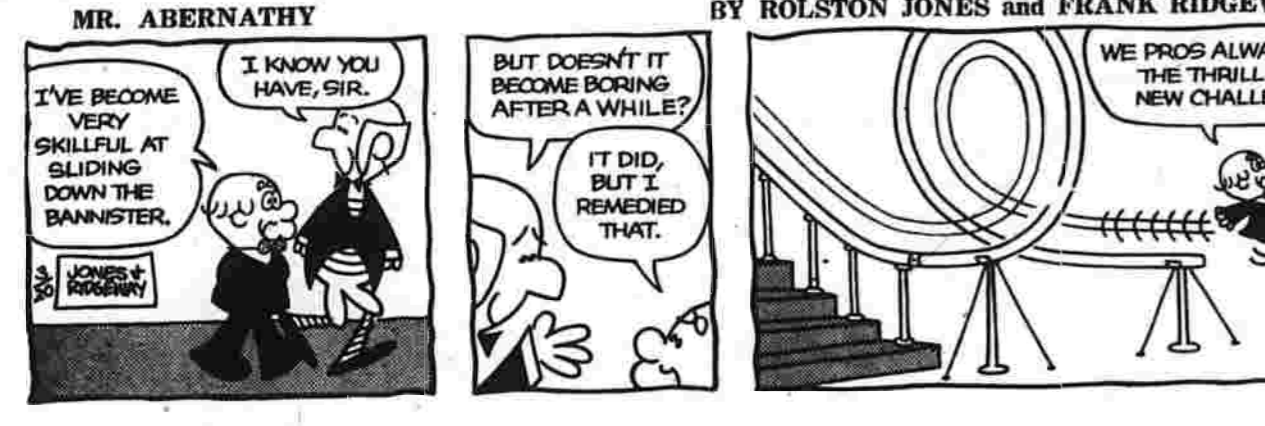

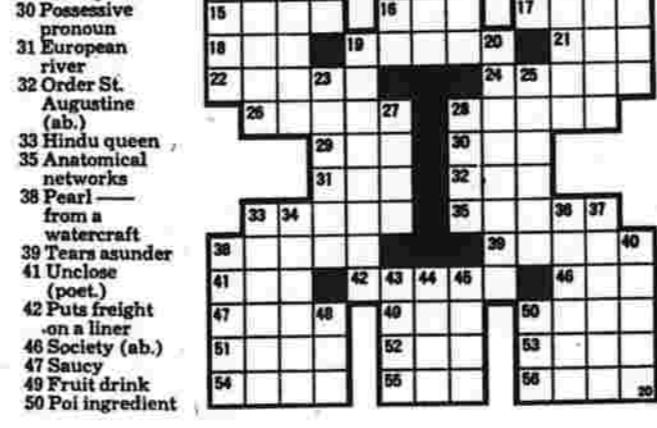

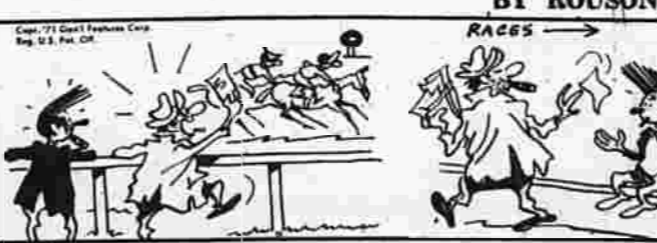

Ustinov, Ferrer Join Forces To Portray 'Gideon'

★ ★ ★ 'Jane Eyre' Invaded By Women's Lib

NEW YORK (AP) — People who remember "Jane Eyre" as a romantic, suspenseful tale set in the English moors may be surprised to find a shade of women's liberation in the television version.

Beneath that romanticism beats the heart of a nonconformist who takes on the establishment and wins, says Delbert Mann, who directed the film.

"There is a similarity to what's going on today," he said. "We don't point it out, but Jane Eyre is a very modern young lady. It's summed up in her phrase, 'I am equal.' It's almost women's lib. Her whole text to Rochester when they separate is, 'I love you, but I am equal.' That's very modern."

"Jane Eyre," Mann's third adaptation from the classics, will be seen on NBC Wednesday, March 24, from 9-11 p.m. EST.

Previously, he directed "Heldi" and "David Copperfield" for television and now he is at work on a fourth, "Kidnapped." He won an Academy Award in 1955 for "Marty."

The two-hour film stars Susanah York in the title role and George C. Scott—who said he would refuse the Oscar if he wins it as best actor for "Patton"—as Rochester.

"I had been against an American playing the role," Mann said, "but I wasn't satisfied with any of the English names we considered. We had to have an actor of the right age and with the romantic, tortured, enigmatic quality of the man. That led to the name of George Scott."

The drama was filmed on the moors of Yorkshire, where Charlotte Bronte set her tale. The biggest problem was not the cold or the wind, but the birds. They are on the sound track despite the efforts of a bird chaser who used a falcon to scare them away.

Emmy and Oscar Award-winner Peter Ustinov, starring in the title role as a boastful and all-too-human savior of the Hebrew tribes, is persuaded by the Angel of the Lord to lead his people in battle against the Midianite oppressors when "Hallmark Hall of Fame" presents the television adaptation of Paddy Chayefsky's Broadway hit "Gideon," on the NBC Television Network March 28.

Also starring in the Biblical comedy-drama special are Jose Ferrer as the Angel of the Lord; Arnold Moss as Gideon's father Joash; Eric Christmas as the Hebrew military leader, Shillem, and exotic dancer Little Egypt as Orpah, a village beauty who strives to sway Gideon from the will of the Lord.

Shortly before the expected Midianite attack upon the Hebrew tribes, the Angel of the Lord appears before Gideon and inspires him to lead the defense of his people. Reluctantly following the Angel's instructions, Gideon routes the enemy with 300 lamps and 300 horns wielded by 300 cowardly warriors.

After the battle, the Hebrews bow down to Gideon and would make him their king, a concept which appeals more than a little to the vain peasant. But the Angel objects, and Gideon is torn between his love for the Lord and his desire to maintain the respect of his people.

"Gideon" is the first Chayefsky play to be presented on television since "The Catered Affair" in 1955. Chayefsky is noted for such television works as "Bachelor Party" and "Marty," both of which evolved into successful movies. His stage plays include "Middle of the Night," "The Tenth Man," "Passion of Joseph D.," and "The Latent Heterosexual."

The Hallmark play was packaged by Compass Productions Inc. and produced and directed by George Schaefer. Chayefsky's work was adapted for television by Robert Hartung, who also served as executive producer.

"Gideon" is among the presentations marking the 20th consecutive season of "Hallmark Hall of Fame," television's oldest and most honored drama series, which has received 33 Emmy Awards.

Public Television, UConn Plan Series

Charlie Brown Turns Around—After Struggle

Journalism students at UConn who traditionally have been attuned to the print media are trying their hand in a different realm of the communications world this semester.

Under an experimental program launched jointly by the University of Connecticut Department of Journalism and Connecticut Public Television, four senior undergraduates are learning how to write for television news.

Initially, the assignment will involve two film essays and two film features — all student composed but supervised by the journalism faculty and produced and directed by CPT's Hartford station, Channel 24.

Evan Hill, professor and head of journalism at UConn, indicated the essays and features will be carried later this semester on Channel 24's Connecticut Newsroom Program, which is aired at 10 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays.

"One two-member team will write the two film essays and a second two-member team will write the features," he said.

Members of the first team are Mrs. Renne Stepno, a senior,

Williamantic; and Stephen E. Fagin, a senior, West Haven. They will write film essays on the "Resurgence of the Pinball Machine" and "The Counter Culture."

Writing news features on the "Talcott Mountain Science Center" and "Proposed Tuition at Connecticut's Public Colleges" will be Carol A. Bakinowski, a senior, Harwinton, and Harold R. Kramer, a junior, Waterbury.

Anders Yocum, CPT program director, explained his station was co-sponsoring the experimental effort in keeping with its Ford Foundation mandate to work with the state's colleges and universities.

"We see the journalism students at the University of Connecticut as a valuable source of ideas for stories on our Connecticut Newsroom program. We're pleased with the essay and feature ideas that have emerged at Storrs and we're ready to produce them. We expect the first story to be aired in three or four weeks."

It was a great day for producer-director-animator Bill Melendez when Charlie Brown turned on him.

Melendez and his Hollywood animation firm added movement to the "Peanuts" cartoon characters created by Charles M. Schulz. He recently spoke about the early problems of translating the popular youngsters to the television medium.

The newest "Peanuts" special—the seventh in the series—"Play It Again, Charlie Brown," will be broadcast March 28 in color on CBS.

"The biggest challenge was adding the dimension required when the kids turn around," Melendez explained. "In the comic strip, they are either looking straight ahead or faced sideways. There's no inbetween."

"A great deal of the charm of Schulz's drawings is the simplicity. He rarely uses backgrounds. The distinctive personality of each child is captured in just a few lines of facial expression."

"As animators, we had to be faithful to this concept. But in making the characters move, we also had to draw them at angles Schulz had never used. We spent hours turning Charlie Brown around, drawing him in different positions, without altering the shape of his head or the placement of his famous curl."
