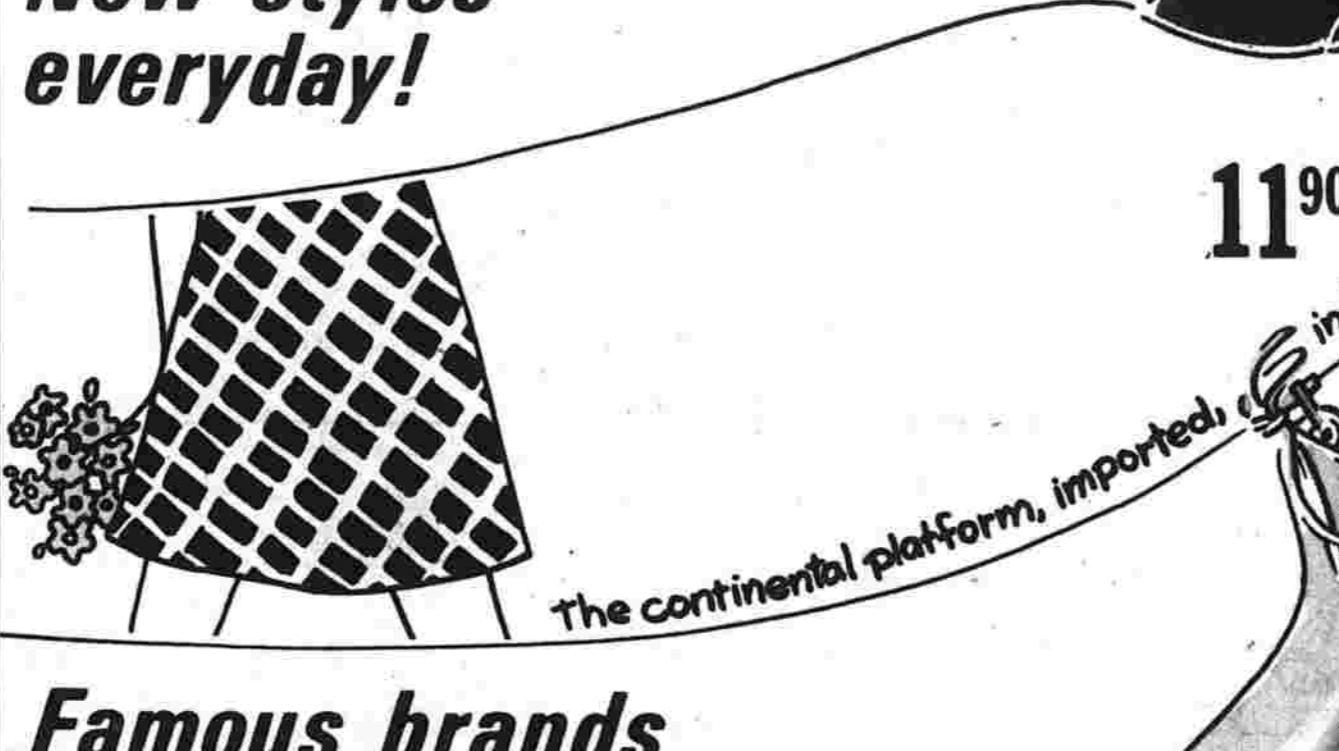

The sad news of the next fiscal year has begun to surround the taxpayers of Manchester.

General Manager Robert Weiss said he sees no way to refrain from general fund expenditures which would be \$864,077 higher than appropriations for the current year.

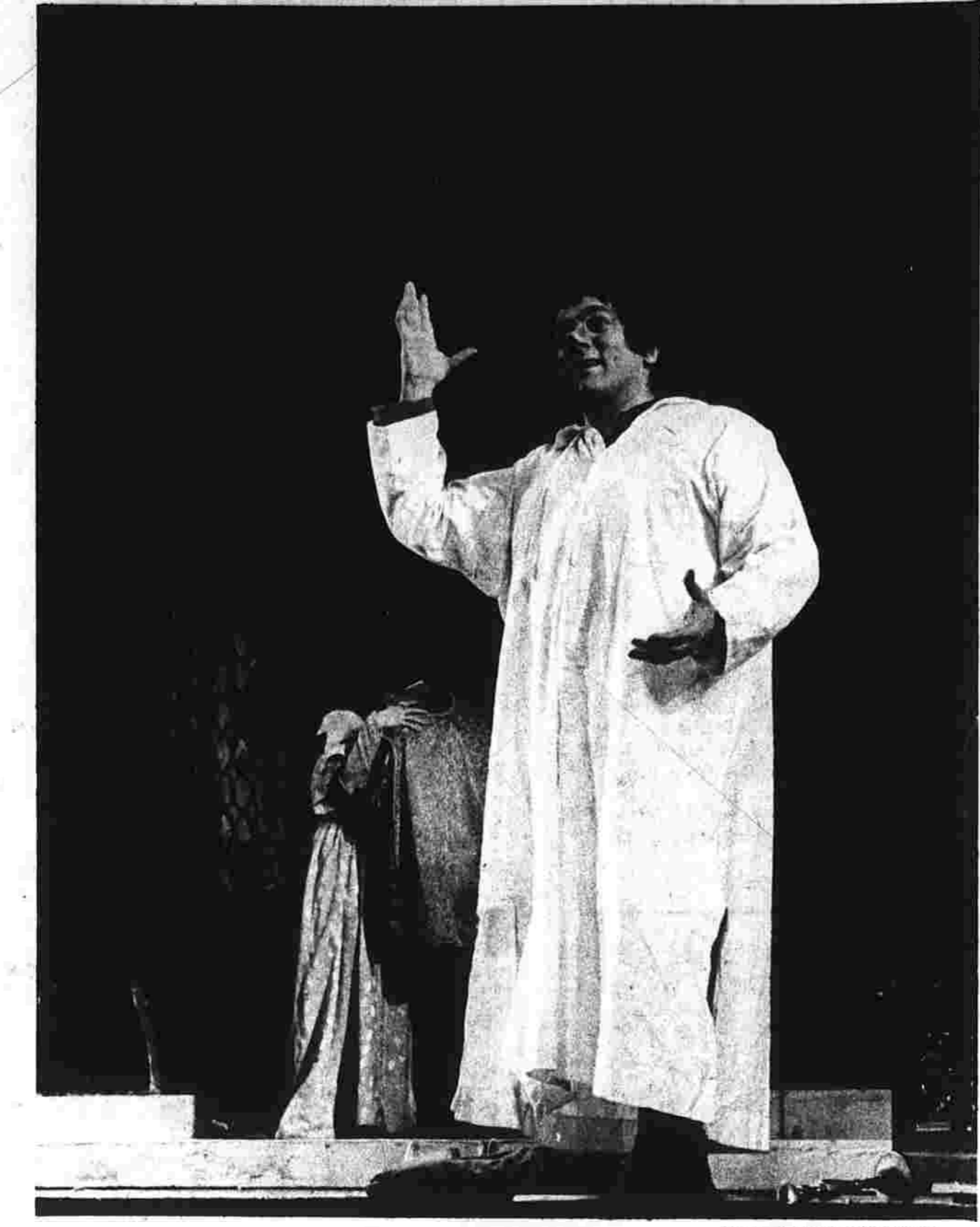

Keeping the Yankees in Yankee Stadium may be an expensive luxury for the taxpayers of New York. Still, it is a reassuring piece of permanency in this anarchic world. At least one team stays put, where it has always been, where it is supposed to be.
