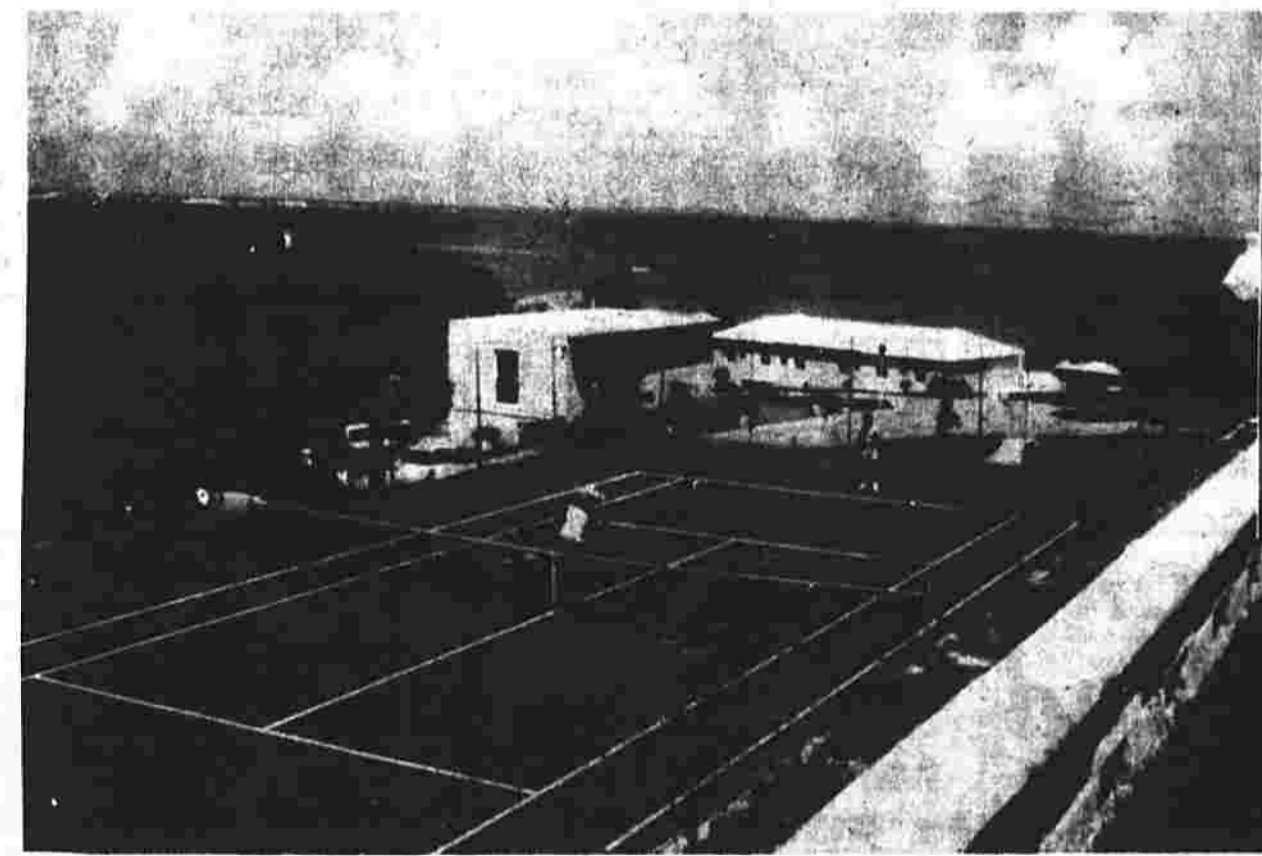

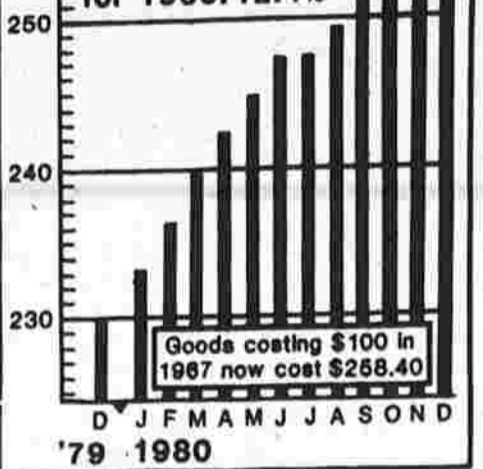

Stock market completes worst week in a month

NEW YORK (UPI) - Stock prices fell for the fifth consecutive session Friday and the market, which had looked forward to Ronald Reagan's presidency, wrapped up its worst week in a month.

As a result, the Dow Jones industrial average, up and down in a narrow range throughout the day following Thursday's 5.81-point loss, finally shed 0.26 point to 940.19.

For the week, the closely watched average skidded 33.10 points, the worst setback since it plunged 39.08 points the period ended Dec. 12, 1980.

Big Board volume totaled only 37,220,000 shares, down from the 39,880,000 traded Thursday in an indication that many big investors retreated to the sidelines.

Brokers said many investors abstained from action to await the Federal Reserve report released after the NYSE closed showing that the nation's money supply plunged \$1.7 billion in the latest statistical week.
