Why Reagan needs a strong England

Washington Merry-Go-Round

WASHINGTON — In World War II, the rock on which Adolf Hitler's dreams ultimately foundered was the close working relationships between Franklin Roosevelt and Winston Churchill. Now, 40 years later, Ronald Reagan and another British prime minister, Margaret Thatcher, seem to have arrived at a similar alliance against the threat of Soviet worldwide aggression.

Top White House advisers tell me that President Reagan is greatly encouraged by Thatcher's steadfast support of his anti-Soviet policies, and would be crushed if she showed signs of wavering, as, for example, our West German allies have done.

Margaret Thatcher's Britain. I sent my associate Dale Van Atta to London to gauge the depth of the British commitment. If the British are uncertain, the Reagan administration's foreign policy is in big trouble.

In addition, the British are cooperating on U.S. programs to upgrade joint nuclear missile forces so that the anti-ballistic missile defenses of Moscow can be penetrated — a vital deterrent to any Soviet plans for a first strike against the West.

What concerns the White House, though, is the political equation in Britain. Selective CIA analyses have warned that the Reagan-Thatcher love affair, like that of Roosevelt and Churchill in World War II, may be blown away.

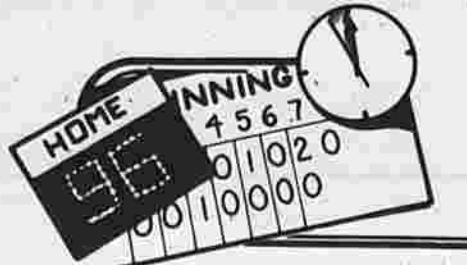

# Coupon-refund conventions fun, profitable

DEAR SUPERMARKET SHOPPER: I have enjoyed your columns describing all the gung-on-at conventions for coupon clippers and refunders.

Can you please tell me what it costs to attend a convention? What should I bring with me? How do people dress at a convention? Will a beginner like me be out of place? — Nancy D., Chicago.

Most conventions draw refunders from many cities and states. You will find a tremendous variety of coupons and refund forms that you never saw in your local supermarket.

Consider getting a photo album with clear plastic covering sheets to hold your forms in place. These albums are easy to flip through and your forms

will still be in good shape after hundreds of refunders have looked at them.

You will meet many refunders with whom you will want to trade forms in the future, most often by mail. Exchanging names and addresses is quick and easy if you have printed labels. If you don't, be sure to write up a dozen or two before the convention.

Anything goes in convention attire. The best advice is wear whatever is most comfortable. Pay particular attention to your shoes; the miles add up when you are walking around a convention hall.

Good conventions welcome beginners, and most offer special classes for those who are new to organized refunding. You will meet a lot of nice peo-

ple who will go out of their way to answer your questions, give you some help and get you started in the right direction.

The big convention season is swiftly approaching. I urge all my readers to try and attend a convention — even if it requires a few hours' drive. You will be glad you did.

Cup up the jelly roll in about 2-inch slices and lay in bottom of good-sized glass bowl. Drain can of fruit cocktail. Place fruit on top of jelly roll slices. Pour 1 cup sherry over all. Cover bowl with saran wrap and set aside. Dissolve the package of gelatin in 1 cup hot water then add and stir in 1 cup cold water and let cool to room temperature. When cooled sufficiently, pour gelatin over cake and other ingredients in bowl. Place in refrigerator until gelatin has congealed. Prepare the instant pudding according to package. Quickly pour over the other ingredients in bowl. Cover bowl and place back in refrigerator to let pudding mix congeal. Just before serving prepare the Dream Whip according to directions (I use both packages, Mrs. Foster said.) Spread the mixture over the top of bowl and garnish with cherries. Sliced almonds can also be used for garnish. This recipe makes a large bowl of trifle.

- 2 eggs
- 1 cup milk
- Sift together granulated sugar, baking powder, salt and flour. Add shortening and chop it in with pastry blender or silver knife. Add currants and stir until well-coated with flour.
- Beat eggs, add milk and stir into first mixture. Transfer to floured board and pat to one-half inch thickness. Cut in about 2-inch rounds. Bake in hot oven 400 degrees for 12 minutes. Serve hot or cold.

- Almond rice tarts**
- 2 eggs
- cherry jam
- 3 ounces of sugar
- 4 ounces of rice flour
- 3 ounces butter
- 1 teaspoon almond flavoring
- 1 cup chopped citron
- 1 cup chopped orange rind
- 1/2 cup chopped lemon rind
- 1 cup chopped walnuts
- 1/2 cups soft bread crumbs

- Soak raisins and currants in brandy for 10 minutes. Mix in other fruit and nuts and other ingredients.
- 1 ounce flour and mix well. Put 1/2 teaspoon cherry jam into unbaked tart shells, add mixture on top of jam. Then bake in 400 degree oven for 15 minutes.

- Make pastry as for pie
- 1 pound currants
- 3 tablespoons sugar
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 1 egg

- Wash the currants for five minutes, add the 3 tablespoons of sugar (or amount to taste). Mix the flour with a little water and add to the currants. Roll out pastry and spread on currant mixture. Cover top with pastry and prick with a fork. Brush with beaten egg. Sprinkle sugar on top and bake in 375 degree oven until nice and brown. When cool, cut into squares.

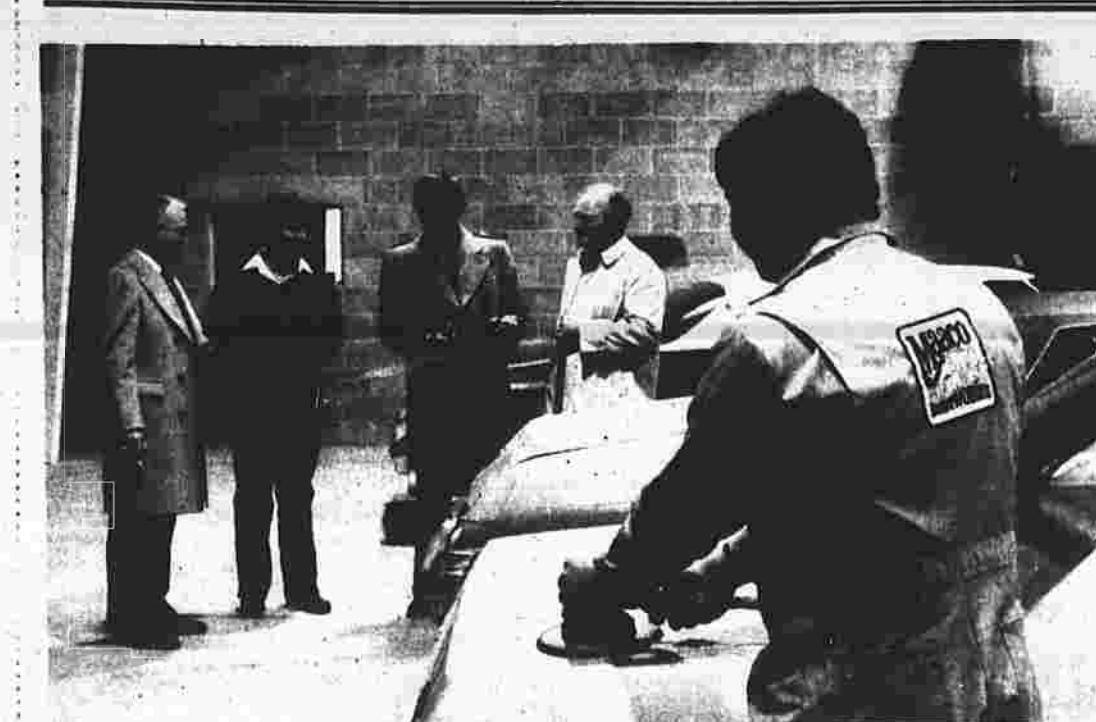

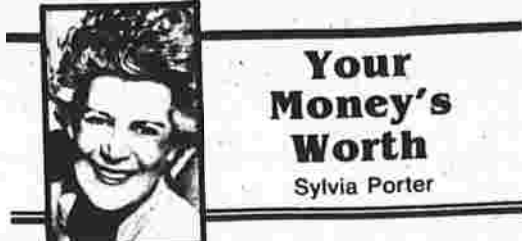
