HARTFORD (AP)—A crowd of more than 500—most apparently opposed to any change in Connecticut's abortion law—turned out for a public hearing in Bushnell Memorial Auditorium Friday.

Speaking for Gov. Thomas Meskill, who strongly opposed liberalization of the law, was Rep. Robert Argazzi, R-Berlin, who said, "There is no justification for wanting to take away a woman's right to life."

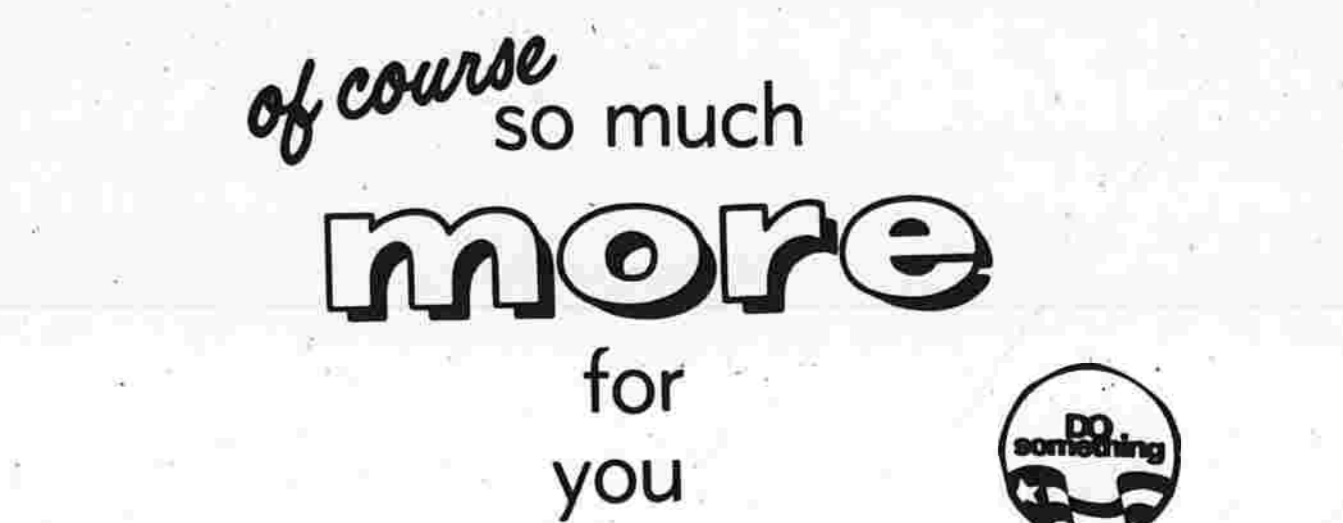

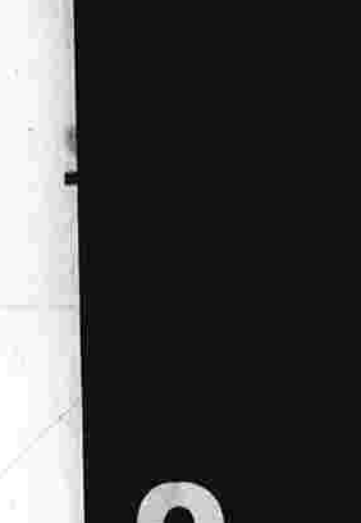

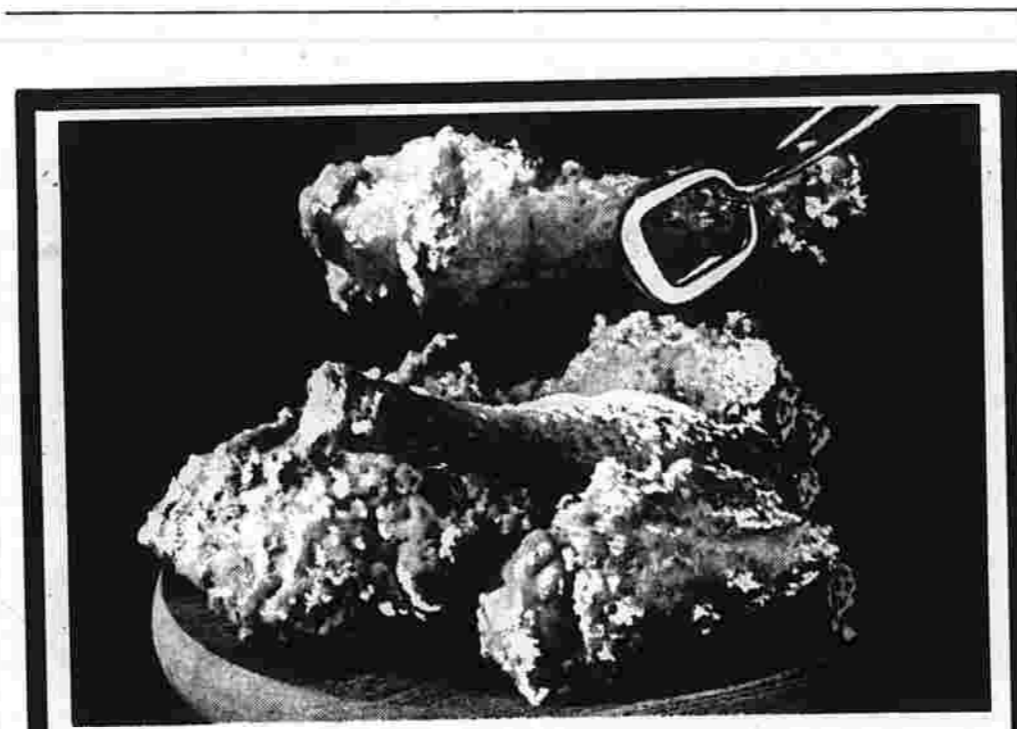

Smokes Supplies Somewhere Else, Tax Foe Claims

HARTFORD (AP) — People aren't smoking or drinking in Connecticut any less than they used to—they're just buying their cigarettes and liquor elsewhere, the legislature's Finance Committee was told Thursday.

The reasons for the out-of-state buying are the high tax rates on liquor and cigarettes, industry spokesmen testified at a public hearing. Raising the taxes even higher, as advocated by Gov. Thomas J. Meskill, would be self-defeating because this would only encourage bootlegging and hurt Connecticut liquor and tobacco dealers by depressing sales in this state, they said.

Speaking for Meskill's proposal to raise the cigarette tax from 16 cents a pack to 30 cents, boost the liquor tax from \$2.50 a gallon to \$3.00, and impose a 7 per cent sales tax on cigarettes, was Finance Commissioner Adolt Carlson. Carlson predicted that the cigarette tax hike would add \$7.8 million to the state's coffers during the next fiscal year and the

liquor tax boost would raise \$4.7 million.

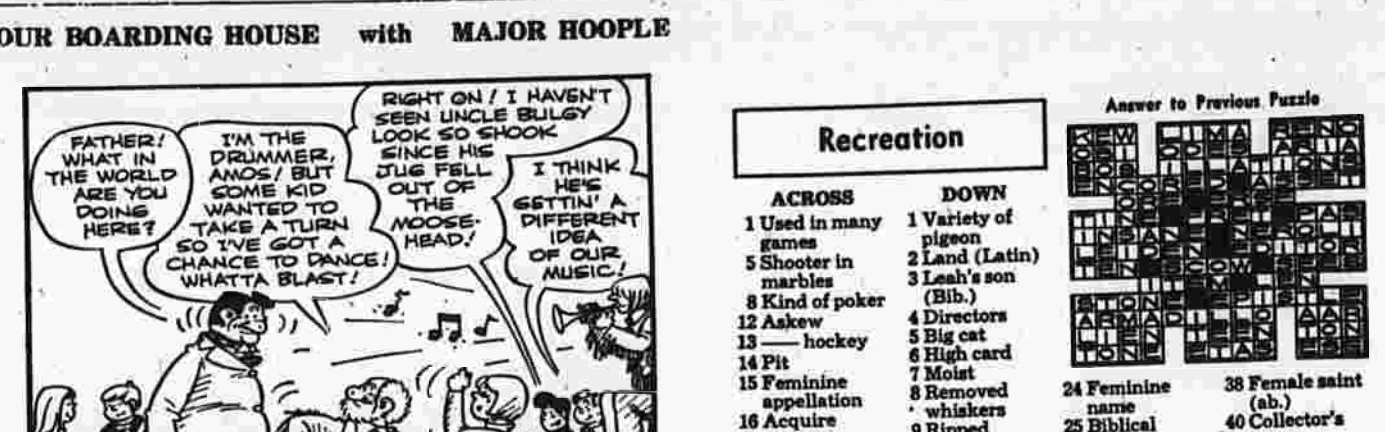

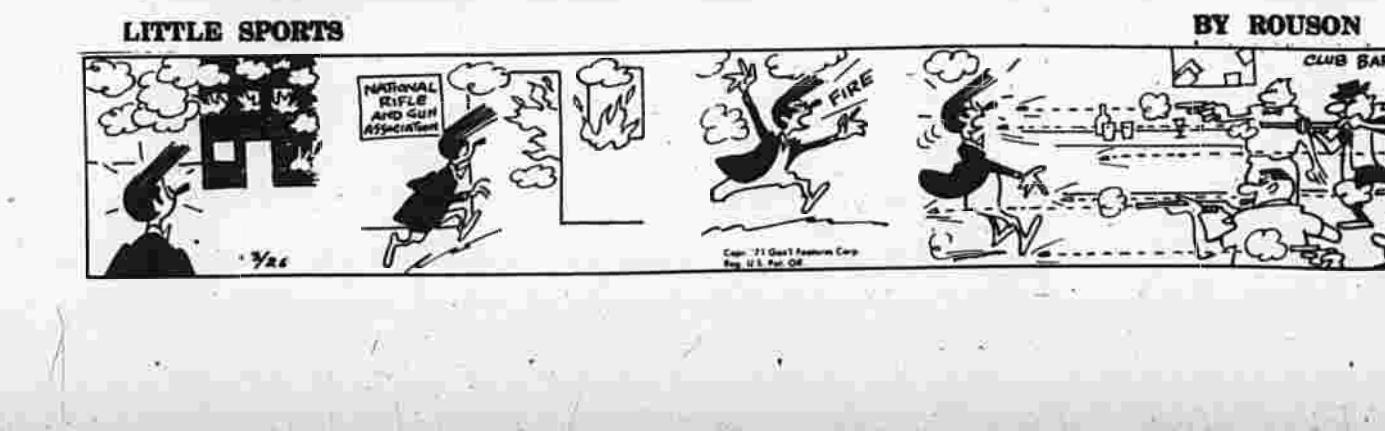
