Father Dooley Pastor Of Hartford Church For 25 Years.

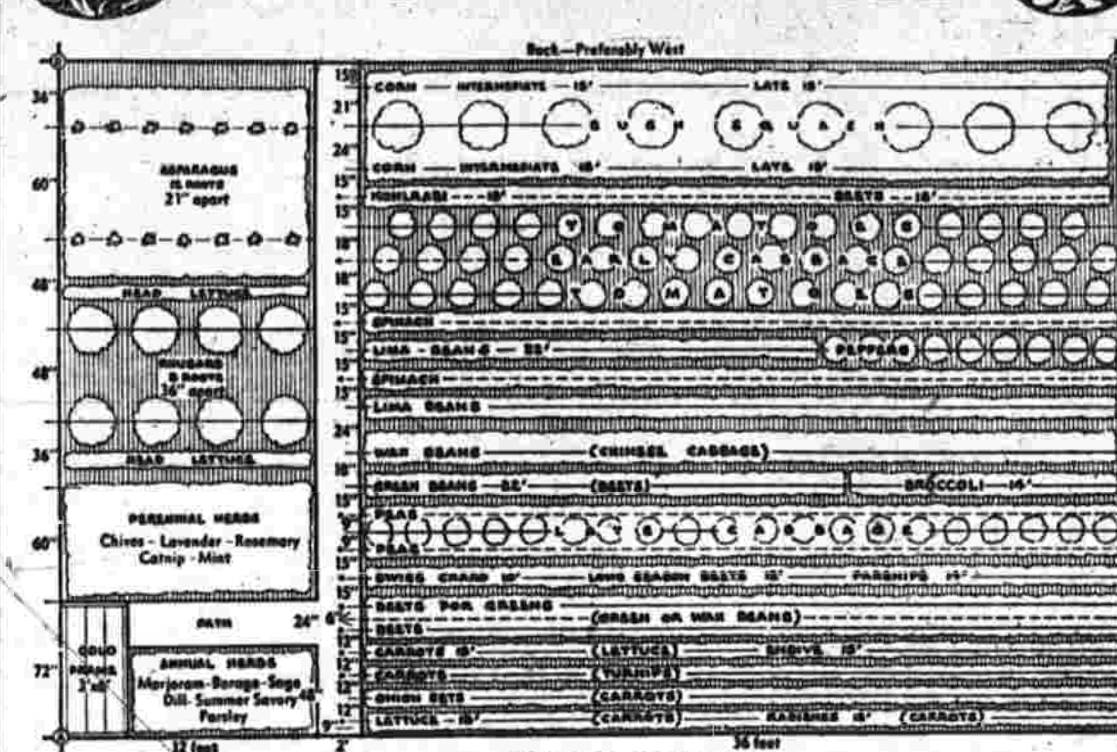

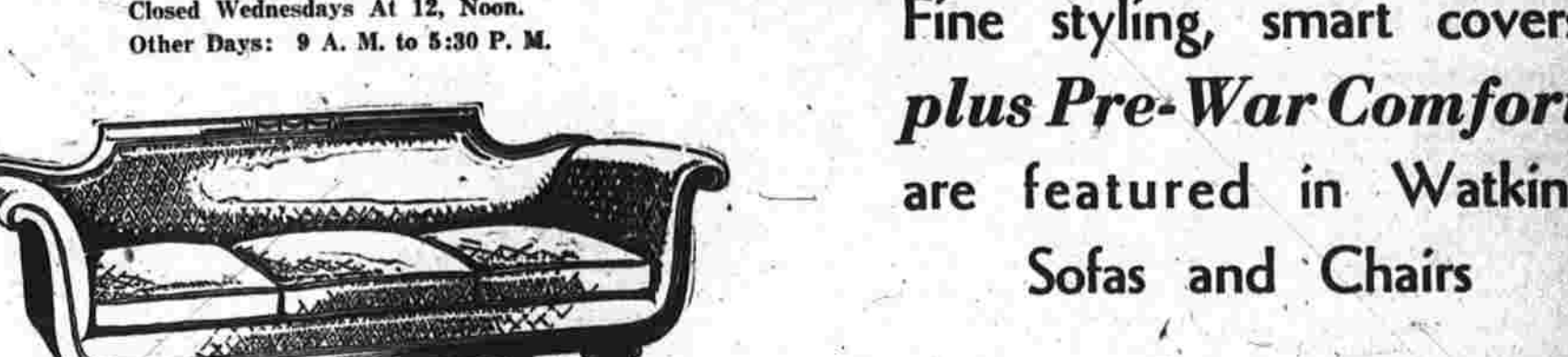

Our Armies Face East

Allied positions on the map of Germany today form the most dramatic pattern of the war to date.

Early last week, it was General Patton who was making the spectacular advances. By the time he had pushed he had, in the direction of Leipzig, reached a point only some 120 miles from the Russian front southeast of Berlin. Incidentally, he was less than 130 miles from Berlin itself.

At this point he paused, and the westward armies of the Allies took over. Three of these armies, the British Second, the American Fifth and the Canadian First, then swung into action, crossing the Weiser River line, and flinging a three arm front up to the north.

The British Second Army has gone straight up to the port of Bremen, taking the port geographical position on the new front. The American First is next in line, past Hanover, and the American First has had the least distance to travel to bring it into the position at the bottom of the new line.

This new line, formed by the progress of these three armies to the north, more or less hinges on the General Patton's previously established position. And at that hinge it is going to swing, not to the north, but to the west. What has been accomplished in the past few days is the establishment of a line which is almost the perfect parallel to the Russian lines east of Berlin.

Between the armies of the east and the armies of the west there now lies a German corridor approximately 100 miles long. The Allied line to the west is roughly 130 miles west of Berlin. The Russian line to the east is roughly 30 miles east of Berlin. Between these two lines lies all that remains of North Germany.

Future Allied progress, then, will no longer be to the north, but to the east. All told, four Allied armies are in position for their final drive to meet the Russians. What we are now going to see on the map, is the steady shrinking of this north German corridor, as if it were under two giant presses, which it is. The chief strategical worry is that the German elements now in this corridor, may try to escape toward the south, abandoning Berlin in order to make possible Hitler's fancied last stand around Berchtesgaden. Here the efficiency of Allied strategy lies with the Russian Armies now in Vienna, and the American Seventh, cutting toward Nuremberg. They are meeting the fiercest resistance, and face the toughest terrain.
