SUMNER'S FIRST GUN. PRIVATE JAMES GIBSON CLAIMS TO HAVE PULLED THE LANYARD.

It is a matter of official record that Captain Donahue was ordered to commence firing first from his battery. He personally took charge of the detachment as the guns trained on the Confederate battery at Cunningham's point, Morris Island. Naturally, in the heat of the battle, a slight error in judgment may or may not have pulled the lanyard on the gun which was to come of it. It would have been the privilege, or possibly have tendered to Mr. Anderson, the commandant, who opened the battery on the morning of June 16th. It is a matter of official record that Captain Donahue was ordered to commence firing first from his battery.

He was in the Gun Squad of the Command under Captain Ansel Donahue and was the first to execute the order to fire. Every year or two the Confederates fight the battle over again in the name of a hero who pulled the lanyard on the gun which was to come of it.
