Navy Plans To Release Older Men

About 30,000 May Be Let Out by December to Permit Induction of Younger Men.

Washington, July 21.—(AP)—About 30,000 older Navy officers and enlisted men may be released by December to permit the enlistment and induction of younger men.

Disclosing this yesterday, the navy said it is considering a point formula for release of older personnel. It adopted the plan would release 11,000 commissioned and warrant officers and 19,000 enlisted men by year's end.

No Demobilization Plan This would permit the voluntary enlistment and drafting of younger men qualified to meet future needs. The Navy emphasized that the formula under consideration will not be a mobilization measure. The navy's strength will not be reduced below the present authorized maximum of 3,588,000 which was reached June 30.

For this reason, the Navy said, the formula does not include such factors as dependency and combat status which might be included in a demobilization plan.

Oregon Blaze Still Roaring At High Rate

New Britain, July 21.—(AP)—A new department book of rules issued today by the British Fire Commission orders that drivers of fire apparatus "shall not exceed a speed of 25 miles an hour" and that on "approaching and passing red traffic lights and stop signs and in turning corners" the speed of all apparatus "shall be limited to 10 miles an hour."

Capricious Winds Join Widely Scattered Spot Fires; 46,000 Acres Hit in Biggest Blaze

Portland, Ore., July 21.—(AP)—Portland winds which joined widely scattered spot fires kept Oregon's 70-square-mile forest fire still roaring at high pitch today.

Fire fighters checked the blaze on one sector and started to mop their brows, only to find flaming embers blown in another direction. The huge Wilson river blaze carried across 10,000 more acres in 40 hours, blackening more than 46,000 acres.

To the north, the Salmonberry fire crossed a dozen new sections under a heavy layer of smoke.

Crews headed for the Tillamook-Washington county line, spot fires from both blazes threatened to meet and fire crews redoubled their efforts.

Forestry officials shook their heads at a weather bureau bulletin.

Madrid, July 21.—(AP)—Generalissimo Francisco Franco completed the sale of office of his new cabinet today and the Falangist newspaper Arriba declared that the new government would continue the Falangist ideal.

The newspaper's editorial said the long-expected cabinet shake-up, which placed in office five men considered monarchist sympathizers, was a "new step" in the life of the Franco's party, the only one in Spain.

Washington, July 21.—(AP)—More workers doing heavy manual labor may get extra food rations already granted to coal and oil miners and a few others.

The OPA said today it has under consideration recommendations to provide supplementary points for longshoremen, stevedores, foundrymen and those engaged in strenuous construction work.

These recommendations were made by the National Research council, which had urged the extra rations and sugar rationing for coal and oil miners were awarded yesterday by the OPA.

Yest Program Expanded Expanding a test program in effect since July 1 in Los Angeles and San Francisco areas, OPA announced today that beginning the first week of August coal and oil miners elsewhere will be eligible for additional ration allowances.

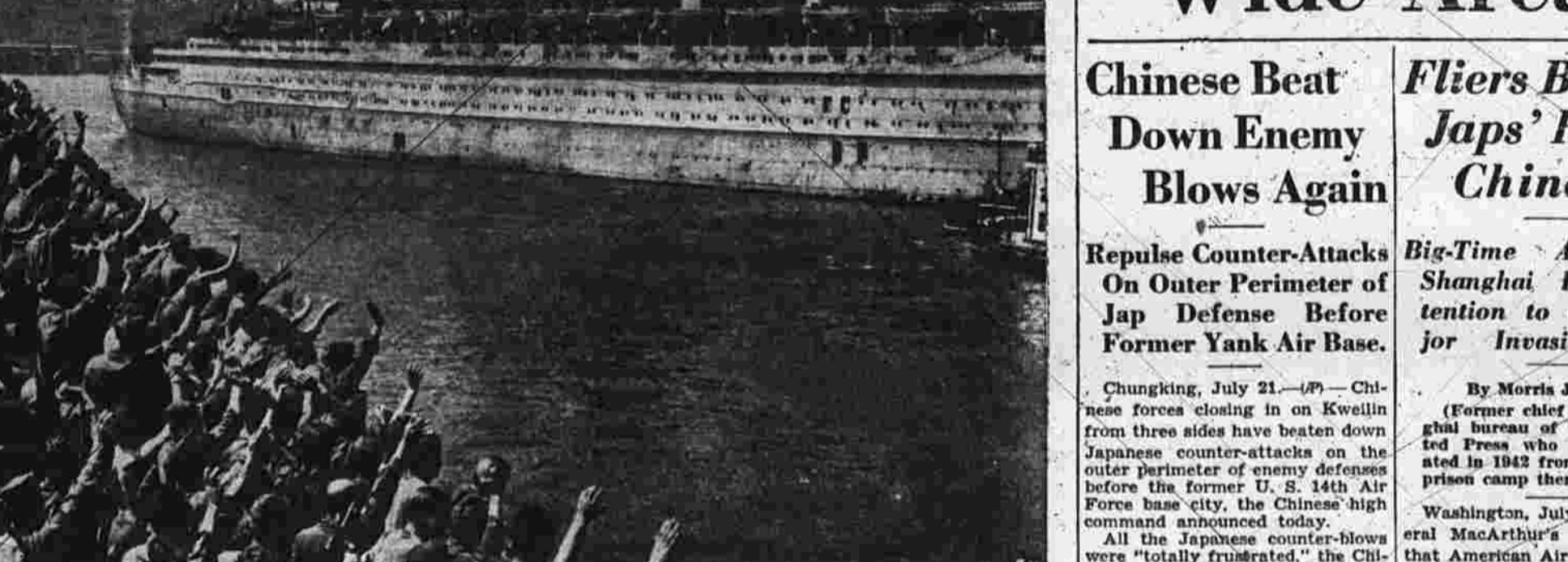
