Timothy Cheney built the Homestead c.1785 with his young son, George.
Six of George & Electa's sons formed the Cheney Mills; the family then developed the "village" of South Manchester. 13 mansions & notable buildings remain, built (or reimagined) by those 6 sons, their children and/or grandchildren.
Properties are shown in a genealogical format but *not* in specific chronological order/by birth of owner, construction date or geographical proximity to one another.
