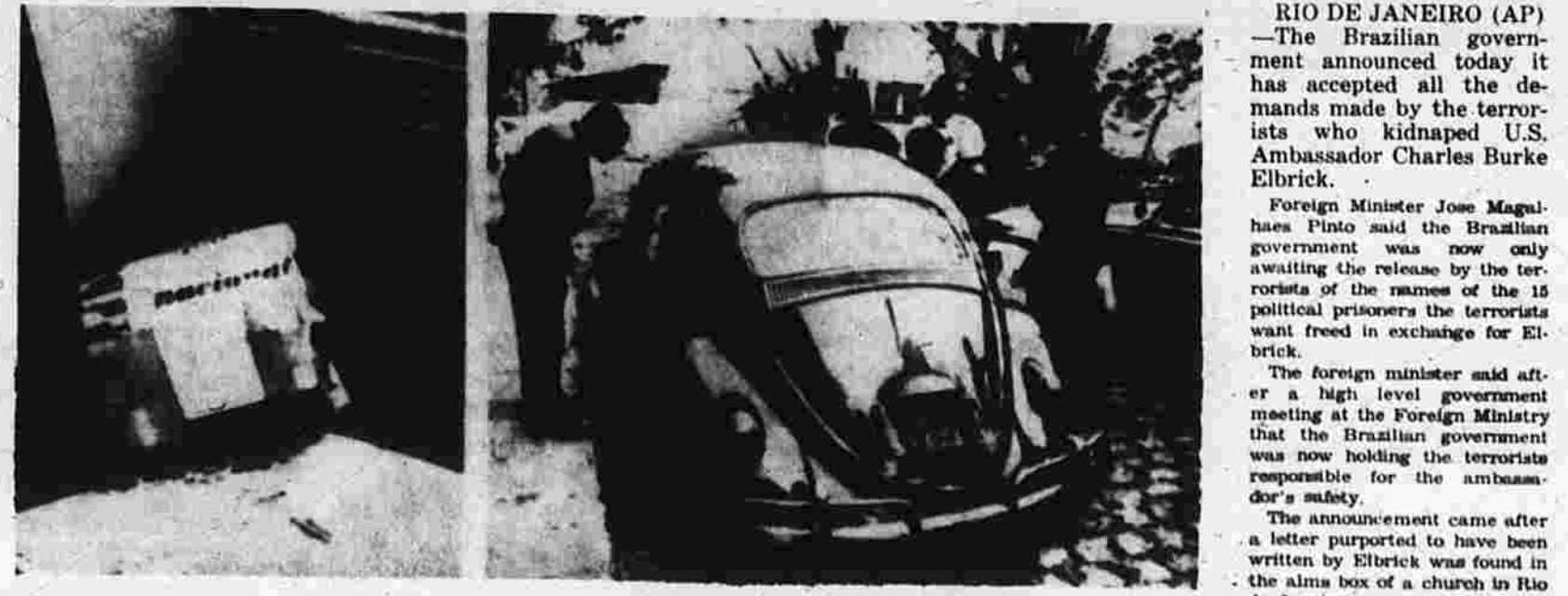

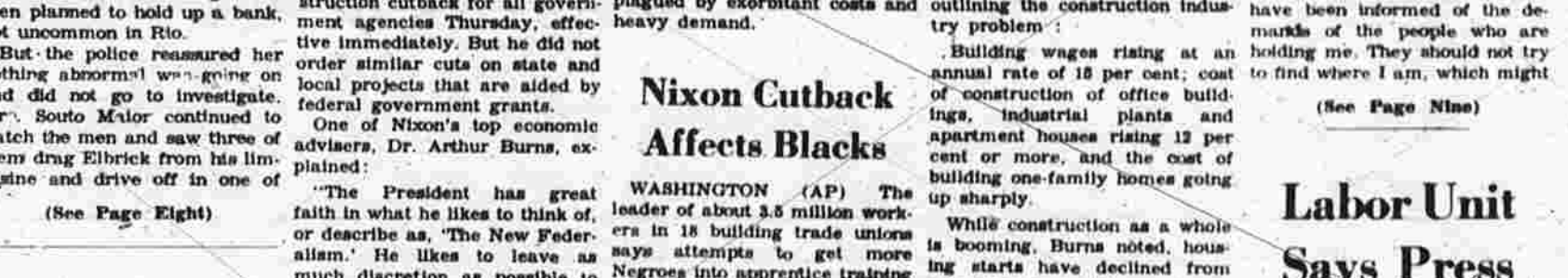

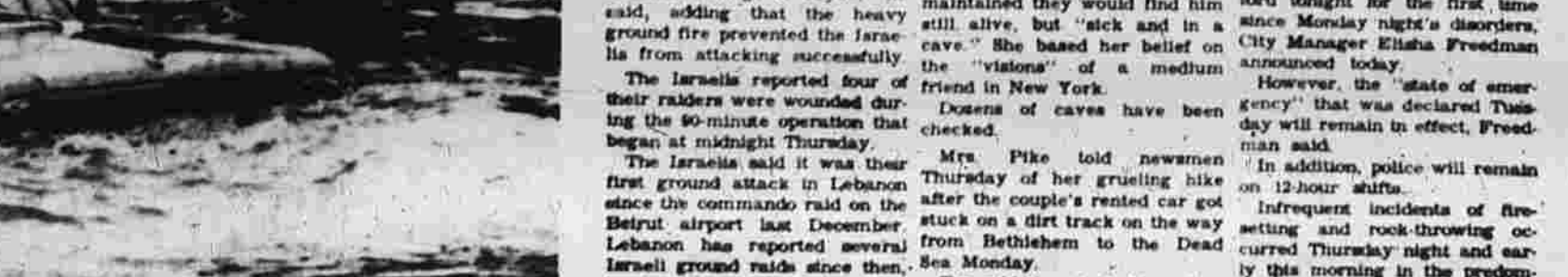

Blue Cross Head Cites Fold-Up Without Increase
HARTFORD, Conn. (AP) — A director of the Connecticut Blue Cross told the Insurance Commission Thursday that unless the organization is permitted to increase its rates it might have to fold up.
John S. Murtha told the meeting of the Insurance Commission that the alternative to approval of the requested rate increase would be "to allow an important Connecticut institution to go out of business."
Blue Cross is asking for an increase in rates of up to 25 per cent.
Murtha told the panel that losses on basic group business from January through June of this year totaled \$17 million. He explained that for the January quarter Blue Cross had paid out \$147 for every dollar taken in on group business.
Blue Cross officials are seeking this year's total of \$17 million.
Murtha also added that Blue Cross reserves were down to an all-time low of \$7.8 million.
Blue Cross officials are seeking the increase because of what they say is a sharp rise in Connecticut hospital charges during this year.
Murtha's testimony came during a sharp fire from Peter Kelly, chief of the Insurance Department, where she is a member of the Insurance Department in Hartford.

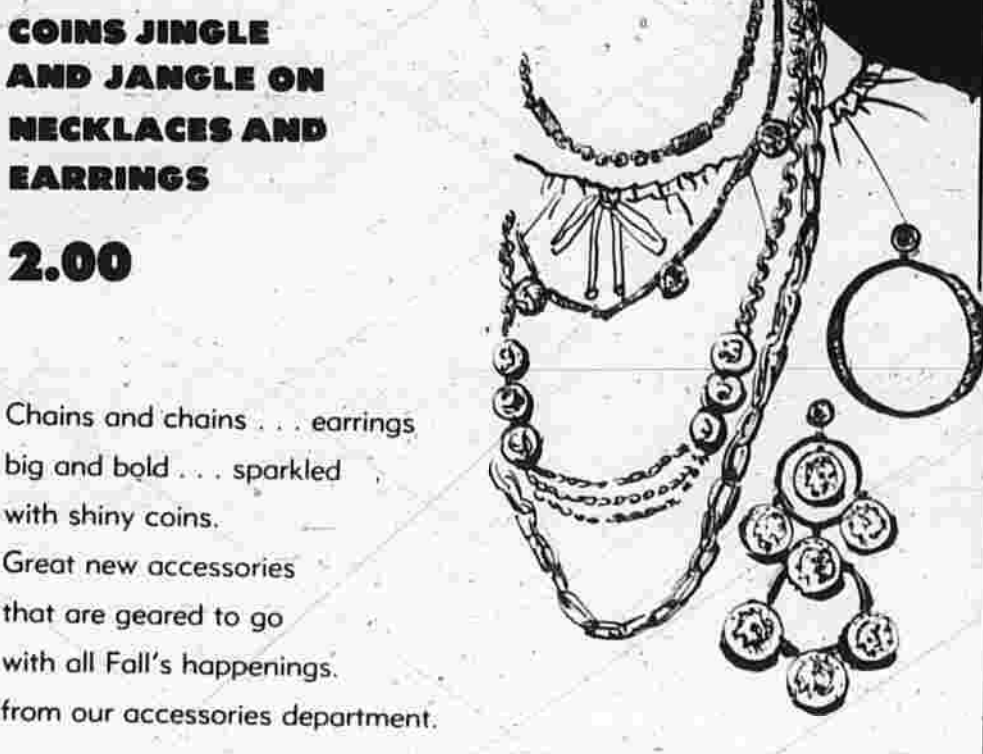

Air Force Expected to Cut Manpower by 50,000

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Air Force will announce today a cutback of about 50,000 officers.

This will bring the overall reduction of U.S. armed forces past the 190,000 mark as the service complies with orders to economize.

Details as to how the cutback will be applied through the Air Force still have not been buttoned down, sources said.

The Air Force's cost-saving drive may lead to fewer squadrons and further base closings.

The Pentagon already has disclosed plans to slash the Army by 36,000 men and the Navy by 72,000 men and 78 ships. Additional retirements of Navy vessels are expected.

Nothing has been said yet about Marine Corps troop cuts. Pentagon officials said these probably will be relatively light.

With obvious reluctance, Secretary of Defense Melvin Laird announced on Aug. 21 that the armed services will have to absorb an additional 500 million spending slash this fiscal year.

Blaming the Democratic-controlled Congress, Laird warned that "there will be an inevitable weakening of our worldwide military posture."

Although the Nixon administration has looked ahead to armed force reductions as the U.S. commitment in Vietnam is scaled down, it had not planned on moving this far this fast.

The expected Air Force manpower reduction, together with the Army and Navy cutbacks, will bring the total of U.S. armed forces close to 3.3 million men, about the level of late 1968, but still about 800,000 above the \$7 billion in units that the Vietnam war buildup developed in the summer of 1968.

According to sources, the current thinking involves a reduction of 44,000 Air Force enlisted men and about 8,000 officers.

The slimming down will be accomplished not by mass releases of men but by taking in fewer replacements for men whose hitches expire.

Normally, the Air Force absorbs about 125,000 recruits a year.
