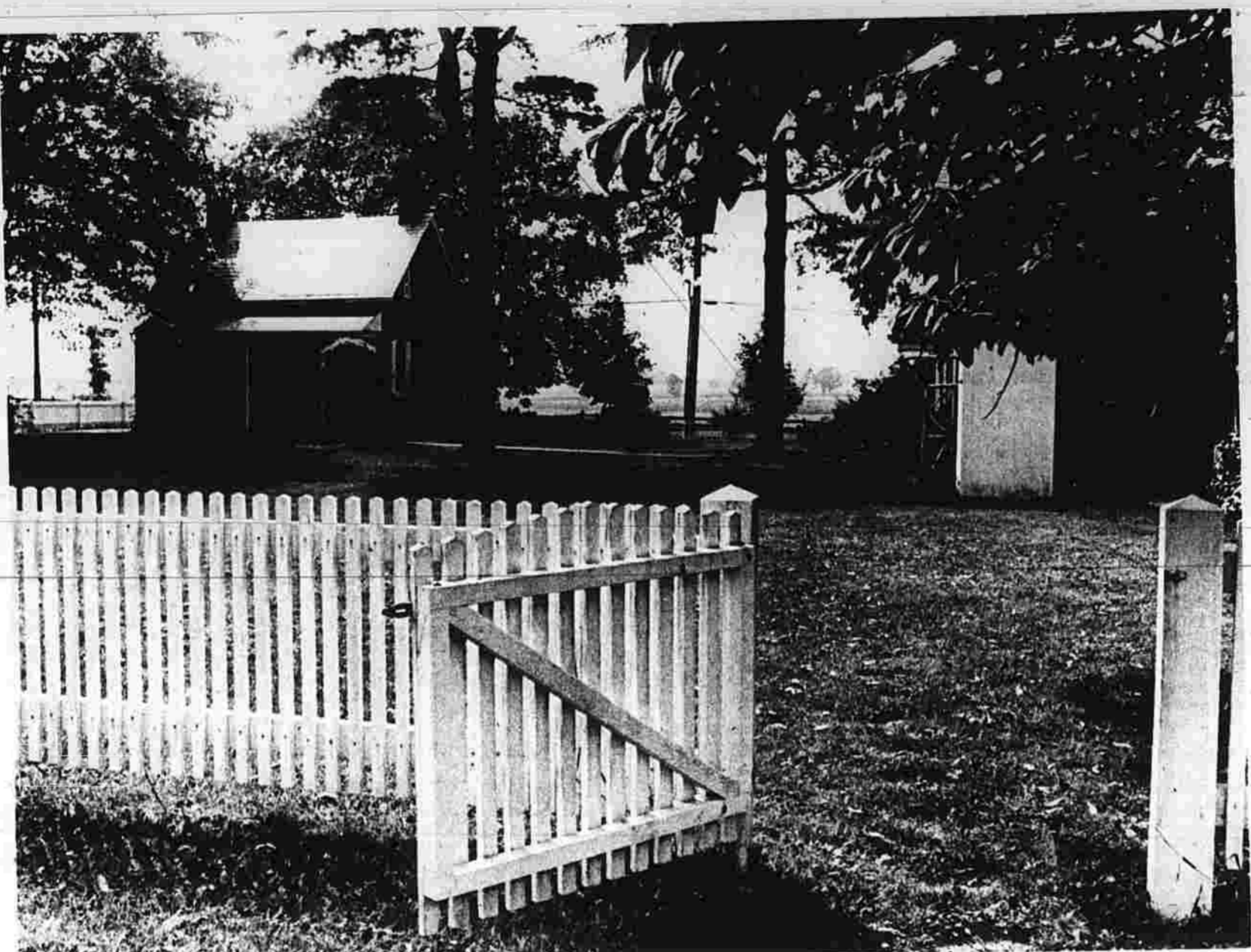

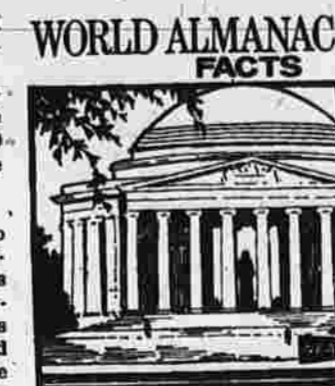

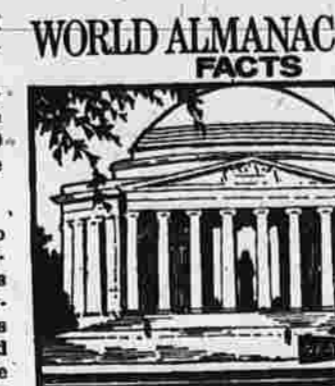

### Congress Faulted by Panel In Probe of Pentagon Papers

By JAY PERKINS

WASHINGTON (AP) — An unofficial House panel probing the Pentagon papers has heard repeated testimony that Congress abdicated its responsibility to maintain a check and balance on the President's handling of foreign affairs.

One House member suggested Congress be abolished if it could not live up to its responsibilities. Another said the American public should be informed Congress is not doing its job.

The testimony came during a three-day hearing called by 17 anti-war congressmen to probe the 47-volume Pentagon papers and what they showed about the government's inner workings. The documents traced origins of U.S. involvement in Vietnam.

Jonathan Mirsky, a Dartmouth professor and co-director of the East Asia Center, told the panel Congress doesn't know about important foreign policy decisions because it doesn't want to accept the responsibility accompanying that knowledge.

### Electric Giant Nears Completion

TURNU SEVERIN, Romania (AP) — Tourist guides describing one of the most scenic parts of the Danube have to describe to a new hydroelectric giant near completion at the river's awesome Iron Gate gorge.

The 600 million complex, a joint venture by Yugoslavia and Romania, is to be commissioned late this year after installation of the last of 12 colossal 178-Megawatt turbines, biggest of their kind in the world.

Harnessed by a 60-meter high dam linking the two countries, Danube waters have risen to form a new immense reservoir.

For the past seven years, some 5,000 Romanian and Yugoslav workers have been busy around the clock, mixing some 27 million tons of concrete and moving some 15 million tons of earth and solid rock. The work forced resettlement of 82,000 people from flooded towns and villages on both sides of the river.

Eventually, the project will generate a combined 11 billion kilowatts—more than Egypt's Aswan dam—to be shared equally between Romania and Yugoslavia. Romanian experts believe the investments will be paid off by 1975 because the site offers what one engineer here called "extremely favorable conditions."

With its twisting currents and ragged reefs ready to trap the unwary, the Iron Gate has been feared by boatmen since ancient times. Clamped between the massive jaws of a ridge joining the Carpathians and the Balkan mountains, it was the longest navigable stretch on the Danube's entire course from West Germany to the Black Sea. At one point, the spectacular Caiane (caldron) delta, the river is narrowed down from about a kilometer to just 110 meters.

The caldrons, currents and reefs disappeared as the water level behind the dam rose by some 30 meters. Ornavo, a picturesque Romanian town on the river port of 11,000 also vanished. It was rebuilt upstream on higher grounds, so fast that some of its streets have not yet been given names.

The top of a few telegraph poles still mark the point where the swelling Danube inundated Ada Kalea, a castle fortress island mentioned in ancient Greek legend. The 500 largely Turkish-speaking islanders were scattered all over Romania, with 70 families emigrating to Turkey.

About 800 million of the total outlay was spent on the navigation system. Locks on both sides, which can take ships up to 5,000 tons, let traffic pass the dam. Total time of the voyage

### Powered by Hydrogen

Four-Man Team Develops Nonpolluting Car Engine

FERRIS, Calif. (AP) — Four men say they have adapted a 1960 pickup truck to run on a mixture of hydrogen and oxygen that does not emit pollutants.

Dwight B. Minnich, one of the four, said Thursday that they chose the hydrogen-oxygen combination as the basis of their experiments because the fuel mixture would burn without harmful leftovers.

"The best way to avoid pollutants is not to make them in the first place, rather than to try to clean them up afterwards," he said.

Minnich, who has worked as an engineer in aerospace projects, is now owner of the Ferris Progress, a weekly newspaper. He and three engineers began working on the project in the newspaper garage during their spare time since January 1970.

John Chao, an engineer with the Los Angeles Resources Board in Los Angeles, watched a demonstration of an earlier test vehicle, a 1960 Model A Ford pickup, and said the engine started easily and ran smoothly.

"Their concept of using hydrogen as fuel is cleaner than petroleum products as far as emission is concerned," Chao said. "If they can satisfy safety requirements and possible problems in lubrication and fuel on long trips and other problems, their car would be just as good as a regular car."

The Model A, the second vehicle adapted in the experiments, also had problems with fuel and fuel control and the cooling system, Chao said.

The 1960 pickup, which has been driven 40 miles at highway speeds and has a recycling system to use all fuel. The fuel mixture is produced by spark plugs.

The four plan to present their work to a meeting of the Society of Automotive Engineers next week in Boston.

Minnich said hydrogen-powered cars would have to overcome fear of the fuel, but added: "Others are working in any fuel. Hydrogen has its dangers, but they are of a lesser order than gasoline."

Minnich said the four have spent \$5,000 on the project and can't afford to spend any more.

"We feel we've proven the theory," he said. "To complete the development would take something in the order of a couple million dollars because you're getting into some pretty sophisticated equipment."

He said some major car makers contacted "have been very courteous, period," and the federal Environmental Protection Agency told the four it could not make funds available because the group was not a university.

Minnich's colleagues are Patrick L. Underwood and Frederick F. Narlock, aerospace engineers, and Paul Diegel, a civil engineer.
