War Casualties

List of Connecticut Men, Dead, Wounded or Missing, As Released by the War and Navy Departments Today. These Reports Are Based on Information Received from the War and Navy Departments. Names of Men and Casualties Noted Here Previously Have Been Reported in the News Columns.

Army Casualties for March 29, 1945: The War Department casualty list, Serial Number O-38 (European wounded), O-39 (Pacific wounded), O-37 (prisoners of war in Germany), and O-38 (Pacific killed), announces for the United States a total of 4,989 casualties for March 29, 1945, classified as follows: 141 killed, 3,208 wounded, and 1,589 prisoners of war.

The Navy Department announces for the United States as a whole 248 casualties for March 29, 1945, of the U. S. Naval Forces (Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard) not heretofore released on Navy Department total casualty lists, consisting of 148 dead, 61 wounded, and 39 missing. These casualties bring the total reported to next of kin and released since December 7, 1941, to March 29, 1945, to 93,064, classified as follows:

Dead: 24,452; Missing: 13,619; Wounded: 2,378; Prisoners of War: 10,683; 28,222; 1,187; 42,132; 588; 210; 295; 0; 1,103.

So what we are finding in Germany is actually a confusing mass of contradictions. There are Germans of all shades of past behavior, of all shades of present feeling. There are desperate Nazis and relatively good Germans who were fooled, and probably a great mass of Germans whose greatest fear is that they know little and care nothing about what went on in the realm of public life.

We say that any one of them is guilty because he did not succeed himself to end what was being done to Germany, and what Germany was doing to the world. And there is a certain amount of high moral truth in that. But how many years was it before one citizen of the state of Louisiana sacrificed himself to end the career of a half-moon-mouthed American dictator, Huey Long?

As victors in this war, as the representatives of world law and order responsible for the future of Germany, we have to render judgment upon the German people. But we have no simple black and white proposition. We have, rather, the most complicated task of human justice in all history.

Canadian Beef Refused: At least some partial proof that the great ambition of the American meat industry is primarily to increase its own war-time profits and not primarily to feed the American people is provided by testimony in the Canadian House of Commons.

Canada, at one time last fall, had more cattle ready for slaughter than could be accommodated either in shipping to Britain or in Canadian packing houses. Thereafter, the Canadian government asked American packers whose trucks they could not take some of the temporary Canadian surplus.

Representatives of the American meat industry in Washington hearings this week, charged the OPA with the philosophy that "profit is sin." That is not the philosophy of the OPA, or of the American consumer. Our whole system is the profit system.

What many Americans have agreed upon is this: That it is a sin to try to exact, in conditions of war, a profit far in excess of what would be earned in peacetime. It is a sin for any individual, or for any interest, to try to get abnormally fat profits from this war.

It was exactly to prevent this from happening that the country demanded and Congress enacted the OPA. Perhaps, in some few instances, the OPA has shaved the profit margin a little thin. In such cases, correction is just. But what we are seeing in the present hearings is an attempt to destroy the principle of price and profit control altogether.

If the American people have any sense they will once more resist the pressure groups and back the OPA.
