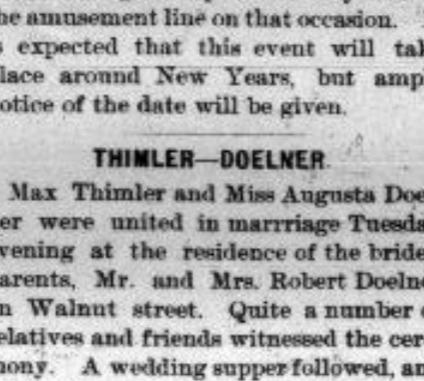

FOR THE HOUSEWIFE. A banana, raw, is not easily digested, but if cooked, but slightly can be eaten by a person who could not possibly digest a raw one. When there is a fall, as it were, in our smaller fruits, one can always get bananas, which may be fried, baked or served with hot cream. Peel the bananas, cut it into very thin slices with a silver knife, put these in bottom of bowl, and pour over the boiling oatmeal, farina or wheat granules; serve with sugar and cream.

FOR THE HOUSEWIFE. A quart of buttermilk, a teaspoonful of salt, four table-spoons of water, one egg, one tablespoonful of soda or saleratus. Beat the egg, add to it the buttermilk; add the salt and mix well. Dissolve the soda or saleratus in two table-spoons of boiling water, then stir it into the buttermilk. Now add gradually the flour, stirring all the while, until you have a batter that will pour smoothly from a spoon. Give a good beating, and bake quickly on a hot griddle. —[New York World.]

SMOTHERED CHICKEN. Cut open the back as for broiled chicken, and salt well, several hours before cooking. When ready to cook wipe off salt, place in a pot, broast down. Add a spoon of lard, and season with plenty of pepper and a little salt. Barely cover with water and let boil until perfectly tender. Then pour off all parts of the chicken, pour in all the liquor from the pot and put in the oven.
