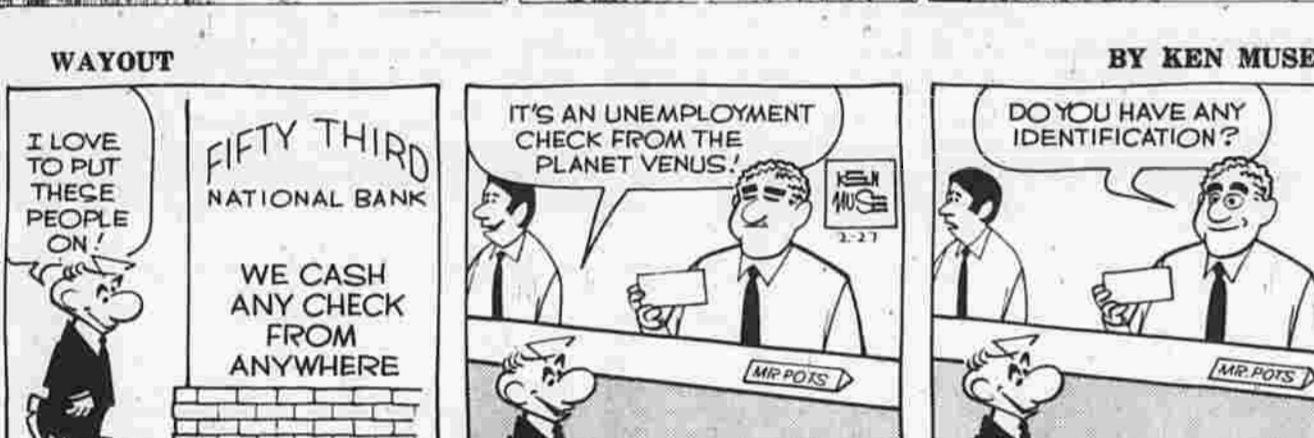

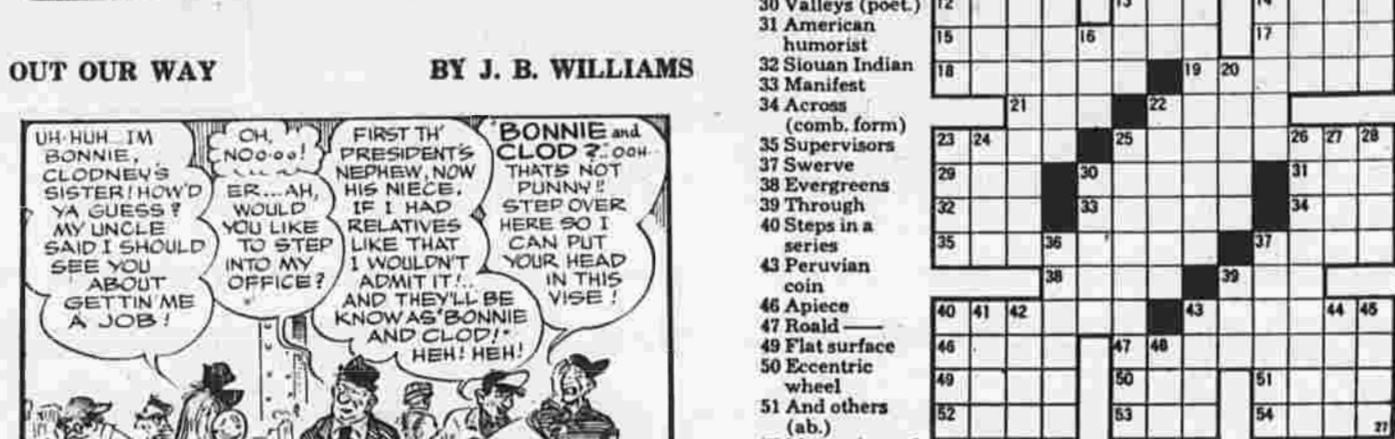

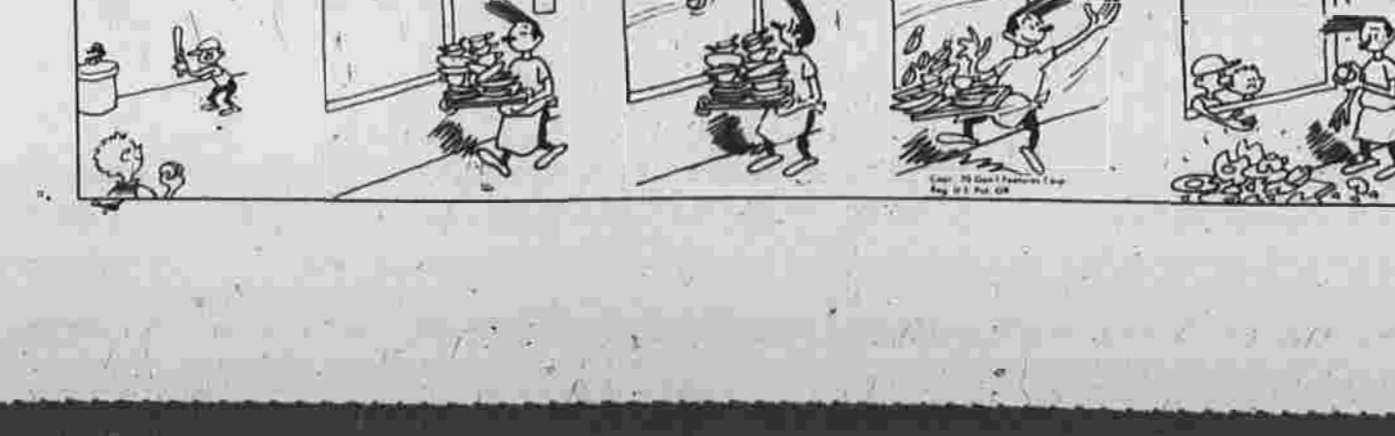

Eastern Bus Line Sues East Hartford

George A. Negro, president of Eastern Bus Line, Inc. of 49 Brainard Pl., Manchester, has brought a \$1 million breach of contract suit against the East Hartford Board of Education and against Dr. Eugene A. Diggs, East Hartford superintendent of schools.

The suit results from the cancellation of Negro's contract by the East Hartford Board of Education last Dec. 18.

The board contended that the bus company did not have adequate insurance to cover the 4,350 school students who rode Eastern buses, as well as other damages.

In his suit, Negro claims that he was not given the five-day notice of cancellation required in the contract, and he also claims that he was not notified that his company did not have sufficient insurance.

The school board said Negro had \$25,000 per person, \$200,000 per accident, and \$10,000,000 per property damage.

In a written statement issued some time ago Negro commented on the insurance matter.

"Now, as to the insurance coverage," the Eastern Bus Line, Inc., of George A. Negro, Bus Co., Inc., and Silver Lane Bus Co., Inc. all were put under a single policy in 1968.

The suit is returnable in Hartford Superior Court Tuesday.

Mr. Negro was not advised that the excess insurance was added on Dec. 24. At that time the insurance carrier indicated that if there had been accidents, they would have been covered, since notice had not been given by the company.

Town Opens Sweep Bids

There were three bidders this morning to provide street and parking lot sweeping services for the town's spring cleaning.

Two of the bidders did not supply either a bid bond or certified check with the bid, which might disqualify them, said some bidders repeatedly failed to appear on schedule.

Dandolfo Sweeper Service of East Canaan, which supplied a bid for \$70,000, was the lowest bidder.

The contract called for a minimum of \$250,000 liability, \$200,000 per accident, and \$10,000,000 per property damage.

The company did bid on street sweeping work for \$220 for the initial sweeping for five days and \$180 per month for three months.

Hartford Sweeping Service offered two 1968 Volkswagens, four wheel drive, twin engines, and four wheel drive, capacities at \$180 per month, \$900 per week, and \$3,600 per month.

The company would charge \$475 for one to two days of initial parking lot sweeping and \$100 per month for services.

For the month of services, part of one day a month, it offered two 1968 Vac-All catch basin cleaners with 16 cubic yard capacities at \$230 per day, \$1,150 per month and \$4,600 per month.

Eastern Equipment Sales Inc. of Rocky Hill sent in a notice that, although the company had expressed interest, it was not bidding.

The chairman of the budget committee, Mrs. Marie Herbst, said her committee is working on next year's budget and the urgent need for considering and resolving them.

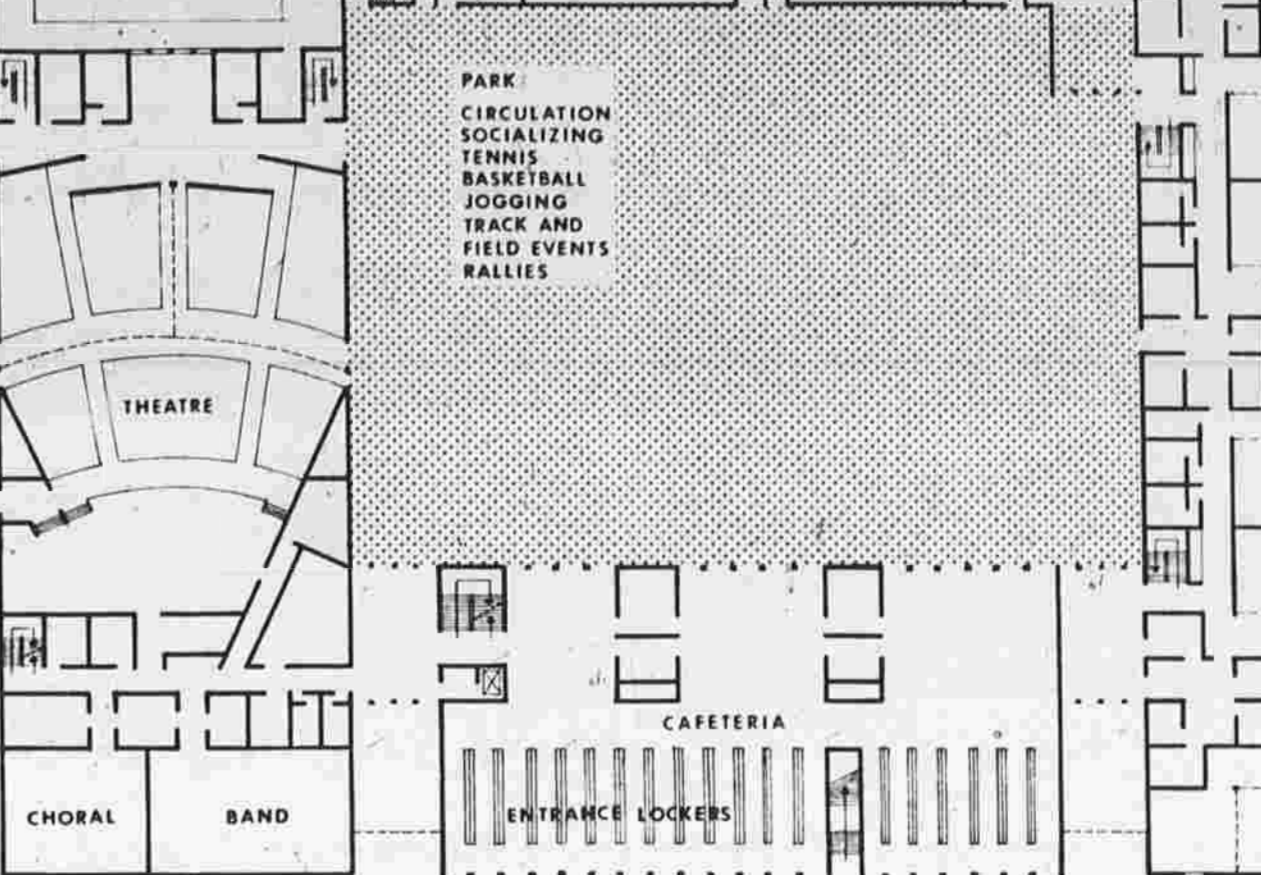
