BOSTON (AP) - Mike Greenwell took over the BOSTON (AP) - Mike Greenwell tor league RBI lead by driving in three runs, major league RBI lead by driving in three
including the game-winner in the seventh inning, to lead the Boston Red Sox past the Oakiand Athletics 7-6 Friday night.
Greenwell finished the game with 96 runs batted in, two more than Oakland's Jose Canseco, wh didn't drive in any runs for the American Leagu With the sco
With the score tied 6-6, Marty Barrett began the relieved starter Dave Stewart. 15-11. Barrett went to third on Dwight Evans' sacrifice bunt and scored on Greenwell's single.
The A's had tied the score in the top of the inning on back-to-back solo homers by Luis Polonia and Dave Henderson, his 19th, to chase starter Mike pitched $21-3$ innings for the victory, allowing one hit. It was the first time this season Henderson homered in a game and the A's did not win.
Boston erased a 4-1 deficit with five runs in the fifth. With one out, Rich Gedman singled, took second on a walk to Wade Boggs and scored on Barrett's single. Greenwell then lined a single to center, scoring Boggs and Barrett. Henderson's throw to the plate bounced off catcher Terry Stelnbach, who was charged with an error that allowed Evans to score and Greenwell to reach third. Greenwell came home on a groundout by Ellis Burks
Don Baylor's sixth homer of the year, a two-run shot in the fourth, and Henderson's sacrifice fly after Polonia's triple put Oakland ahead $4-1$ in the fifth.
Oakland had taken a 1-0 lead on consecutive doubles by Walt Weiss and Polonia in the third. Boggs' single and Barrett's run-scoring double tied the score in the bottom of the inning.

## Yankees 5, Mariners 3 (10 Innings)

NEW YORK (AP) - Former Mariner Ken Phelps hit a two-run homer in the 10th inning to give the New York Yankees a 5-3 victory over Seattle in the first game of a doubleheader Friday
Phelps' homer came after Dave Winfield had singled with one out off reliever Mike Schooler, 4-5. It was Phelps July 21 for Jay Buhner.
Phelps' home run was an opposite field drive to left field and broke off the glove of Mickey Brantley who tried to make a leaping catch over the fence. Dave Righetti, 4-3, pitched two innings of one-hi relief for the win
The victory broke a streak of six consecutive extra-inning losses for the $Y$ ankees.
New York tied the score 3-3 with two runs in the eighth inning on Phelps' RBI single and a bases-loaded wild pitch by Schooler. With the bases
