NEW DELHI, India — An Indian Airlines Boeing 737 crashed in thick fog and killed 139 people today, officials said. About an hour later, a propeller plane leased from Indian Airlines crashed in heavy rain, and all 34 aboard were feared dead.

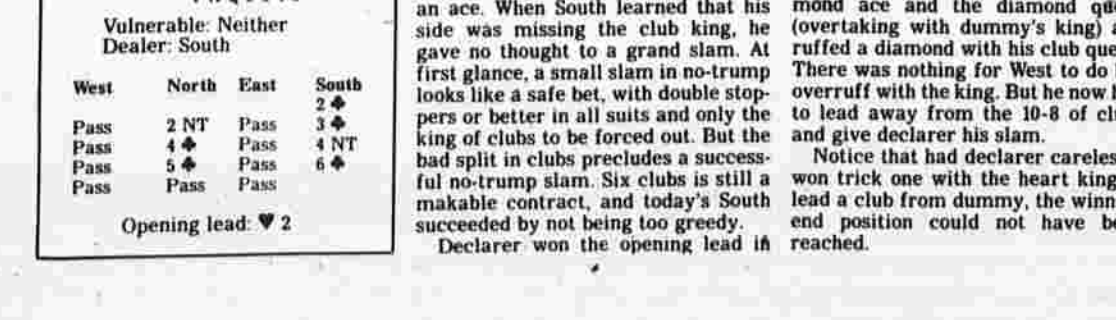

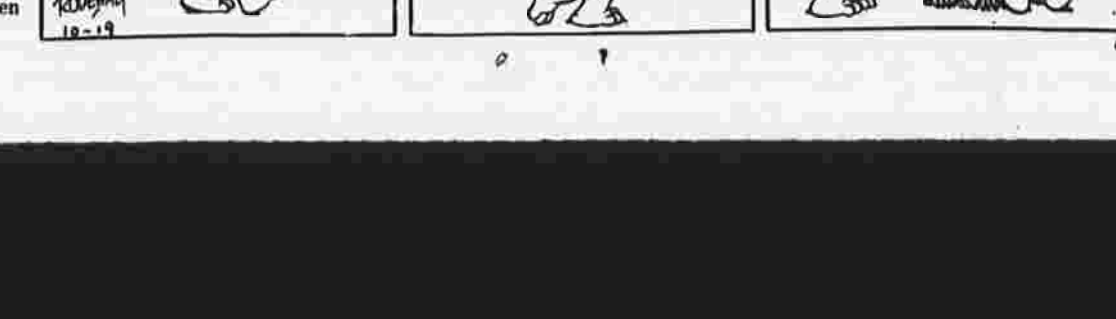
