3rd Army Drives Toward Berchtesgaden: Germans Try to Drop Supplies in Berlin Churchill Hints Europe Peace Before Saturday

Has No Statement Upon Any Bid Now; Bernadotte Silent

Premier Answers Questions in Commons as Swedish Count Confers With Foreign Office Official After Flying from Copenhagen.

London, May 1.—(P)—Prime Minister Churchill hinted today that announcement of peace in Europe might come before Saturday, but told a packed House of Commons that he had no answered questions in the House as Swedish Count Folke Bernadotte conferred in Stockholm with Erik Boheman, secretary of state in the Swedish Foreign Office, after a quick flight from Copenhagen.

Refuses Information Bernadotte refused to tell newsmen whether he had brought a new message from Heinrich Himmler. There were no official statements in Stockholm, but such contact must likely have been established through the Swedish Foreign Office.

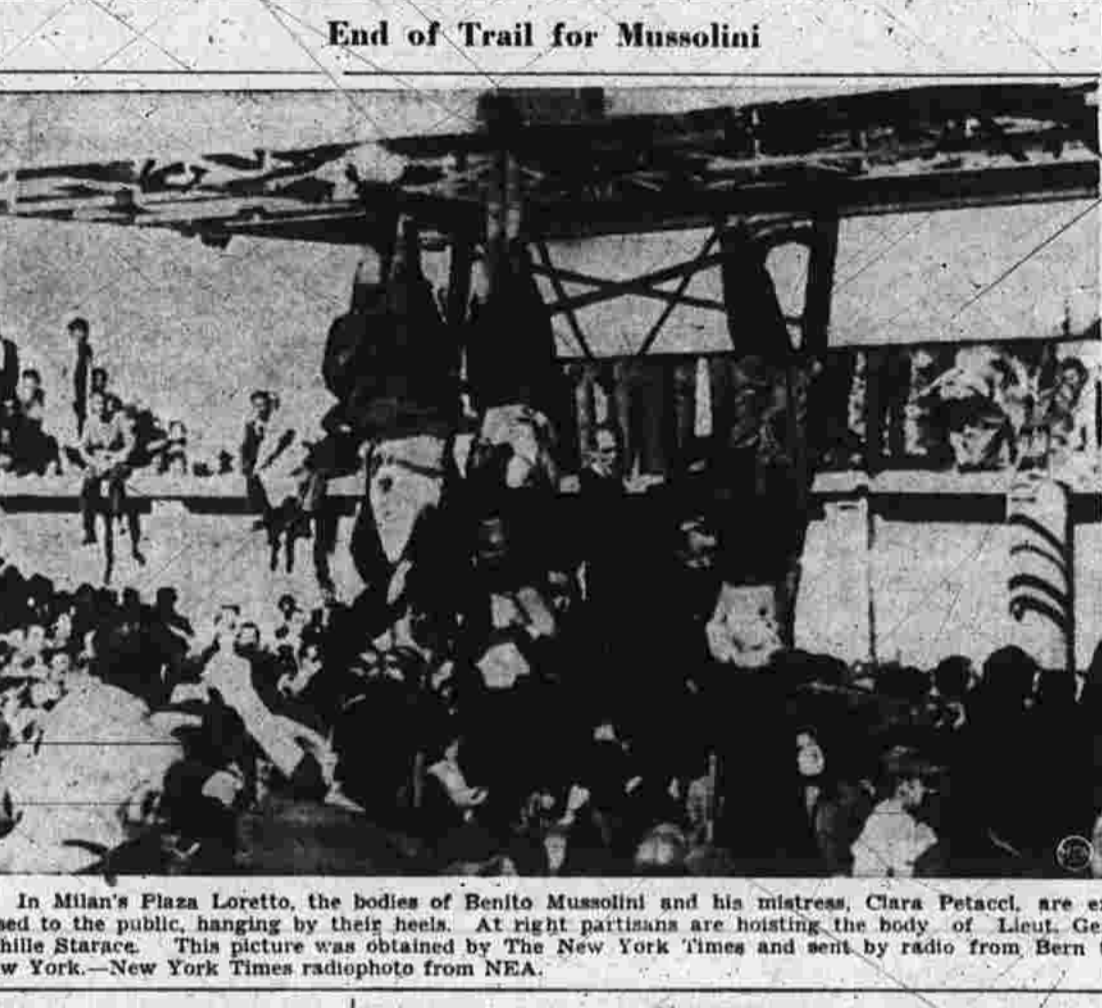
