On the Sw-548 exchange ship Gripsholm, leaving the ship at Boston where he offered his services to the Nazis. Hoover said he was enrolled in the Elite Guard and sent to school in Berlin. The Hague and Dresden where he was taught radio, photography and use of explosives.

Gimpel was arrested in Lima, Peru, while working for a German radio firm and was interned in Texas until repatriated to Germany where he continued radio work until joining the Elite Guard for training similar to Codelpa's.

84 Days Crossing Atlantic

Hoover said the two men sailed from Kiel, Germany, in U-boat 1230 on Sept. 26. The trip across the Atlantic took 84 days, he added, as the submarine submerged in daylight hours and surfaced only at night.

The FBI chief said he was certain no other agents linked with Codelpa and Gimpel.

Still Continuing Investigation

The FBI director said investigations of the two men still was going on.

Although Hoover declined to say how the FBI learned of the men's activities, Deputy Sheriff Dana Hodges of Hancock Point said his 17-year-old son, Harvard, spotted the two men walking on a road near his home.

How to take good care of your electric refrigerator

- Let foods cool. Steaming hot foods should not be placed in the refrigerator.
- Don't overload refrigerator. Jamming food into compartments prevents free circulation of air.
- Remove ice trays carefully. Using a sharp instrument to pry or force trays free may chip or puncture the freezing compartment and entail costly repairs.
- Defrost regularly. When frost is more than one-fourth inch thick, it's time to defrost. Clean the coils with warm water and baking soda to remove odors, (one teaspoonful to three quarts).
- Maintain even temperature. Your refrigerator was designed to preserve foods—don't freeze them. Running it on "HIGH" can damage the foods as well as overwork the motor.
- Don't try to fix it yourself. If your motor runs more than one-third of the time, it probably needs repairs. But call a reliable serviceman. Amateur "tinkling" can wreck expensive parts.
