Three Beaches To Be Opened

Hammanasset, Rocky Neck, Sherwood Island To Be in Public Use.

Hartford, May 28.—(AP)—The State Park and Forest Commission announced today that three state bathing beaches at Hammanasset, Rocky Neck in East Lyme and Sherwood Island in Westport will be in public use this summer.

"We now feel certain that the three beaches will be available to the public for the warm weather season," George C. Walden, of Bridgeport, chairman of the commission, declared today. "Of course, we are handicapped by wartime shortages and wartime conditions all the pre-war services, but we'll be having parking and lifeguard facilities ready for the people."

Chairman Walden disclosed that Donald B. Alexander, administrative director of the commission, had filed a formal inquiry with the Army's First Service command in an effort to learn if the war-time beach has been thoroughly inspected and if the principal beach can be used. Only the Meigs point area is likely to be barred from the public.

The Hammanasset tract has been used since early in the war as a target area for the Army Air Corps. Fighter pilots in training used targets, mainly in the Meigs point area, for aerial machine gun practice, and thousands of bullet-nosed planes have been shot down and adjacent land. Army authorities say there is no danger from unexploded bombs, but the Park commission ruled against use of the tract because of possible danger to bathers' feet from the tiny sharp-pointed, rusted wreckage that litter the section. It will not be used until every bit of sand on the beach has been thoroughly inspected.

"There will be ample room on the available portion of the public beach to accommodate thousands of bathers daily. The Army has not formally cancelled its contract for the place, but has permitted states park work crews to begin repairs on state buildings, which were badly damaged in the hurricane, last fall and by mid-winter storms.

"Some of the repairs will be a make-shift type until more permanent improvements can be made," according to Walden, "but the main point is that we will be able to get the place in shape so

2,000,000 Tires Available in June

Washington, May 28.—(AP)—Two million passenger car tires—an increase of 500,000—will be available in June, but that amount still will fall short of meeting demands.

The increase in next month's ration quota will be possible, said OPA National Chief Max McCullough. He added, however, that the backlog of 300,000 applications for casing, low inventories and a seasonal increase in tire demands will make the quota impossible.

OPA estimates that a 2,000,000 allocation will have to be maintained several consecutive months before any new tires can be made available to "A" card drivers.
