With Top 100 Billions

The last payments today on 1944 income are expected to bring revenue for the three war years considerably above \$100,000,000,000, which congressional experts said was more than the aggregate of all prior taxes collected since the nation was constituted.

Of the 1944 collections, around \$17,000,000,000 will be from individual incomes. The remainder comes chiefly from corporation taxes and excise levies on such items as liquor, cigarettes and automobiles.

Prior to enactment of the first individual income tax in 1913, the government was financed chiefly by levies on liquor and tobacco. The latter, however, in 1937 the liquor tax yielded 30.6 per cent of all government revenues.
