Terrorists Kidnap Four U.S. Airmen; Demand \$400,000

ANKARA, Turkey (AP)—Four American airmen were kidnapped today and terrorists demanded \$400,000 ransom, threatening to "put them before a firing squad" if the money wasn't delivered. Turkish police said five armed men abducted the airmen early today as they were patrolled around a U.S. radar base near Ankara.

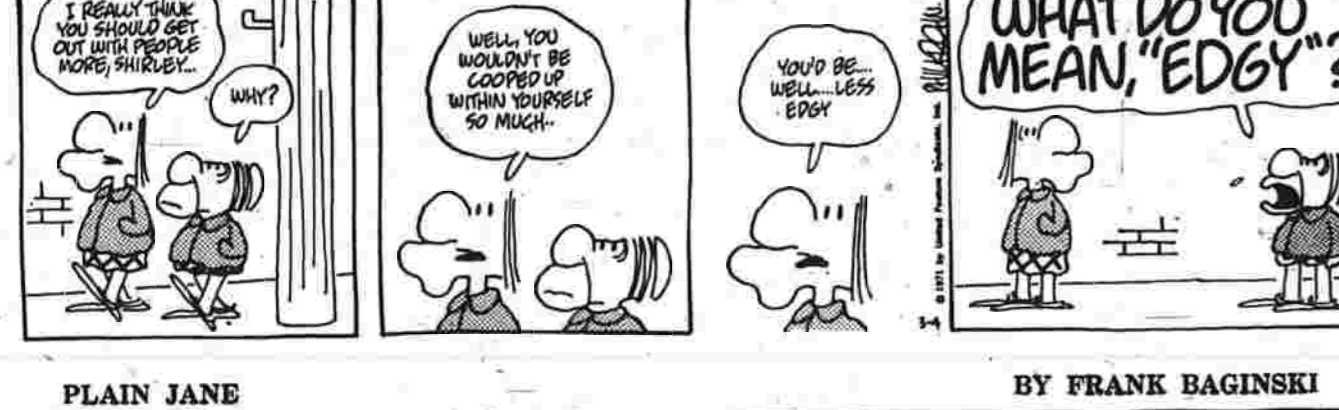

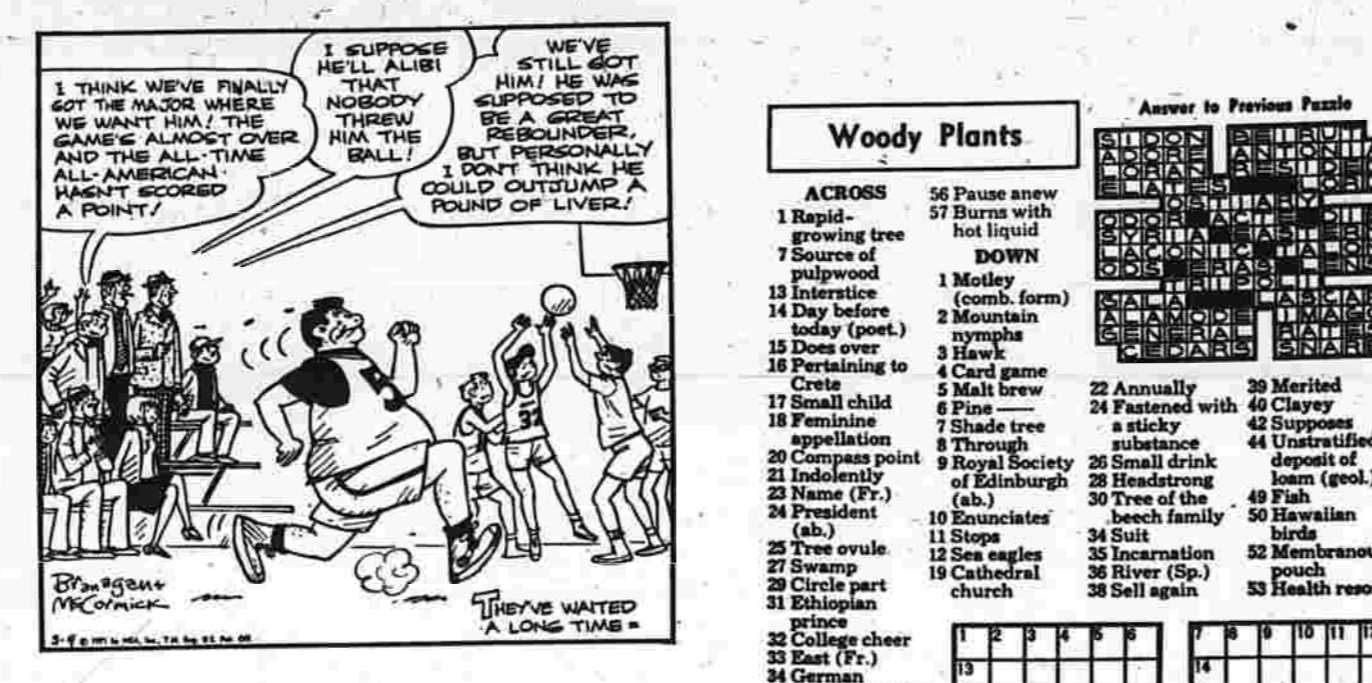

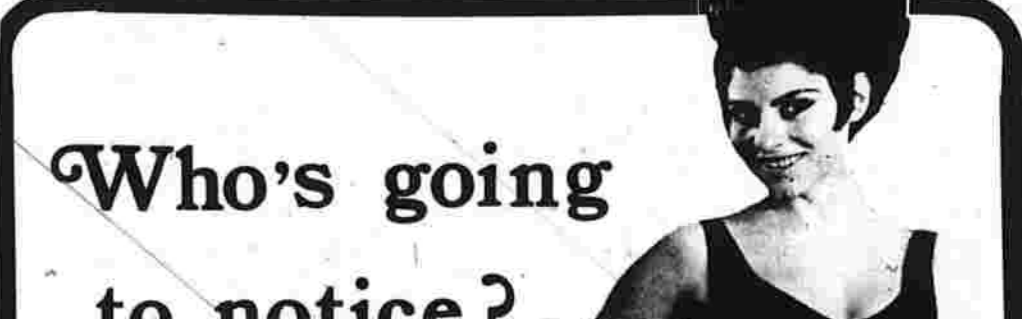
