Estoril, Portugal, "within an hour" of Franco's death to make a personal bid for the crown.

Many Spanish experts say the expected nomination of Juan Carlos as a way of avoiding a politically perilous transition to a new monarch.

The selection of either man also is expected to raise an outcry from the Catholic hierarchy, which claims to be the trustee of Carlos Hugo de Borbon y Parra, the pretender from a rival branch of the Borbon family.

Although Alfonso XIII abandoned his throne, Spain has never ceased to be a monarchy. But unlike other monarchies, the House of Bourbon, who suggested that after reaching the moon the nation's flag be planted on the moon, is an orderly monarch.

Significance was given to Juan's statement, made at Cape Kennedy, Fla., following the launch of the Apollo 11 moon ship, because he heads a presidential committee on re-evaluating the nation's long-range space goals.

Mansfield and Kennedy, the latter considered a potential candidate, speak for a group of liberals already working to cut military spending in favor of increased funds for domestic programs.

Eight Hurt, 28 Arrested In Race Riot

YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio (AP) — Police arrested 28 persons and blanketed 10 blocks of a South Side street with tear gas early today in putting down Youngstown's second straight night of racial disturbances.

Eight persons were injured. Three buildings and four cars were burned before the trouble was brought under control.

Police said that several buildings were hit by sniper fire, police said. Gov. James A. Rhodes sent 150 National Guardsmen to help police prevent cleanup crews along the Hillman Street area.

The racially mixed area was the scene of disturbances in April 1968, following a rally in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., assassinated civil rights leader.

National Guard units totaling 170 men were placed on standby during the night.

The violence began Wednesday night in a two-block area. It spread through 10 blocks before being halted by police using tear gas and armed with rifles and riot guns.

The injured included one policeman and a fireman hurt by a flying glass another policeman struck by a rock, two men beat after their cars were set afire, a woman driver hit by a brick, and drug store owner Ralph White Jr., 49, who said he was hit by a brick after being dragged out of a fire bomb at his store.

Astronauts Soar Past Midpoint in Moon Trip

WASHINGTON (AP) — President Nixon announced today that the American moon team will leave behind on the lunar moon module awarded to Soviet cosmonauts killed while participating in space programs.

Nixon said the medals were given to astronaut Frank Borman by the widows of Yuri A. Gagarin and Vladimir Komarov.

The medals were relayed to the crew of Apollo 11 which will leave them on the moon.

Also to be left there are the patches and medals awarded the three Apollo 11 astronauts killed in a fire on the Cape Kennedy, Fla., launch pad in Jan. 27, 1967. They were Air Force Lt. Col. Virgil I. Grissom, Navy Lt. Col. Edward S. White Jr., and Air Force Lt. Col. Edward H. Smith.

Gagarin, the first man in space, was killed March 27, 1968 in a jet plane crash. Komarov was killed April 27, 1967 when the parachute for his Soyuz spacecraft failed to function properly as it was returning to earth.

The occasion for Nixon's announcement was a ceremony at which he presented the Distinguished Service Medal to Gen. John P. McConnell, retiring Air Force chief of staff.

The President noted that McConnell's service spanned a period in the development of manned flight — from 1922 to a year after Charles A. Lindbergh's solo transatlantic flight, to the mission of Apollo 11.

Pioneer Space Doctor Recalls Early Work

SPACE CENTER, Houston (AP) — Quietly following the program of Apollo 11 is a man who spent 27 years of civilian groundwork for such a flight before the moon-bound astronauts were launched.

Dr. Hubert Strighold, 71, regarded here as the "father of space medicine," watched the start of the voyage this week as a guest member of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.

As he hears the voices of the crew on the way to the moon, the spy space expert can recall the days when he conducted crude tests of weightlessness by starting in early airplanes.

Dr. Strighold returned last year as a top scientist at Brooks Army Airfield near San Antonio. He accepted an invitation to join the staff of Alexander Mead, chief of the physiological department of the Air Force.

During the late 1920s, he became known for his research on simulated altitude experiments. He conducted some of the first simulated altitude experiments with a man in an Air Force volunteer in a tiny pressure chamber at Wuerzburg, Germany, in 1927, staying inside a metal box while the Soviet Union sent the first satellite into orbit.

It didn't seem to be said, "I just did like it," he said. He never doubted that man's experiments with weightlessness would be used to help in the making of an astronautic capsule, but in 1936 he was convinced that man flying a "sophisticated capsule" on the moon in under-ground installations.

SPACER CENTER, Houston (AP) — Guiding themselves by the stars, America's Apollo 11 astronauts will spend the half-way point of their journey to the moon today with men and machines operating almost flawlessly.

As they sped toward their date with history, Russia's Luna 15 slipped into orbit around the moon on its mysterious mission.

A Moscow report said the craft had become a lunar satellite but there was still speculation the unmanned vehicle might attempt to land, scoop up moon samples and return them to earth before Apollo 11 can bring back a cargo of rocks.

Spacecraft Commander Neil A. Armstrong, Air Force Col. Edwin E. Aldrin Jr., and Air Force Lt. Col. Michael Collins reached the midpoint of their outward trek at 10:33 a.m. EDT when their 48-ton spaceship was precisely 120,000 miles from earth and the moon.

The astronauts crossed that distance in 29 hours 53 seconds of flight at a speed of about 3,000 miles per hour — 10 times faster than a commercial jetliner.

Like a car coasting uphill, the spaceship gradually has slowed from its initial speed of 24,900 m.p.h.

Armstrong, Aldrin and Collins remained light-tipped, the least tentative Apollo crew yet, as the earth shrunk in the distance.

Throughout the morning they consulted checklists and when they talked it usually was to report on the condition of systems.

Collins concentrated on star sightings with the sextant and other navigation instruments. He reported excellent results, in contrast to Wednesday when clouds obscured the stars to seem to "move."

During one test today, the crew did display emotion.

"My really a fantastic sight through the window," Collins reported. "The reticle just swept across the Mediterranean. You

Soviet Shot Orbits Moon, Sends Data

JODRELL BANK, England (AP) — The Soviet Luna 15 probe rocketed into orbit around the moon today. Jodrell Bank astronomers said the expected attempt to land the unmanned craft on the moon by Friday morning.

Observatory director Sir Bernard Lovell said Luna 15 was in an elliptical orbit almost exactly two hours long and 600 to 1,300 miles above the moon.

He added after checking his 85-foot radio telescope, the west's main radio probe for Luna 15 since it was launched Sunday, that it was sending back "bursts" of data.

The official Soviet news agency Tass said in Moscow that Luna 15 had become an artificial satellite of the moon, a statement interpreted in the Russian capital as possibly meaning no landing attempt would be made. Sir Bernard said he did not know whether to create another lunar satellite.
