### Mutual funds lend portfolio securities

**QUESTION:** At the annual meeting of the mutual fund in which I have invested, shareholders were asked to vote on two proposals to allow the fund to lend its portfolio securities. Both proposals were approved by majority vote of shares at the meeting. Enclosed are two pages from the annual meeting notice describing the proposals. I have read and reread them and get more confused each time. Any time anyone changes what I originally signed up for, it makes me leery. Is this a normal, safe way for a mutual fund to handle other people's money?

**ANSWER:** Put your worries to rest. An increasing number of mutual funds lend portfolio securities. Many funds have been doing it for years. It can be counted as a normal thing. It's also safe, if it's done judiciously. The pages you sent along show that's how your mutual fund will handle things. The fund will lend securities it owns only to solid broker-dealers, banks and other reputable institutions. And, when securities are put out on loan, the fund will receive 100 percent of their value in cash or U.S. government securities. The motive behind all this is to produce more income for the mutual fund. The fund will collect interest when it lends securities. That interest will be added to the other income the fund receives, as interest and/or dividends from the bonds and stocks it owns.

After deducting its operating costs, all the income a mutual fund receives is passed on to shareholders as dividends. Assuming your mutual fund collects a sizeable amount of interest on portfolio securities loans, your dividends will be increased. **QUESTION:** After my husband died, I went to a broker to invest the money my husband left. I told the broker I had to live on the income from investments. Another lady was with me and heard the tell him "I can't gamble." The broker had me invest \$55,000 in a high yield mutual fund and \$45,000 in an oil and gas fund. He told me I could sell these investments back in a short time. He didn't say I would get back only five cents on the dollar in the oil and gas fund, which is what would happen if I sold now. Furthermore, the broker never mentioned commis-

sions. I had sold real estate and was under the impression sellers pay commissions. Not so, the broker collected big commissions on my purchases. I would never have bought, if I had known about those commissions. I am 72 and may have to sell my house, because of the terrible financial situation the broker put me in. Is there anything I can do about this?

**ANSWER:** The broker was required to give you a copy of the mutual fund's prospectus before you made that investment. The same rule applies to the oil and gas fund, if that was a new offering. Commissions are spelled out in each prospectus. If the broker did not give you prospectus, you can try to nab him for that rule violation. You might also accuse him of not following the "suitability rule" by putting you into that highly speculative oil and gas fund. Some people can afford to take that kind of risk. Based on your letter, you can't.

You can complain to the Office of Consumer Affairs, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth St., N.W., Washington, DC 20549. But be aware that you will have to prove the broker acted improperly. It's going to be his word against yours and your lady friend's.

### State to review practices of insurance firms

**HARTFORD (UPI)** — State Insurance Commissioner Peter W. Gillies says he will send examiners into the field to determine if insurance companies and their agencies are using improper marketing practices.

Gillies said the Insurance Department has resolved some complaints where companies improperly canceled policies or lines of insurance or failed to give adequate notice to customers before canceling coverage.

The commissioner said he now wants to know if the problems are isolated or widespread and will conduct the insurance marketing practices review dealing with commercial insurance sold in Connecticut.

"I can't simply sit back and wait for the telephone to ring," Gillies said at a news conference Wednesday. "I simply want to give notice to the companies — be on the lookout, we're coming."

The effort will involve review of cancellation and non-renewal practices and cost and pricing practices as well as on-site audits at insurance firms to compare actual pricing with filed rate schedules and plans.

Gillies also said he is asking Gov. William A. O'Neill to include about \$200,000 in the Insurance Department budget for the next fiscal year to create a permanent unit to monitor insurance marketing practices.
