Anti-Bias Bill Sent Dewey

Albany, N. Y., March 6.—(AP)—A law by which New York employers actually exercising religious or racial prejudice in selecting workers, base fines and imprisonment will go on the statute books after early passage by Gov. Thomas E. Dewey.

Legislative action on what both supporters and opponents termed "the most drastic measure ever enacted in the United States" was completed last night when the Senate voted the bill, 49 to 6. The Assembly approved the proposal last week, 100-32.

Dewey, 1944 Republican presidential nominee, threw his support behind the bill which was passed with unanimous minority Democratic support in both houses. Individual Republicans strongly opposed the proposal, although G.O.P. leaders were favorable.

Following Senate action, Dewey termed passage of the bill a historic act. He said "I am happy indeed that our state has led the entire nation in this great social advance which will assure equality of opportunity for all our people regardless of race, creed, color, or national origin."

Although the new law is directed equally against labor unions, employment agencies and employers, and makes violation a misdemeanor, punishable by \$500 fine and a year imprisonment, it also contains provisions for the application to employers, individuals or firms employing fewer than six persons are exempt as are religious, charitable, social and fraternal organizations.

The law will be enforced by a five-member commission, which will be empowered to order hearings upon complaint of any person, considering himself discriminated against. If mediation fails, a "cease and desist" order may be issued. This may be followed by judicial review upon filing of misdemeanor charges.

Debate in both legislative houses followed the same general pattern. Opponents all said they opposed discrimination, but asserted that "goodness cannot be legislated." Supporters held the key to the problem, and that enactment of the law would advance religious and racial prejudice, by emphasizing them.
