## Students receive \$113,060 in scholarships

MANCHESTER — Community leaders, scholarship recipients, and proud parents gathered in Manchester Community College's Lowe Program Center Wednesday night for the Manchester Scholarship Foundation's annual awards ceremony. The Foundation awarded \$113,060 in scholarships, the largest amount in its history.

Catholic High School and M.C.C. received scholarships in the two-hour ceremony which included singing by the M.H.S. Round Table Singers and the Silk City Chorus.

The humor of Richard T. Carter, foundation president, lightened the event. "It's a happy time for everyone," said Carter, who presided over the ceremony. "Students are getting the devil out, and parents are ending one segment of life and beginning another."

Students graduating from Manchester High School, East

Carter also had a word of advice for the scholarship recipients. "Somewhere down the line, whatever community you're in, give something back."

Those receiving scholarships had their names read individually by Foundation Director William Johnson and their awards presented to them by representatives of the various organizations and memorials granting scholarships. Many students from East Catholic could not attend because of that school's Senior Class Night. Those who could not attend had their parents accept their awards for them.

MANCHESTER — Manchester High School graduate and soon-to-be University of Connecticut student Un Baek, recently awarded over \$2,000 in scholarship money from the Manchester Scholarship Foundation, believes that anyone can achieve if they put their mind to it.

"I believe that if you study hard and push yourself, if you're white, black, Oriental, or whatever, you can get it," Linda said.

Back, a Korean immigrant who likes to be called Linda, received money from the Albert T. & Jane N. Dewey Memorial Scholarship, North United Methodist Church Scholarship, Manchester Education Association Scholarship, and the Manchester Association for Retarded Citizens Scholarship.

Back was born in Seoul, South Korea, and emigrated to the United States with her family ten years ago, when she was eight. When asked if she had trouble learning English, she just smiles.

"Oh yeah," she said, "but I think it helped me to make friends with Americans."

Back hopes to use her scholarship money to help her turn her in-

terest in helping retarded children. She developed this interest while working part-time at a supermarket.

"I worked at the courtesy desk and some retarded people were employed as baggers," she said. "I like being with them, they're very affectionate. They like to hug and kiss you and I like that."

Her teachers in high school were a source of inspiration for Linda, particularly Lew Irving, a counselor, Mrs. Don, and English teacher, and Ron Courmyer, a Social Studies teacher.

"Mr. Irving, a multi-cultural advisor, is very motivating and doesn't allow you to give up easily. He's always saying, 'Linda, strive for the best, don't strive for the least.' He's helpful with kids who are in trouble. He wants them to be in school."

Back will start college in the fall but will get a head start by studying English and math in summer school. While at UConn she plans to join a sorority and become active in the Korean student organization.

In the long run, however, Back said she'd like to return to Manchester and show the town and the Scholarship Foundation the rewards of her labor.
