### Tradition Marks Bolton Graduation

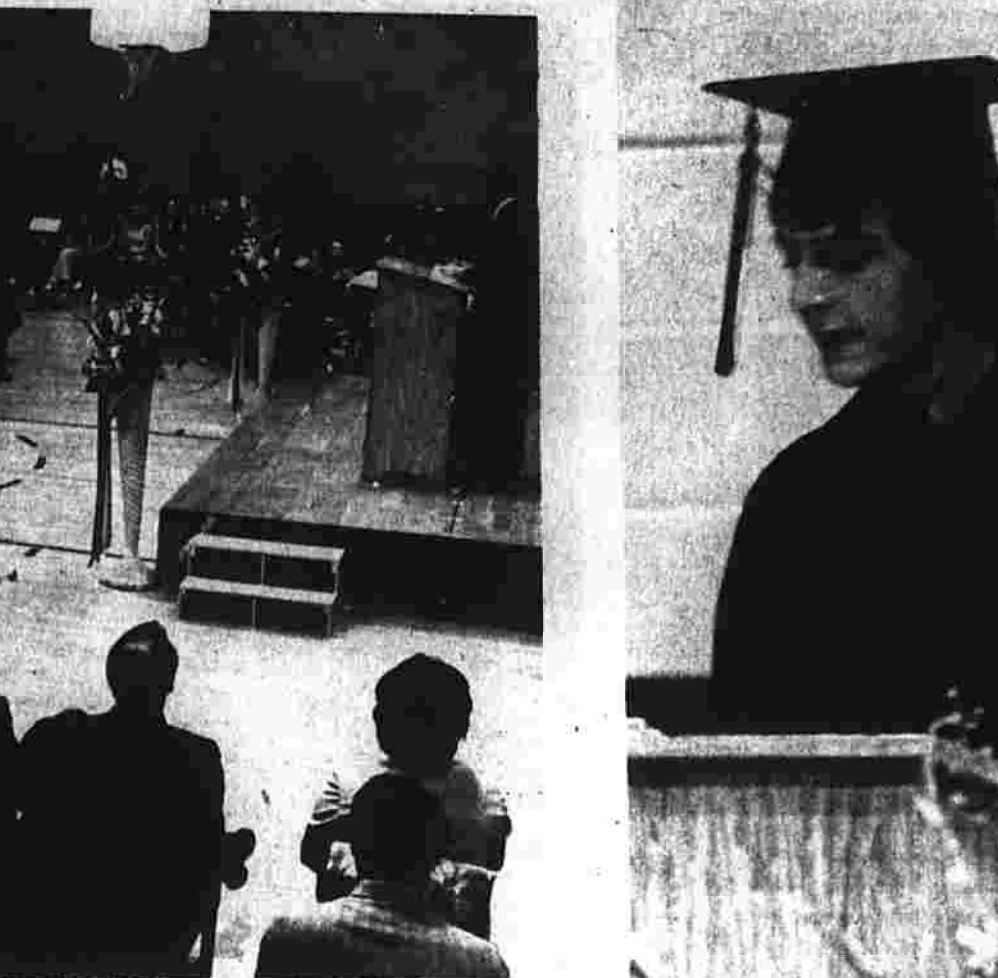

Originally the Five Miles bought by Hartford from the Indians, 1682. First settlement about 1673. Chartered by General Assembly as Orford Parish, 1772. Incorporated as town of Manchester, 1823.

An early center of small industry, its mill produced powder for the American army during the Revolution, paper on which the Connecticut Courant printed the news of the battle of Lexington, and army blankets for the War of 1812.

Later the great Cheney Mills made Manchester the silk capital of the nation.

Here Christopher Spencer developed the first successful magazine repeating rifle. Here was established under town support the second community college in Connecticut.
