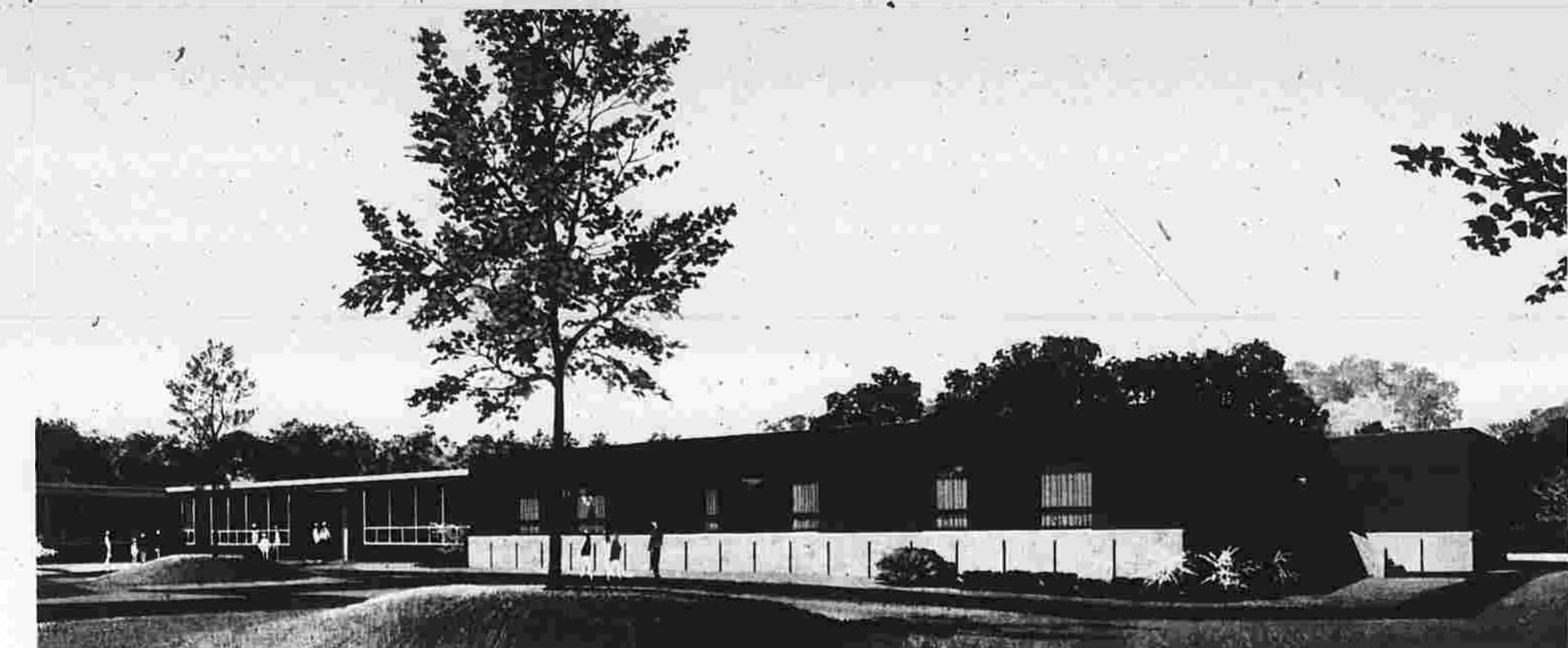

### Keeney St. School: Six-Room Addition

This proposed addition to the Keeney St. School, shown here in an artist's rendering, would house six additional classroom spaces. The new structure would cost \$324,000 of the total \$1,996 million school bond issue. The bond issue which would provide for additions to Robertson and Nathan Hale Schools as well as Keeney St., will be on the Nov. 3 ballot. As in the plans for the other two schools, the class space in the new Keeney St. addition would be designed to utilize a modern concept of space by folding noise-resistant partitions would allow

for both individual classrooms and the use of as many as three class areas at once for such things as team teaching or use of audio-visual aids. The new structure would extend southward from the east wing of the existing building. Also included in the Keeney St. plans are renovations which would call for enlarging the existing cafeteria and conversion of the existing library into a larger media center where various types of educational aids would be located. The expansion of the library area would involve taking over the space of what is now a classroom.

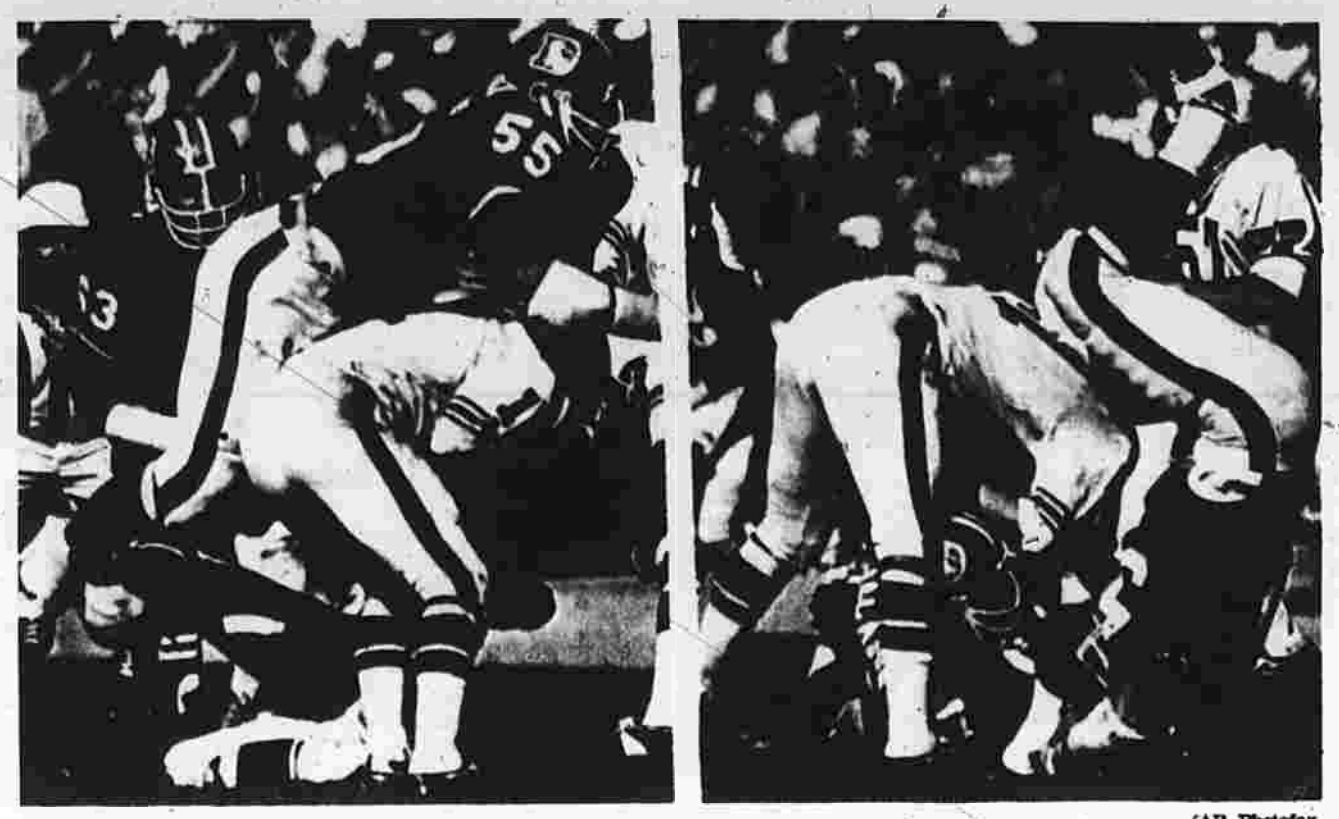
