Hamburg Surrenders to British Forces; Rush of Dead Nation Over Fallen Berlin

Thousands Shuffle To Give Up Arms In Ruined Capital

Russians Checking Story Hitler and Goebbels Commit Suicide; Eyewitness Report of Capitulation by Red Correspondent. Moscow, May 3.—(AP)—Thousands of dirty and unshaven Germans shuffled through the Brandenburg gate under the pillars of the triumphal arch today to lay down their arms where goosestepping Prussians formerly paraded their triumph. The hub of the dead nation lay over the smoking, brick-capital, interrupted only by occasional explosions in the ruins.



Signing Surrender Document in Italy

Moscow, May 3.—(AP)—The Russian government today announced that it had received a report from a Red correspondent in Berlin that Hitler and Goebbels had committed suicide. The report stated that the two leaders had taken cyanide pills in the Führerbunker in Berlin on the night of May 2.
