Abortion rightists claim they have foes on the run

WASHINGTON (AP) — Abortion rights leaders claim an "unprecedented turnaround" is putting anti-abortion forces on the political run following defeats in the U.S. House and a special legislative session in Florida.

And in Virginia, Democratic candidate for governor Douglas Wilder is challenging political wisdom on abortion by airing pro-choice television ads aimed at winning support among conservative voters.

"This is evidence that the anti-choice minority no longer inspires fear in elected officials," said Kate Michelman, executive director of the National Abortion Rights Action League.

The House voted 216-206 on Wednesday to allow federal aid for abortions for poor women who are victims of rape or incest, rejecting Medicaid restrictions it has kept in the law since 1981. It instead backed more liberal provisions already passed by the Senate.

The vote was a defeat for conservatives and put Congress in opposition to President Bush, who has promised to veto Medicaid abortions.

Rep. Patricia Schroeder, D-Colo., attributed the vote to an abortion rights movement galvanized by the Supreme Court's decision in July giving the states more power to restrict abortions.

"The Webster decision was a wakeup call," she said.

Rep. Henry Hyde, R-Ill., for years the leader of anti-abortion forces in the House, said House members are increasingly "perceiving their constituencies as pro-choice."

Darla St. Martin, leader of the National Right to Life Committee, said the vote "opens the door to the use of tax funds to destroy innocent

U.S. believes Olivetti illegally sold technology

WASHINGTON (AP) — The United States is asking Italy to investigate allegations that an Italian company violated Western export control rules and sold the Soviet Union computer equipment used to manufacture a highly sophisticated jet fighter.

The U.S. case regarding the Italian company Olivetti, which officials say is based on intelligence information, was brought up Wednesday at a White House meeting between President Bush and Italian President Francesco Cossiga.

"The President did mention the concern about the Olivetti case. And President Cossiga stressed that this was being pursued in a highly cooperative manner," said Assistant Secretary of State Raymond Setz, briefing reporters about Cossiga's talks with Bush.

The United States notified Italy earlier this month that Olivetti, one of Europe's largest computer companies, was suspected of violating rules set by the 17-nation Coordinating Committee of Multilateral Ex-

States resist plan to store N- waste

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Bush administration is meeting stiff resistance to its plan to spread plutonium-contaminated waste from the Rocky Flats nuclear weapons plant among seven states in order to avert a plant shutdown early next year.

White House chief of staff John Sununu and Energy Department officials urged the seven governors and members of the states' congressional delegations Wednesday to temporarily handle equal amounts of waste from the Rocky Flats plant next year.

"My answer is absolutely not," said Rep. Bill Derrick, D-S.C., whose district includes the Savannah River weapons plant that is among the sites targeted by the Energy Department for interim storage of the radioactive waste.

"The Energy Department doesn't know the definition of the word 'temporary,'" Derrick said in an interview. He noted 35 million gallons of radioactive waste have been stored "temporarily" at Savannah River, near Aiken, S.C., for decades.

Most of the seven states — Idaho, Colorado, New Mexico, Nevada, South Carolina, Tennessee and Washington — had indicated earlier this week they would not accept any of the waste, which contains plutonium that remains radioactive for 240,000 years.

Palme verdict dismissed

STOCKHOLM, Sweden (AP) — An appeals court today threw out the conviction of a 42-year-old career criminal accused of fatally shooting Prime Minister Olof Palme three years ago, the national TT news agency reported.

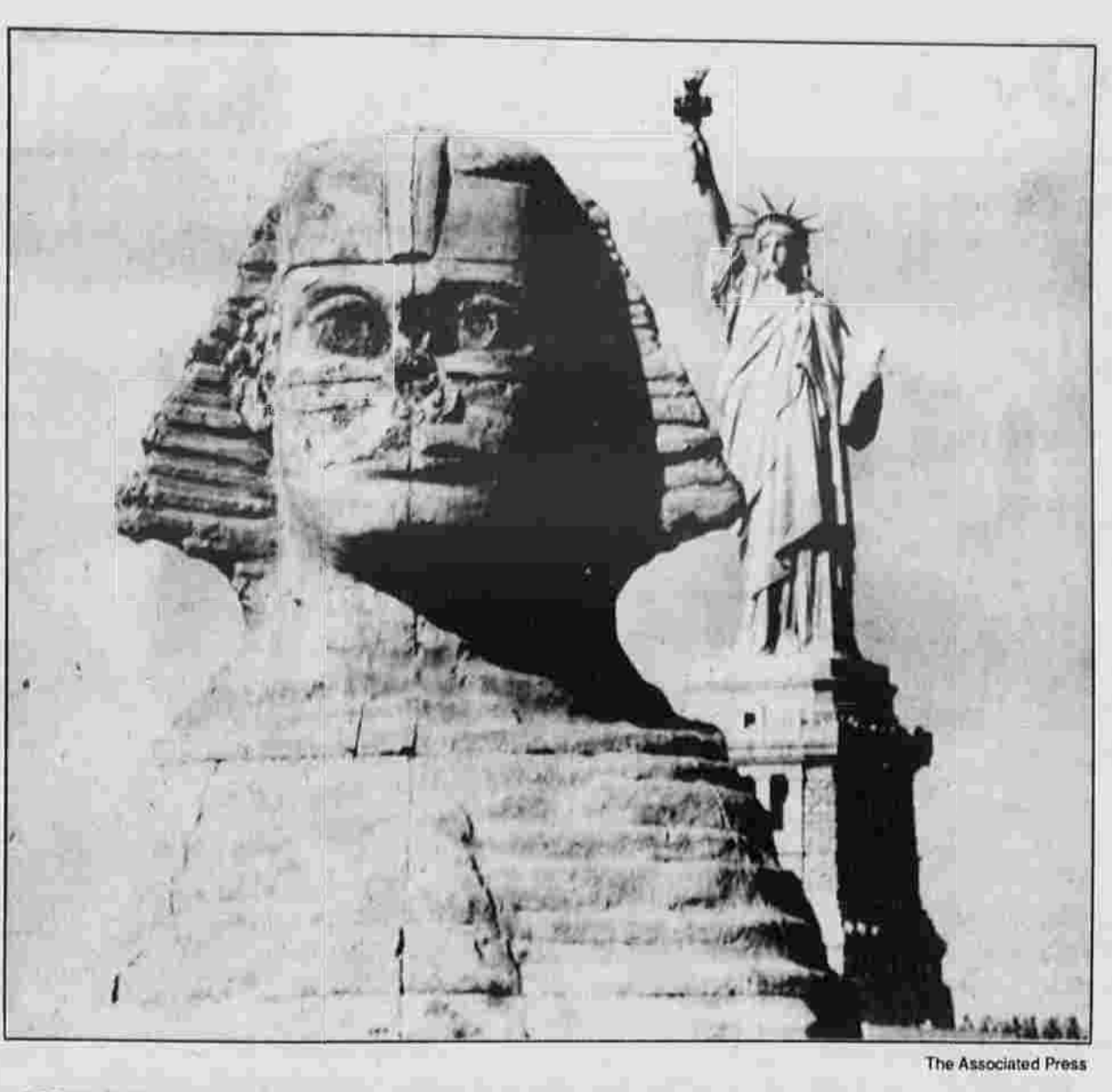
The Svea Court of Appeals ruled that there was not enough evidence to show that Christer Pettersson stalked and killed Palme as the popular Swedish leader walked out of a movie theater with his wife Feb. 28, 1986.

The decision is the culmination of a sensational case that authorities have been accused of bungling since its inception. Police for a year pursued a series of vastly different conspiracy theories before prosecuting Pettersson, a drug and alcohol abuser with a long and varied criminal record.

Pettersson was convicted in July even though no motive was ever established, no weapon was found and no witnesses testified to seeing the Swede fire five shots at the dynamic leader on a darkened street.

Pettersson has been jailed since December and was to be freed immediately, Erik Hansson, an administrative official of the Svea Court of Appeals, was quoted by the news agency as saying.

Pettersson's three-week appeal hearing was presided over by a jury of three laymen and four professional jurors. The hearing ended Monday.

RNA, time studies win Nobels

STOCKHOLM, Sweden (AP) — The Nobel Prize in physics was awarded today to two Americans and a West German whose work led to the atomic clock as an international standard. The chemistry prize went to an American and a Canadian for the discovery of surprising properties of the genetic material RNA.

The physics award was given to Norman F. Ramsey of Harvard University for the atomic clock used as the international time standard and to Hans G. Dehmelt of the University of Washington and Wolfgang Paul for a method to isolate single atoms and make exacting measurements of them.

The recipients of the Nobel Prize in chemistry were Thomas Cech, 41, of the University of Colorado, and Canadian Sidney Altman, 50, of Yale University, who showed independently in the 1970s and early 1980s that RNA, then thought to be merely a genetic messenger, could actively aid chemical reactions.

Their discovery "will probably provide a new tool for gene technology, with potential to create a new defense against viral infections," the Swedish Academy said. They will share the \$669,000 prize.

Half of the physics prize, worth the same amount, will go to Ramsey, 74, of Harvard University. The other half will be shared by the German-born

Protesters, police clash in front of Pope's altar

DILI, Indonesia (AP) — Banner-waving youths opposed to Indonesian rule of East Timor fought the Vatican and Indonesian bodyguards, moved toward his car.

From there he went directly to the airport as scheduled and flew off to Jakarta, capital of Indonesia, the world's most populous Moslem country. After he left, youths began to chant "Viva Fretelin!"

Dili General Hospital reported four women admitted after the incident, all of whom had been battered by the surging crowd.

There was no immediate report of arrests.

Girl Scouts, who had been serving as ushers in front of the altar, wept as they were caught up in the clash. The incident lasted about 15 minutes. The crowd then left the duty area peacefully.

Security at the Mass was tight and provided by unarmed police and militia. The Indonesian army, which has a garrison of 13,000 in East Timor, was apparently not deployed. Indonesia admits to having suffered "hundreds of casualties" in the guerrilla war over the territory.

Portugal ruled for 450 years. Indonesia had dismissed the strength of the separatist guerrillas, saying only 200 remain in the hinterland.

In his homily, the pope made no direct mention of Indonesian rule, which is not recognized by the Vatican, but referred instead to "those who are responsible for life in East Timor."

Latin nations weigh Panama sanction

ICA, Peru (AP) — Two Latin American presidents broke with tradition at a regional summit and denounced Panama's government, which Gen. Manuel Antonio Noriega effectively heads, as a dictatorship.

Peru's Alan Garcia, host of the meeting that ends tonight, used his opening remarks to "express publicly his concern over the military dictatorship" of Noriega.

Peru and Garcia's condemnations broke with the traditional reluctance of Group of Eight nations to publicly denounce a member at such meetings.

The summit began a day after Garcia, Colombia's Virgilio Barco and Bolivia's Jaime Paz Zamora agreed to invite President Bush to a drug summit in Latin America that would take place within 90 days. Bush accepted immediately.

The three Andean nations are the source of nearly all of the world's cocaine.

Perez and the other presidents made clear Wednesday they did not share Bush's focus on police action as the best way to fight the drug trade.

"The more demand grows in the North, the more production will grow in the South. Police actions will be useless unless demand is reduced," Perez said.

"The problem is not only in Medellin," said President Santiago of Uruguay, referring to the Colombian city that is home to the world's largest cocaine cartel. "It is also in the streets of New York City."

The Medellin cartel has virtually been at war with the Colombian government since suspected drug assassins killed the country's leading presidential candidate Aug. 18.

Future of car's headlights promises to be even brighter

If you're like me, you probably don't give your car's headlights much thought — at least not until one of them burns out. And even then, under bright city lights you might not notice.

Who hasn't gotten in their car after making a nighttime run to the local 7-Eleven for a fresh supply of beer mats, and then driven a block or two before realizing they had forgotten to turn the headlights? You could see OK without them, right?

In urban areas, it seems the main benefit of headlights is that they can annoy fellow motorists by driving with your high beams on. But try driving on a rural, uncrowded highway some dark and moonless night — suddenly good headlights take on new meaning.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) has decreed that a car's high beams can emit a maximum of 150,000 "candela" (a measure of brightness). That may seem like a lot of candles, but it's only enough to illuminate a human-sized object at 530 feet on a dark night.

Yet, as John Tomerlin points out in the October issue of Road & Track, the braking distance of a car traveling at typical highway speeds is very little less than 530 feet. And that assumes ideal conditions of good weather, an alert driver and headlights and brakes in optimum working order. There's little room for error.

Professional models have the feel of a precision tool and are typically light in weight to minimize fatigue. They often have two worthwhile features: an adjustable clutch, which stops the bit from turning once the screw is driven.

Other tested models, not as powerful as the top two, are still fine for moderately demanding tasks, such as installing hinges. Good choices are the attractively priced Weller 225, \$25, and the pencil style Skil Super Torq 2210, \$42. Also worth considering are the AEG E2502 and the essentially similar Milwaukee 6539-1, both \$108. They are hinged to switch from pencil to pistol shape.

Keep Your Car Alive

Enter halogen headlights. Though they had been used in Europe since the 1960s, halogen headlights only received NHTSA approval in 1980. The bulb in a halogen headlight is filled with halogen gas — iodine, bromine, chlorine, fluorine or argon. Unlike the old sealed beam headlights, which produce a yellowish light, halogen headlights give an intense white light. And just as important, halogen headlights don't darken over time the way standard sealed beams do.

There is a downside (an) there always is. Though some cars now use sealed beam halogen headlights, the typical halogen light assembly is made up of separate components. Either way, halogens are expensive. The bulb alone can cost more than an entire standard sealed beam headlamp or as much as \$50. Lenses and reflectors can run another \$200 to \$300 for most late model cars. That can make a front-end fender-bender all the more expensive.

But the future of headlights promises to be even brighter. Robert Bosch Inc. is working on a super-efficient headlamp. Enclosed in a "polyellipsoidal" envelope, this headlamp has a front area about the size of a business card. And barring crash damage, its bulb will last the life of the car. A recent Pontiac concept car used a bulb containing 16 of these mini-headlamps, running parallel to the front bumper, to meet lighting requirements.

Not all screwdrivers are alike

Driving screws for an hour or so with a standard screwdriver can be torturous, even for the most adept do-it-yourselfer. The cordless screwdriver does the work faster and easier. Introduced only a few years ago, it is now the best-selling battery-powered tool, appealing to both professionals and ordinary homeowners.

Recently, Consumer Reports' engineers tested both "professional" screwdrivers, which sell for \$100 and up, and lower-priced models which are meant for light-duty, off-and-on jobs around the house.

Professional models have the feel of a precision tool and are typically light in weight to minimize fatigue. They often have two worthwhile features: an adjustable clutch, which stops the bit from turning once the screw is driven far enough and a removable battery pack. Hobbyist screwdrivers aren't as solidly constructed as the typical professional model, even though some may have more power. If a hobbyist model has an adjustable clutch (few do), it may not be as sturdy. Typically, it comes with charging stand instead of a removable battery pack. When it wears down, you have to wait several hours for it to recharge. The worst homeowner models, priced at \$20 to \$30, are often stimpily made — you might think some were toys.

Because and underpowered tool is often worse than no tool at all, the cordless screwdrivers were rated primarily on their power capacity. Every model tested developed enough twisting power — or torque — to drive some screws, but not every screwdriver had sufficient torque to handle demanding tasks.

DEAR DR. GOTT: A 13-year-old nephew suffers from a brachial cleft cyst that is the size of a tennis ball. What is the cause, result of surgery and the outlook for him?

DEAR READER: The developing embryo has five strands of flesh, called brachial arches, that eventually grow to form the upper and lower jaws, portions of the neck and the cartilage beneath the thyroid gland. These arches are separated by grooves or clefts.

For unknown reasons, parts of these primitive structures may remain after a person has fully developed. The remnants fill with fluid and appear as soft, painless cysts beneath the angle of the jaw. Although they do not represent an illness or a health hazard, they can be unsightly.

Surgical removal is the recommended treatment for brachial cleft cysts. Simple drainage is not appropriate because the cysts re-form. The operation is quite standard, and the results are uniformly successful. Your nephew would probably be grateful to have the cyst removed.

DEAR DR. GOTT: Can you provide information on neurofibromatosis? I have it, my five children have it, and now my grandson has a tumor on his brain.

DEAR READER: Neurofibromatosis (von Recklinghausen's disease) is an uncommon, inherited affliction associated with nerve tumors, bone deformities and peculiar, tan (cafe-au-lait) spots of the skin. The disease is serious because the nerve tumors can grow, causing weakness, deafness or blindness.

Treatment consists of surgical removal of the tumors or radiation therapy to shrink them. Because neurofibromatosis is inherited, it is genetically transmitted to children as the case in your family. Adults with the disease should have genetic counseling before choosing to have a family.

I wonder if your grandson's brain tumor may be yet another manifestation of von Recklinghausen's disease. Ask your doctor about this. Perhaps the youngster could benefit from radiation therapy, without the need for surgery.

DEAR DR. GOTT: Our 6-year-old granddaughter is losing her hair. It is coming out steadily and getting worse. She loves fruits and vegetables and is not fond of sweets. Thyroid tests are negative. Her doctors suggest we wait and see. Please help.

DEAR READER: Children often go through stages when they lose excessive amounts of hair. This can result from fever and illness, for example. If your granddaughter is in other ways healthy, I think you can ease the doctors' advice to wait for new hair to grow. If, after a few weeks, the hair loss continues, ask for a referral to a dermatologist. The child could have a scalp condition — eczema, for instance — that could cause hair loss and would need treatment.

In Rolling Stone magazine's November issue, Hall said that when Jay Leno was selected as Carson's substitute host, "I thought it should have been me." Hall has long admired Carson and dreamed of being host of "The Tonight Show." "He was the guy," Hall said of Carson. "Even when he wasn't funny, he looked good. I had to cry to my mother for one pair of sneakers, but what I really wanted was a Johnny Carson suit." Hall praised Leno, saying "Jay Leno is one of the last pure stand-up left."

Graham wins award LOS ANGELES (AP) — The Salvation Army honored televangelist Billy Graham, awarding the preacher its highest humanitarian award. Graham was given the William Booth Award on Wednesday in recognition of four decades of ministry and crusades, said Lt. Col. David Riley, Salvation Army Southern California division commander.

"People are finding today that materialism doesn't satisfy," Graham said, describing the world's spiritual hunger. Today, Graham is out of the fund-raising dinner for the homeless. Graham's "The Hour of Decision" hit the airwaves in 1950 and is broadcast on 500 U.S. stations and several hundred overseas. On Sunday, Graham is scheduled to become the first clergyman to receive a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, said his spokesman A. Larry Ross.

Jackson goes back to school LOS ANGELES (AP) — Michael Jackson's homecoming excited Gardner Street Elementary School pupils, who watched as the pop music superstar helped dedicate a remodeled auditorium named in his honor.

"This is the happiest day of my life," said Jackson, a sixth-grader at the Hollywood school during the 1969-70 school year. Jackson, wearing a leather outfit covered in zippers, studs and buckles, arrived at the school Wednesday to students' squeals of "Michael! 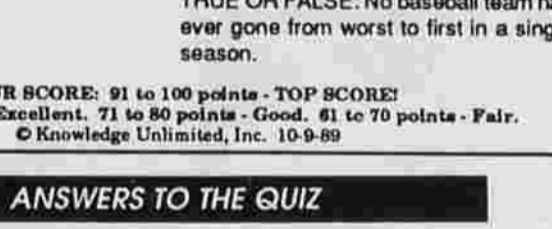
