Ten-Year-Old Reds Kidnapped to Slave In Nazi Factories

Part of Campaign of Extermination Through Work; Dodd Offers Germans' Own Records Of Mass Enslavement Of Conquered Peoples

Nuernberg, Dec. 11.—(AP)—Ten-year-old Russian children were kidnapped for slavery in German war factories as part of the Nazi campaign of "extermination through work," according to evidence submitted today at the war crimes trial of 21 of Hitler's top leaders.

Approved by Rosenberg, the festivity came from Col. Bernard Bernstein, director of the Division of German Affairs, U. S. Army, who said that the records were approved by Alfred Rosenberg, the party's official spokesman.

The Nazi leaders on trial before the International Military Tribunal earlier in the day's session disclosed that plans to use the children of German war factories as a source of labor were approved by the Gestapo to build up Germany's war production and set Germany on the road to aggression and ruin.
