Commandos marched Kogi on the double out of the prison and down a small road toward the sea. It led past a willow-bordered cemetery where were buried many Stanley camp internees who died of starvation.

When Kogi arrived at the prison his hands were tied behind him. He was dressed in a clean but heavy yellow-green officer's uniform, and he methodically and identically carried out the orders of the British Army. He was the only official photograph at the scene of his crime. Here, on October 19, 1942, that 33 of 41 Allied prisoners were condemned to death in bloody combat.

Kogi stands no more than 5 feet tall. He is a thin, dark-skinned man with a serious expression. He is dressed in a clean but heavy yellow-green officer's uniform, and he methodically and identically carried out the orders of the British Army. He was the only official photograph at the scene of his crime. Here, on October 19, 1942, that 33 of 41 Allied prisoners were condemned to death in bloody combat.

Only one man in the small group of spectators felt any pity for the man who had been sentenced to death. He was George Wood Clifton, Hong Kong, who had spent three and one-half years in Stanley prison since the Japanese invasion of the island.

But seeing Kogi stand there alone and powerless in the war-torn night, Clifton felt no remorse, only an overwhelming sense of sadness. He said, "I thought I wish I hadn't come."
