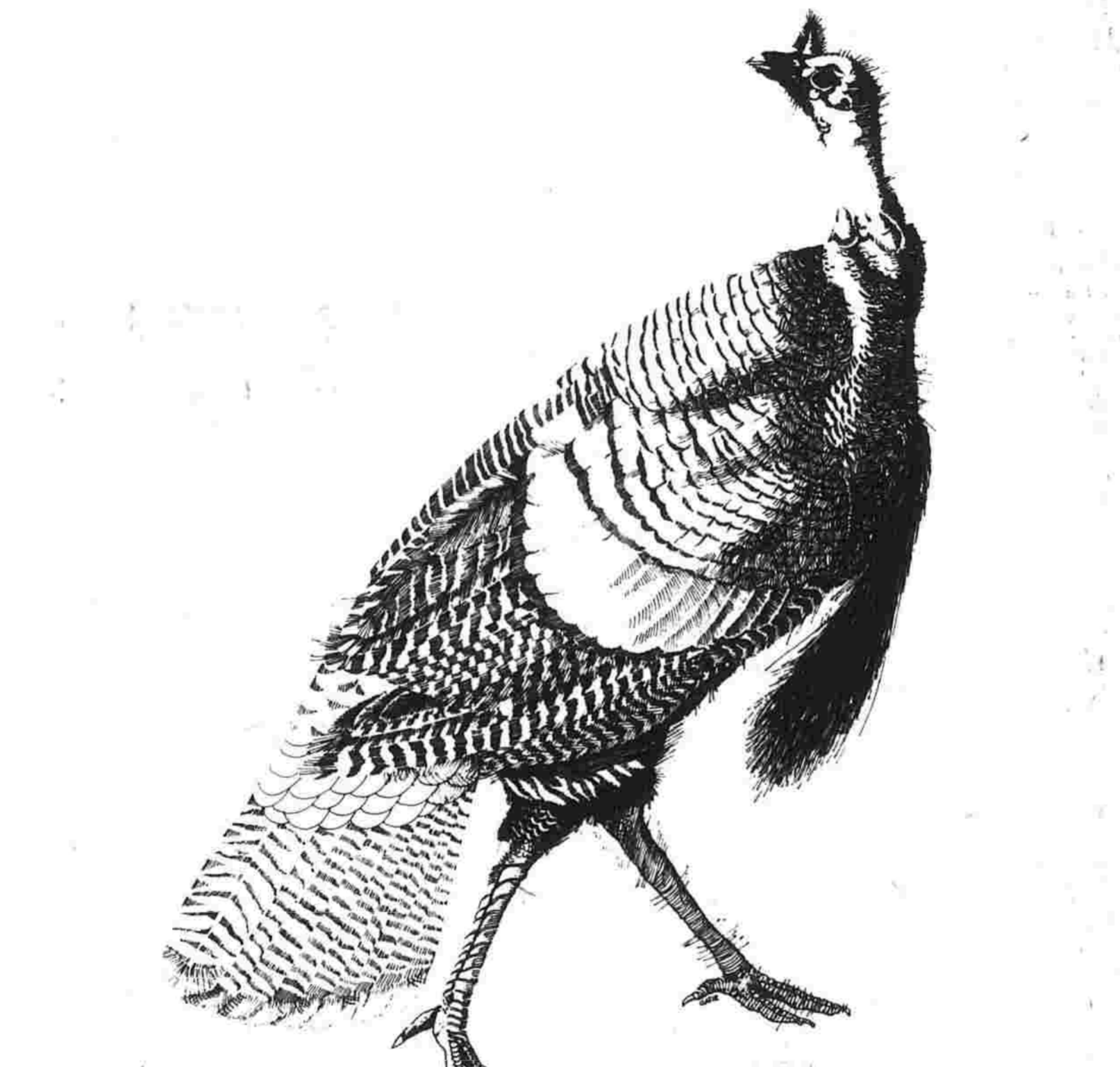

South Windsor CRRG Says School Board Distorts Public Hearing

The Concerned Citizens for Responsible and Responsible Government, (CRRG) has charged the Board of Education with "misconducting the meaning of a public hearing" and, by this action, "insulting the intelligence of the citizens of South Windsor."

The group's comments refer to the recent decision by the board to allow the group a public hearing at the high school tonight at 8, but to deny a request for a "shared presentation" with the board and school administrators.

The group claims tonight's meeting is "just another one of eight meetings where the public heard the board using its own interpretations, its version of the final analysis of the complex plan."

The group also charged the administrators with "manipulation of information, distortion in redirecting of elementary school children" and "using general scare technique while not submitting supportive facts."

The group also rapped the superintendent for a statement made in June 1970 in which he said "I don't believe my projections had been anticipated."
