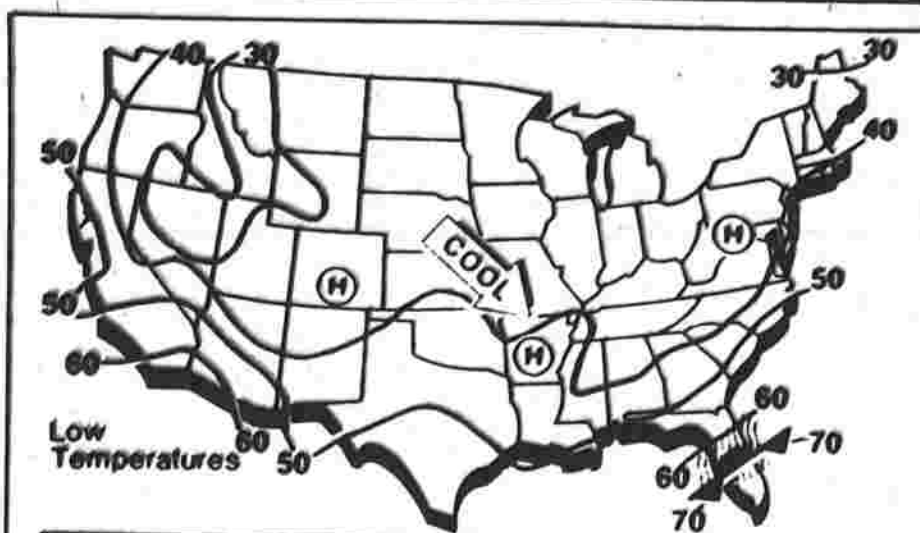

Up to 4 inches of snow fell in northern Michigan on Tuesday, but it was melting quickly and was expected to be wiped out by temperatures in the 40s today.

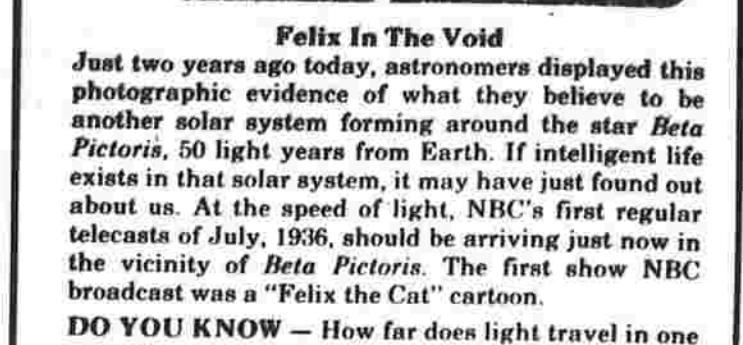

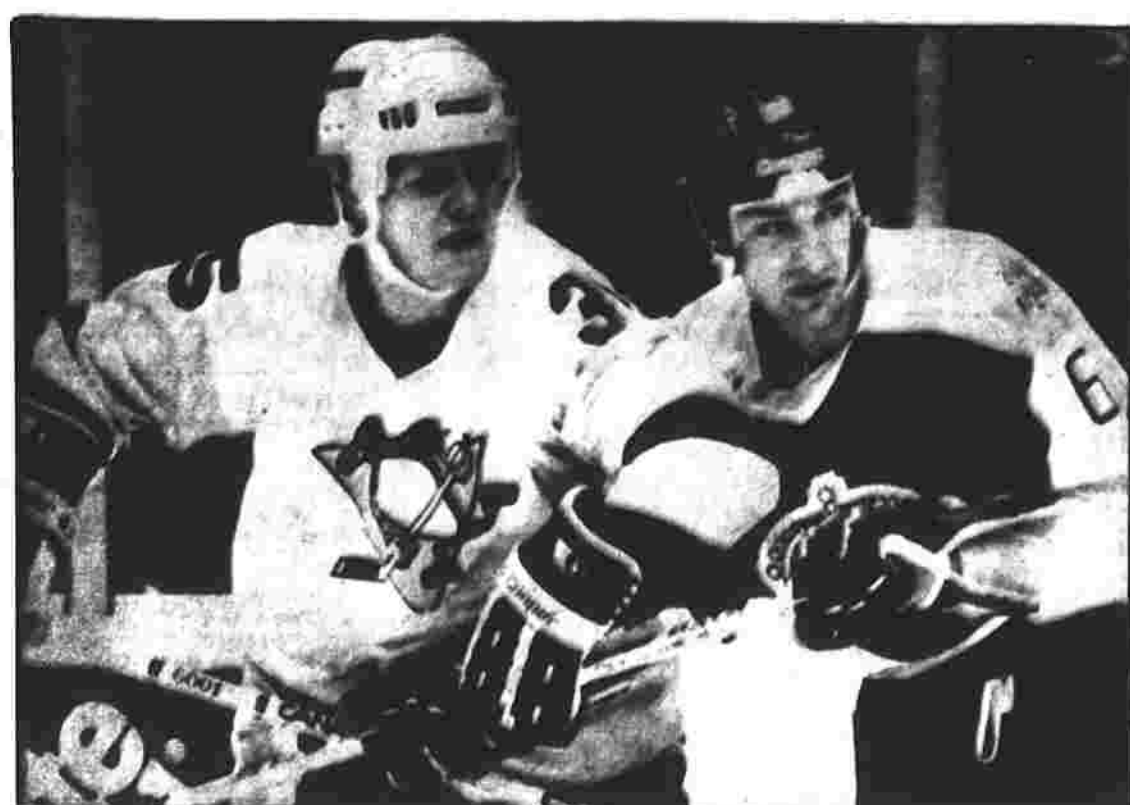
