General Motors Books
An important issue in the
General Motors strike—and one
which has not yet been resolved—is
to make it the prime issue of the
entire strike—the union's demand
that the company produce its own
secret records of costs and profits.
If the company would do this, the
union has frequently said, it
would retreat from its 30 per cent
demand, and it would accept
whatever increase the company's
actual cost and profit figures
showed to be possible. What
margin of profit the union did not
have the company it has not
said.

The Nuremberg Precedent
When defense counsel for the
German war criminals on trial in
Nuremberg moved for dismissal
of the trial, on the ground that
the international tribunal was
jurisdictionless, how many business-
men would still be so naive as to
claim that the trial was a
violation of international law?
This trial, in fact, and the inter-
national agreement which autho-
rized it, are an attempt to cre-
ate international law which did
not exist before. That happens to
be the most important thing
about the trial—more important
even than the process of bringing
these specific German leaders to
justice. Here the civilized world
is trying to establish new inter-
national law which says that
those who start wars of aggression
are personally guilty of crime. This
new international law, if success-
fully established, would be the
basis for the new world order.
If this new precedent can be estab-
lished, it will become the legal
counterpart of the United Nations
Organization, prescribing what is
to be done with those who try to
start new wars.
