Lecture Topic Is Announced

Dr. R. B. Mahoney to Speak Monday at the Nathan Hale School. Dr. Robert B. Mahoney, director of Secondary Education in the public schools of Hartford, will be the speaker on Monday evening at the Nathan Hale Auditorium. He will discuss the results of his recent survey of the Y.W.C.A. in the city. Dr. Mahoney will discuss "Inter-cultural Education in Our Schools," thus carrying the theme of this year's forum one step farther. In 1943-44 Dr. Mahoney served as chairman of the Inter-towns Committee on Character Education, which prepared the noteworthy report "Carrying American Ideals Into Action." His talk will develop from this report ways in which the American school may contribute more effectively towards better understanding among the various races and nationalities.
