CHICAGO—The self-imposed handicap that Sen. Charles S. Percy of Illinois carries into any race for the 1976 Republican Presidential nomination was exposed when he lunched at Chicago's elegant Casino Club with key Democratic supporters for his reelection to the Senate.

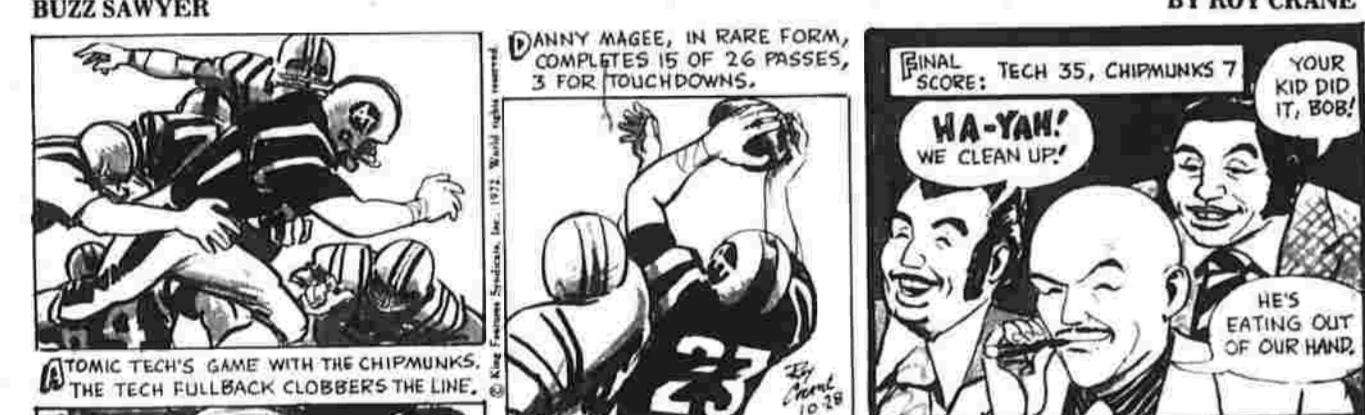

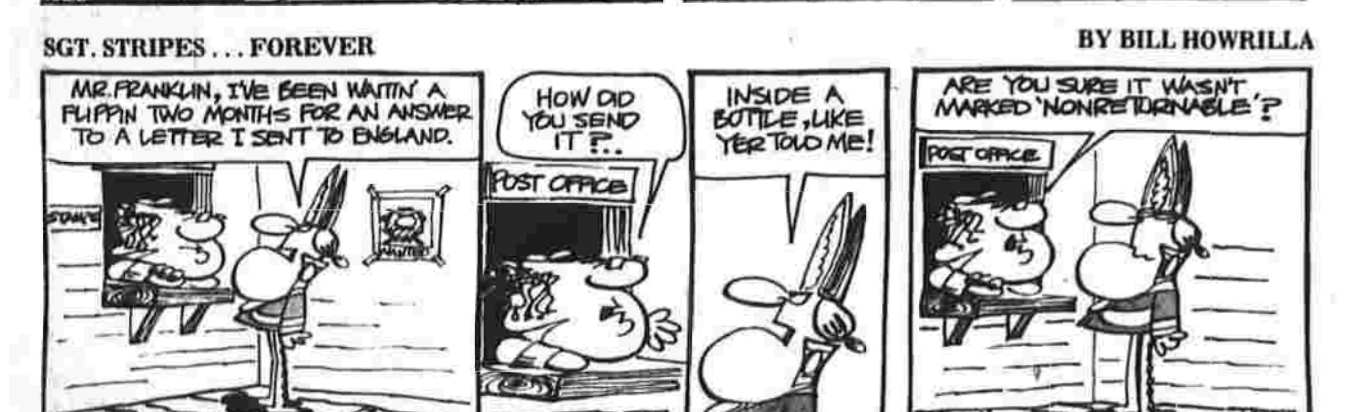

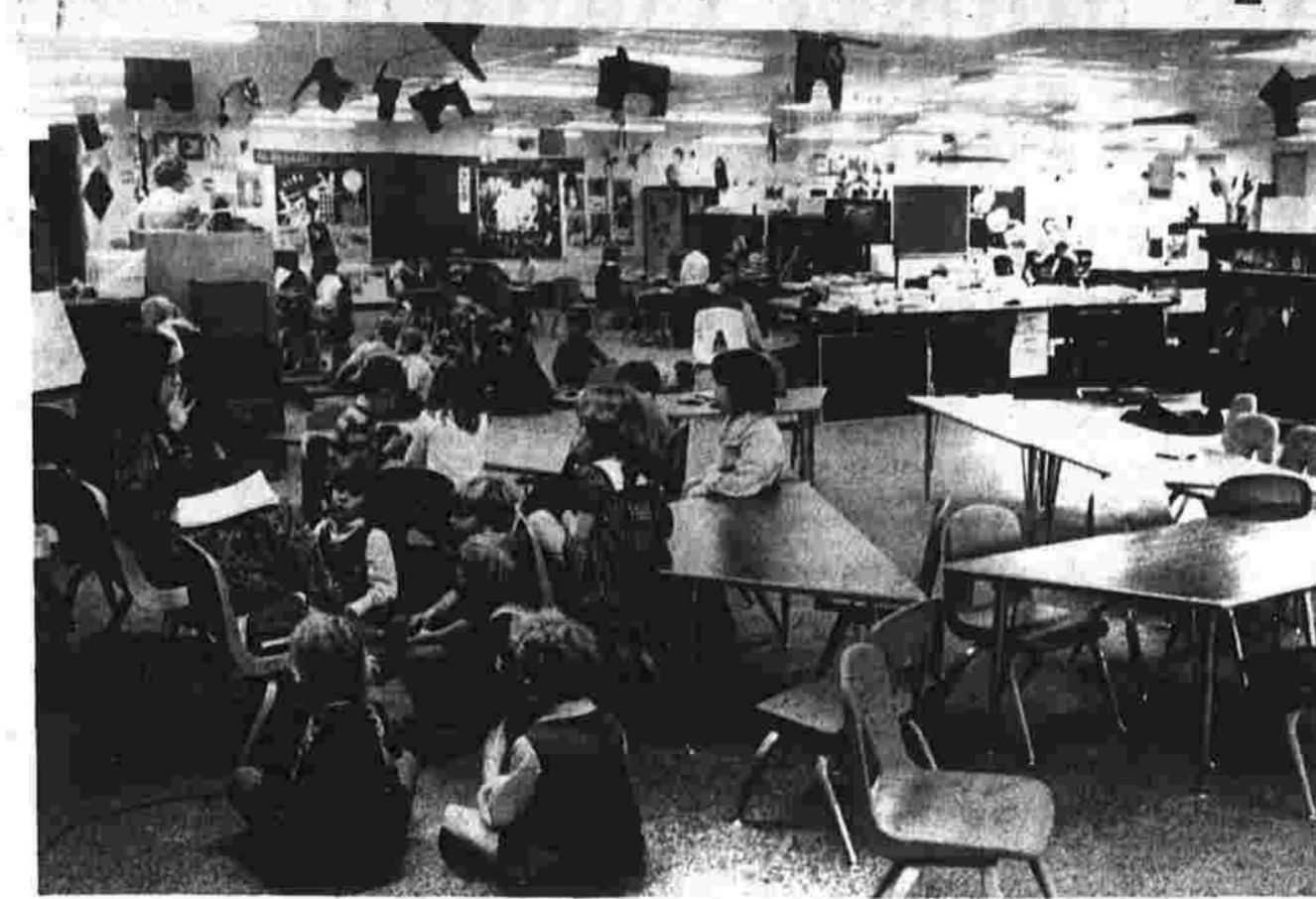

Bridgeport Sets Up Interim Bus System

BRIDGEPORT (AP) — The Bridgeport Transit District has told its bus commuters to leave the bus service up to the district.

The Bridgeport area, along with Waterbury and New Britain, has been without regular bus service since the Connecticut Railway and Lighting Co. suspended service Oct. 10.

Now the Bridgeport Transit District says it will provide interim bus service on the major routes normally served by CR&L beginning Tuesday.

District Chairman Salvatore B. Curiale said Friday that the plan, effective at 6 a.m. Tuesday, will make maximum use of the four other Bridgeport area bus companies: the Gray Line, the Chieftop and Stratford bus companies, and Bridgeport Auto Transit.

Fares for runs on CR&L routes by the four companies will remain at 50 cents while fares for

their own runs will not be affected, Curiale said.

He said the interim service is renewable every 15 days.

In another development Friday, the state Public Utilities Commission said it would be impossible to shift from Hartford to Bridgeport a Nov. 6 hearing on possible revocation of CR&L's franchise.

The PUC, responding to a request from Democratic congressional candidate James McLoughlin of Bridgeport, said 15 towns were served by the CR&L and that more persons interested in the situation would be able to attend the hearing in Hartford.

McLoughlin had submitted a petition with 54 signatures demanding the hearing be in Bridgeport. Only 25 signatures were needed to force the PUC to make the switch.

Also on Nov. 6 the PUC will hear a request from Northeast Transit Co. to assume all 14 CR&L routes in Waterbury.

Company President Paul Rust has called a meeting of the firm's board of directors for Monday to decide whether to contest revocation of the company's state franchises.

Children Given Polio Boosters

AMHERST, N.H. (AP) — About 3,000 school children were given booster doses of oral polio vaccine Friday following a report that an Amherst boy had contracted the disease at a school in Connecticut.

Dr. James Starke, public health officer, said the precaution was being taken because the unidentified victims sister has been in contact with children in Amherst and Milford.

The victim, a pupil at Daycroft School in Greenwich, Conn., Starke said, was one of eleven pupils affected by a polio outbreak at the school.

The victim's sister is a pupil in a school in Amherst. Starke said pupils in the Wilkins and Clark School in Amherst and the junior and senior high schools in Milford, were being given the vaccine provided by the state.

Educators Hear Proposal On Performance Ratings

ROCKY HILL (AP) — A conference of the Elementary School Principals' Association Friday heard proposals for annual performance evaluation of all teachers and administrators.

A speaker later in the meeting summed up the reaction of the association as ranging from "critical to hostile."

The proposed evaluations would be effected by locally-selected committees of educators and laymen and would include peers of the person being evaluated. The proposals also call for a one-year internship for all teachers and administrators advancing to a new position.

David Mulholland, representing the Educational Administrators Association of Hartford, called the evaluation and internship proposals "very regressive" and said they could "open the door to political patronage" in the schools.

A school principal at the session said, "I feel that the top 60 per cent of the people on our staff would not benefit from these...elaborate procedures." He said he would prefer to have the evaluation procedure available on request for special cases.

Dr. Sophie Jenkins of Eastern Connecticut State College, chairman of the Advisory Board of State Certification and one of those who presented the evalua-

tion proposals, said they grew out of two state conferences on teacher certification held early last year.

Those attending the preliminary conferences recommended that teacher certification be "based on demonstrated ability to perform" rather than on education courses taken, and that a commission be appointed to recommend specific procedures, she explained.

Mahlon F. Hayden of E.O. Smith High School in Storrs, also involved in the presentation Friday, said there seemed to be a misunderstanding among the principals of what was behind the proposals.

It is unfortunate but understandable that educators are so "emotionally involved," with proposals for change, he said, adding that the proposals contain inadequacies but the basic plan "is feasible and is one that will improve education in this state."

The state Board of Education has approved the "direction" of the evaluation guidelines but not
