Local Salvage Breaks Record

Nearly 31 Tons of Cans Collected Here Last Week; Largest Yet.

Chairman Stuart J. Wasey, of the local tin can salvage committee, today announced that in the drive last Friday and Saturday in Manchester, a total of 61,000 pounds of tin had been collected. This is 40 pounds above 21 tons and is, by far, the largest contribution during the extensive drive that has covered Manchester every other month.

The tin cans were collected and delivered to the Salvage Depot in Hartford. To date local housewives have contributed a total of 432,040 pounds which amounts to a grand total of 27 tons.

Expressive Hils Thanks Chairman Wasey for his efforts to thank the people of Manchester for their splendid cooperation in helping and saving the cans from such a vital cause. The cans were a waste in a proper and dignified and favorable comments were received from the Hartford Salvage committee.

The collection is well above the average for towns of the size of Manchester per pound and the recent collection exceeds the previous collection by 600 pounds.

The tin can collection date for Manchester has been set for May 21, 1948.
