Accord Seen Near On Parley Change At San Francisco

Molotov Is Now Seeking Word from His Superior on Two Key Changes in Security Plan; Otherwise All Is In Agreement Now. San Francisco, May 5.—(AP)—Foreign Commissioner Molotov was believed seeking instructions from Premier Stalin today on two key changes in the Dumbarton Oaks world security plan. With these two exceptions—on provisions for reviewing international relations and on regional defense arrangements in the United States, Russia, China and Britain were reported to be in agreement on the plan.

Say Talks Underway Also for Capitulation Of Last Enemy Stands

Happy Danes Already Forming Framework Of a New Government. Stockholm, May 5.—(AP)—on receipt of the news of the German surrender, King Christian was reported to have ordered mobilization of the whole resistance movement, putting an estimated 200,000 men under arms in the capital alone. They appeared everywhere, carrying tommy guns and other arms, mostly of British and American manufacture.

Furious Land, Sea Fighting Near Okinawa

Guam, May 5.—(AP)—In one of the wildest battles of the Pacific war, Japanese held amphibious forces, the first major tanked counterattack of the Okinawa campaign, suicide boats, planes and pilot-guided flying bombs at miles south of Japan. Every attack was broken up, but the Japanese carried 20,000 men and others damaged. Hundreds of the 4,000 attacking Japanese soldiers were slaughtered in the best day of Jap killing since the Okinawa campaign began. 154 planes shot down and 15 explosive laden speed boats blown up.

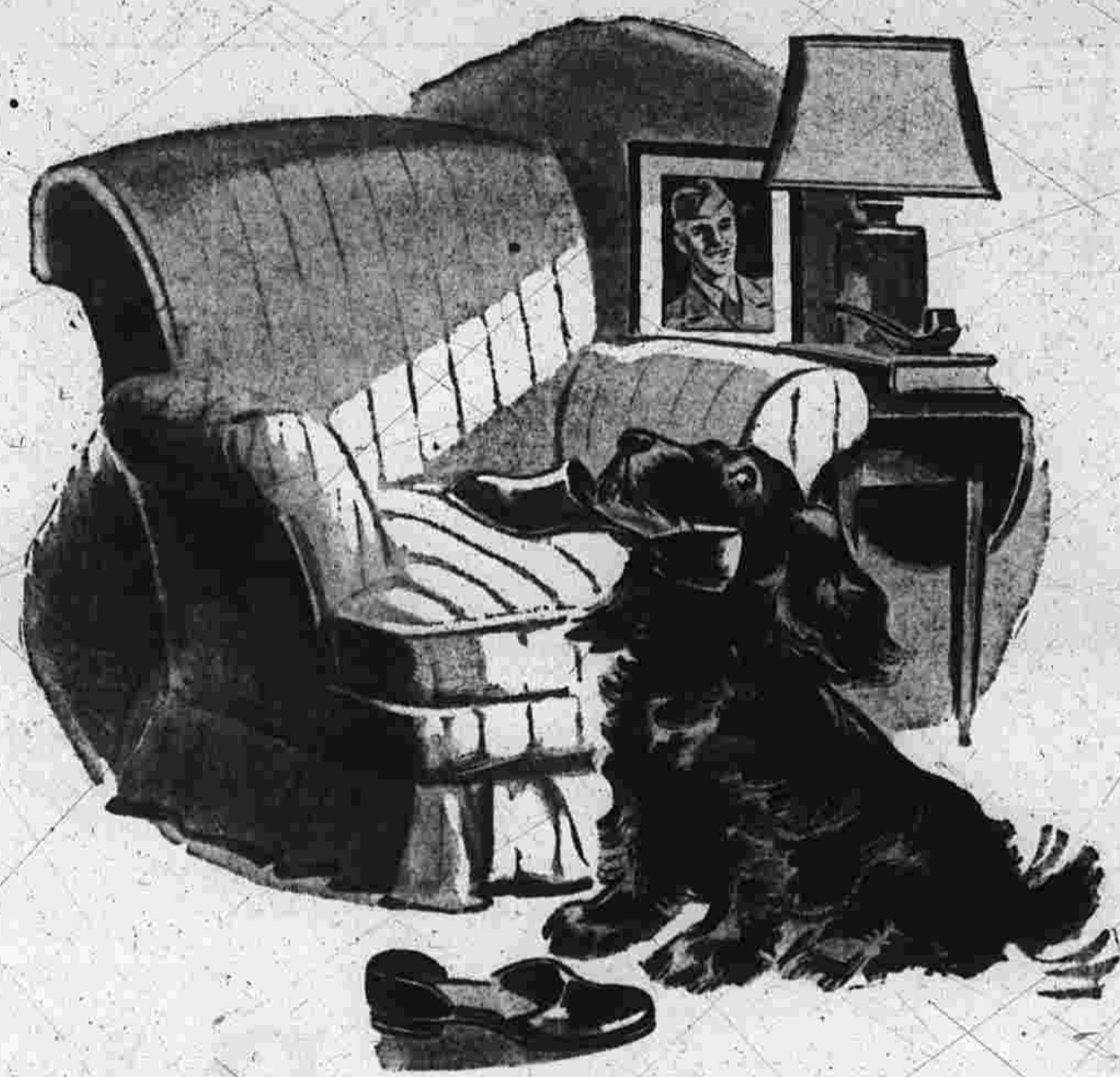




## Blessed is the Event of Victory!
