So Pravda improved an explanation. The publication of the Pentagon papers has been nothing more than a capitalist plot, in which an element of American business has become disappointed in the effect of the Vietnam war on profits has given instructions to that semi-official organ of American capitalism, the New York Times, to begin to discredit the war.

Let's be sure we Americans get the picture straight.

The disclosure of the Pentagon papers came about because American big business ordered its slave press, represented by the New York Times, to begin to make propaganda against the war in Vietnam because, in spite of the war, big business was experiencing a recession.

The joke, then, seems to be on any Americans who thought that disinformation with the war in Vietnam was something that started with ordinary common sense Americans and that the publication of classified documents unmaking some of the leadership strategy involved was a controversial assertion of the duties and privileges of a free press.

There could be a further joke involved, one on Pravda itself. For until Pravda told us this "truth" about the disclosure, there were some Americans who were willing to consider all anti-war Americans and the New York Times as the agents, witting or unwitting, of a Communist plot.

Gambling A Dubious Pastime

State Senator Roger B. Eddy of Newington was among the eight senators to vote against the historic legislation in Connecticut before the legislature on home racing at tracks, and in special betting parlors operated by the state.

It is not certain, however, and dubious whether the new legal betting procedure will raise the money to help the state.

Opponents argue that what the state should be doing to raise revenue, besides raising taxes, is to attract new industry into the state, rather than watch business emigrate to climates with more favorable tax tables.

But people are going to gamble anyway, so why shouldn't Connecticut obtain some of the money? Others ask. The point is that with gambling opportunities more readily available, many more people will be able to afford it and discover the excitement of gambling with their first bet and develop a habit that eventually impoverishes him.

Off-track betting and other types of gambling might do great harm to the world of sports. Professional football is already spending a great deal of money to keep the game honest. Investigations in search of underables involve tracing backgrounds, associations. Certainly there is no money to be made through illegal betting.

But, when you expand it through legal channels, you may concentrate the problem tremendously. When you license betting on any event, you cannot help but increase the potential of people trying to influence the outcome of that event. Bay State Legal Group Vows War on No-Fault

BOSTON (AP) — The legal no-fault law reduction this year will be a major battle over Massachusetts' no-fault automobile insurance law.

Several states this year have followed Massachusetts in cutting auto insurance. Florida, Delaware and Oregon have enacted no-fault legislation, to become effective next January, Illinois is expected soon to follow suit.

Established Ryan Dacey, president of the Massachusetts Trial Lawyers Association, said in a telephone interview that a coalition of state legal associations would appeal the decision in federal court.

"Eventually it will reach the U.S. Supreme Court because so many rights have been taken away," Mrs. Dacey said.

The legal associations have steadfastly opposed no-fault ever since it was first proposed in the Massachusetts legislature in 1967.

The law, as now applied in the state, permits only to bodily injury insurance, compulsory in Massachusetts since 1971, to be paid.

It provides that a motorist's own insurer pay claims of less than \$2,000 regardless of fault in an accident and prohibits suits for "pain and suffering" unless medical expenses exceed \$500.

It is the prohibition against pain and suffering claims which state insurance authorities call "a form of socialized insurance" and constituted a change in common law.

She also said the law will mean loss of work for "thousands" of lawyers and insurance industry employees.

Grave Diggers Threaten Strike

The present contract expires at midnight Wednesday. Bodies of deceased persons would have to be stored in vaults or mausoleums during a strike, he said.

Grave diggers now earn about \$3.50 an hour, Gomez said.

Property Cover Expected In No-Fault Bill

BOSTON (AP) — No-fault automobile insurance, applicable only to compulsory bodily injury coverage since it became law Jan. 1, can be expected to be extended to property damage this year by the Massachusetts Legislature.

State Rep. Edward J. Dever, D-Arlington, House chairman of the legislature's joint Committee on Insurance, said Tuesday after the state Supreme Court ruled the law is unconstitutional under both federal and state constitutions.

In return for the benefit of a quick settlement, the court said the accident victim surrenders the right for possible "minimal" damages for pain and suffering recoverable in cases not marked by serious economic loss.

U.S. Considers Suez Proposals

WASHINGTON (AP) — The United States is reported working on concrete proposals to be submitted to Israel and Egypt by the end of the month, according to a State Department spokesman.

The official U.S. position remains that the administration continues to reflect on what to do next, but senior officials acknowledged today that presenting precise suggestions heads the list of possibilities.

If this takes place it will be the first time the United States has presented both sides with proposals of its own on how to reach what is called an interim agreement on the reopening of the waterway. Thus far the administration has returned from doing so in the hope that acting

as an honest broker will be sufficient to encourage Jerusalem and Cairo to come to terms on the Suez.

Although officials caution that no final decision has been reached as yet, they acknowledged that submitting proposals is a distinct possibility and could come early in July.

Some officials also concede privately that the reason for departing from the earlier position of acting only as a go-between was impatience and some irritation that Israel and Egypt appeared to be unwilling to make concessions.

# Somers Inmates File Suit Accusing Guards of Assault

Eight inmates at the state prison in Somers filed suit Tuesday charging with assaulting guards put there also. The inmates, who were returned to the prison from their homes on a multi-million dollar lawsuit claiming they were the victims of a violent assault.

The civil action was filed recently in Federal District Court in New Haven against 11 guards as well as prison warden Frederick Adams and former Commissioner of Corrections Ellis C. MacDougall.

The suit which charges a violation of civil rights in the "unjustified use of excessive force and summary punishment" against each of three counts against each defendant. It claims that prisoners were "pushed, stomped, kicked, choked and beaten" by guards without provocation, that all the inmates were dragged from their cells in handcuffs and by a number of guards, and that all sustained painful physical injuries in the beatings and were never medically treated.

The state charged that eight inmates last August with "unsubstantiated" charges of assaulting guards and to date just two of these cases have come up for trial in Tolland County Superior Court. All pleaded innocent.

According to testimony at the January trial of Tommie Hart and Melvin Henley, the disruption began in the segregated section of the prison with an infraction of rules against talking the 10 p.m. curfew.

The inmate alleged to have been making the disturbance, Thomas Johnson, told the court he was trying to get medication for hemorrhoids for which he had been in the hospital. When Johnson was told he was being put in isolation as punishment, he refused to go.

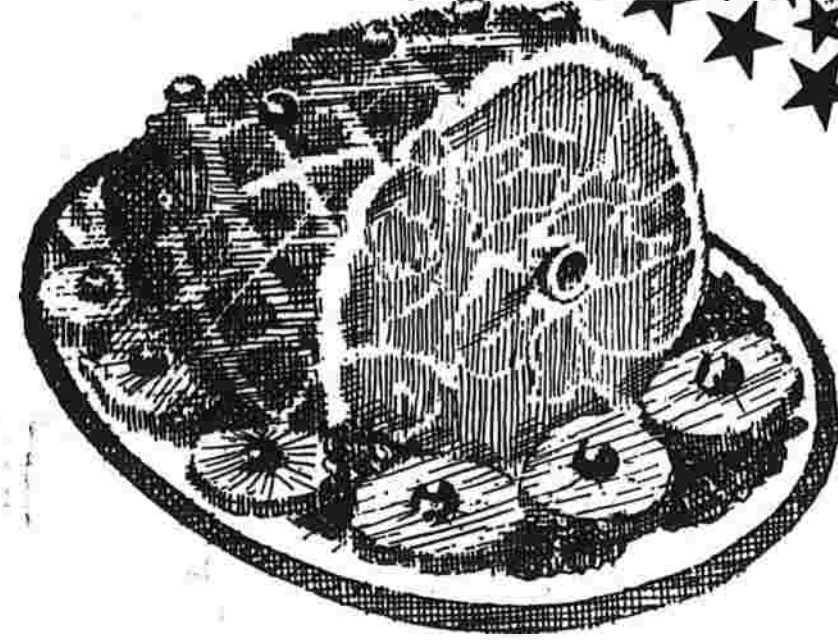

Parking Lot Perils

As part of its service, a neighborhood market maintained a parking lot behind the building. Near one corner of the lot, the stump of an old post jotted up from the ground. One evening a woman shopper tripped over the stump and fell, dislocating a hip. Was the market legally liable for her injury? In a court hearing, the owner insisted that she should have kept a sharper look-out for danger. But when the woman pointed out that the lighting was poor at the site of the accident, the court upheld her claim. The law places upon the owner of a parking lot a basic responsibility to keep it in safe condition. Furthermore, he is usually liable for injuries caused by the negligence of his hired help. Nevertheless, the owner does not guarantee absolute safety. Some accidents are simply not his fault. Thus a man got hurt in a parking lot when he slipped on a patch of ice cream. Demanding damages in court, he argued: "It is up to the attendant to keep the place clean. Since he failed to do so, his employer is liable." However, no one had any idea how long the ice cream had been lying there—or who had dropped it in the first place. Rejecting the man's claim, the court said there was "no evidence that the condition had existed long enough for the attendant, in the exercise of reasonable care, to have discovered and remedied it."

Suppose the accident is caused by someone's careless driving within the lot. May that be blamed on the lot owner? That question arose when a motorist drove the wrong way in a one-way aisle and knocked down a small boy. The boy's parents tried to pin liability on the owner of the lot, on the theory that it was his duty to "police" all drivers on his premises. However, the court held the owner not liable, because even a watchful attendant could hardly have acted quickly enough to be helpful. Preventing this kind of an accident, the court felt, would call for closer policing by the management than the law could fairly expect.

Lumps Bring Loose Cash

LONDON (AP)— Jackie Calaway lumped it and the British National Innovations Center liked it. The 21-year-old blonde girl declared "brown sugar" was better but lumps are more convenient. "I wrote to the big sugar firms to ask why there were no brown sugar lumps, but none of them replied," she told her men. So she made her own lumps, mixing "ordinary brown sugar with just the right amount of water and left it to harden in the freezer in our fridge." For her idea, the innovations center sent her 6 pounds—\$12.

British Find Big Arms Cache

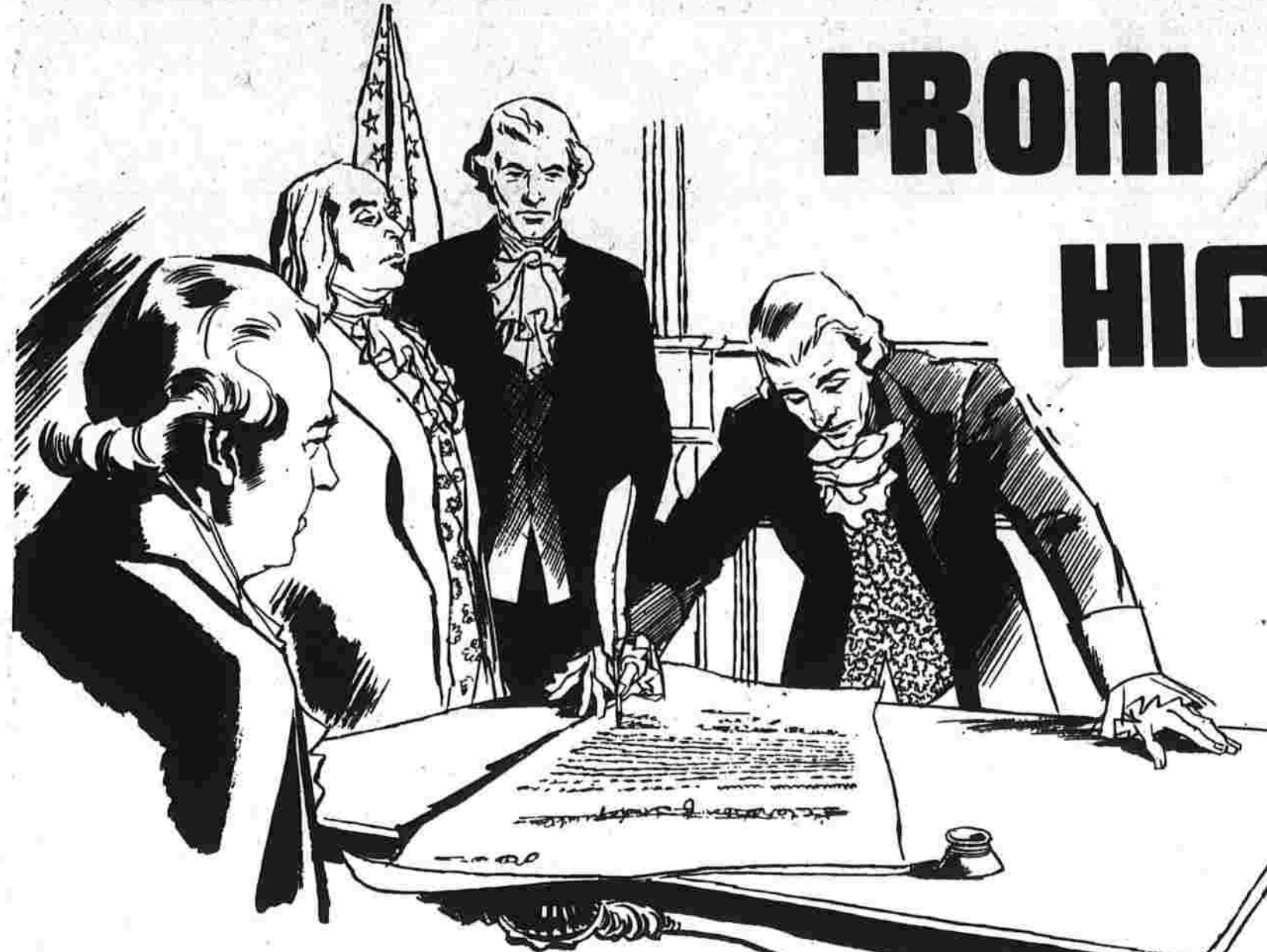
BELFAST, Northern Ireland (AP)— One of the biggest arms caches ever found by British troops in Northern Ireland was uncovered early today in a raid on a Belfast warehouse. "From the items uncovered, we can only surmise that the building was used as a bomb-making factory," a senior army officer said. Three men were arrested at the warehouse. The troops found 2,000 feet of fuse wire, 200 gallons of acid, 64 booby traps, two walkie-talkie radios, 330 detonators, three grenades, four gasbait bombs, one pistol, a rifle, more than 300 rounds of ammunition, machine-gun parts and an assortment of fuses, flares and time switches. British troops also discovered an illegal arms depot in Belfast during a house-to-house search on Saturday.

Nixon Hailed By Linkletter

LOS ANGELES (AP)— Embassador Art Linkletter says President Nixon is justifying a pressuring some countries whose business production reaches American youths. In meetings with some foreign representatives, Linkletter said, "I would say the President did not jawbone, he showed them out." He said the countries included Turkey, Laos, and Thailand. Linkletter's daughter died after using LSD and he heads a national anti-drug campaign. The embassador talked to newsmen Monday after being honored by Los Angeles County Supervisors.

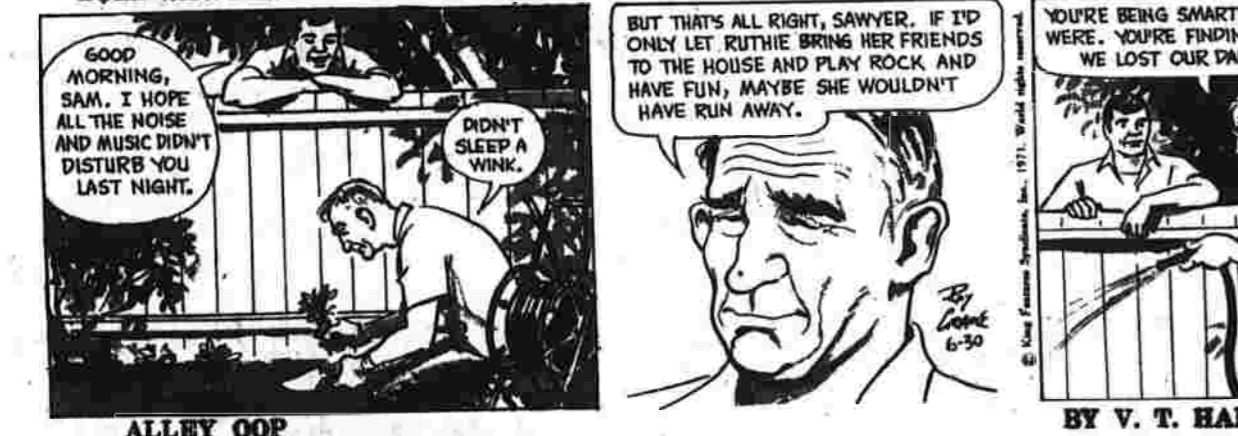

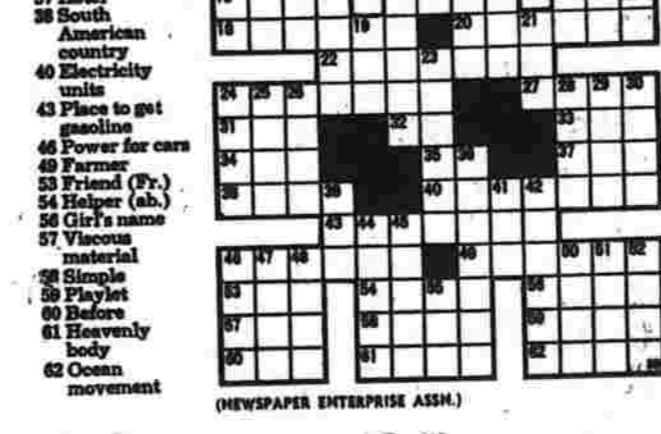
