NBA to Adopt Uniform Plan

Milwaukee, Sept. 16 (AP)—The National Basketball Association decided yesterday to sweep out the coloration of scoring methods used in the states affiliated with the NBA and adopt a uniform plan.

Some 13 plans now are in use. The NBA's new scoring method, the one used in Minnesota, would replace them all, beginning Jan. 1, 1954.

The plan known as the "ten-point" works like this: The judges and referees give 10 points to the winner of a round, the loser can receive any number of points up to nine. For instance, in a one-sided fight, the winner will get 10 points and the loser as few as three or four.
