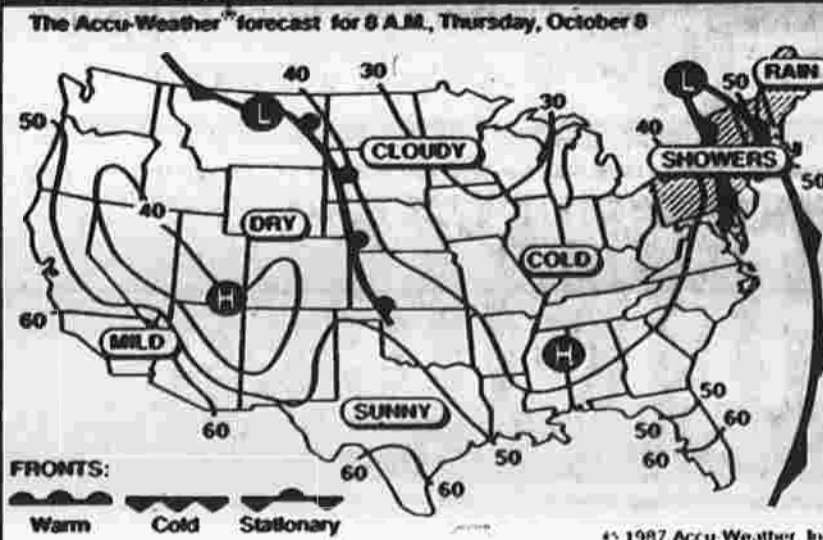
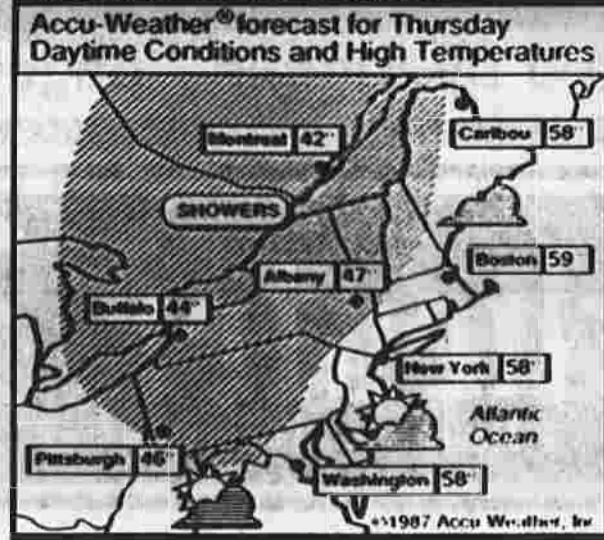

Winter in Midwest, rest of nation fair

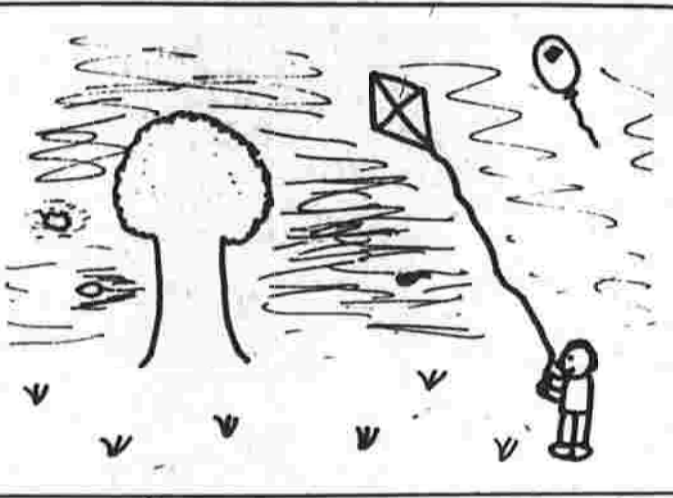
Sleet, freezing rain and snow fell in the Midwest today, while broad sections of the rest of the nation were under fair skies.

Partly cloudy skies prevailed in the Pacific Northwest, but skies were mostly clear across the Rockies and into California.

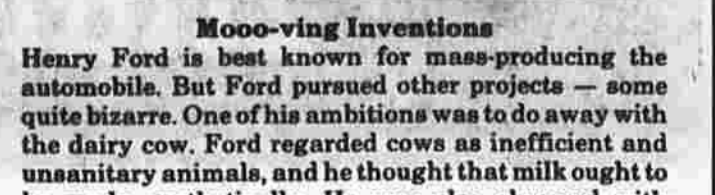

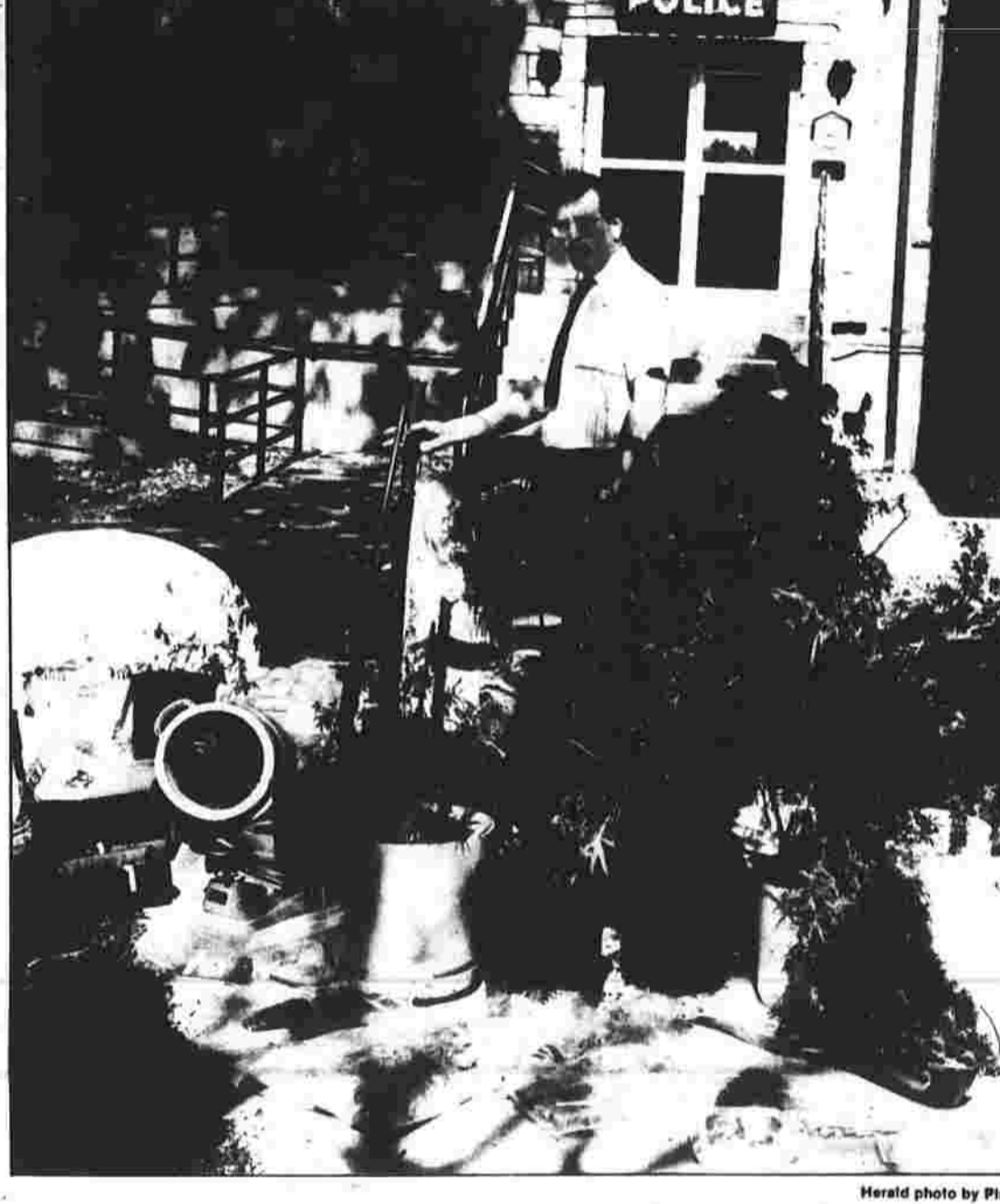

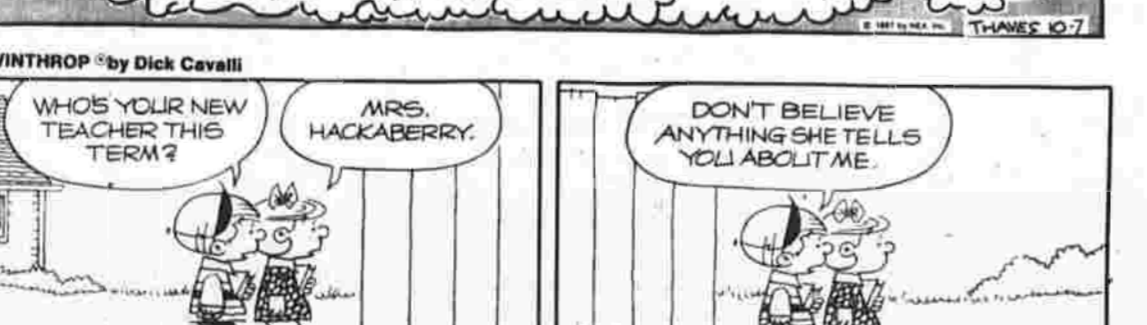

Analysts unfazed as stocks tumble

NEW YORK (AP) - Stocks tumbled in a selling spree that wiped nearly 100 points from the Dow Jones industrial average, Wall Street's biggest one-day drop ever, but analysts were unfazed by what amounted to a \$73 billion paper loss.

The previous record for a one-day drop in the closely-watched average was on Sept. 11, 1986, when it skidded 86.61 points.

As a percentage of the Dow, however, Tuesday's decline didn't compare with Black Tuesday, the worst day in Wall Street history. On Oct. 28, 1929, in the middle of the Great Crash, the average fell 38.33, closing at 260.84 for a loss of 12.9 percent.

Congress learns creative accounting

NEW YORK - Creative accounting is an amazing tool in the hands of corrupt executives, dishonest accountants and common thieves.

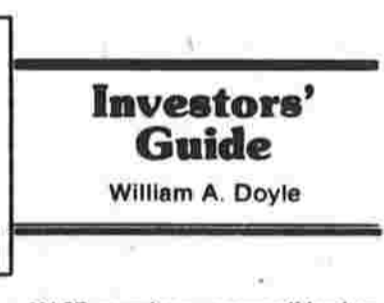
