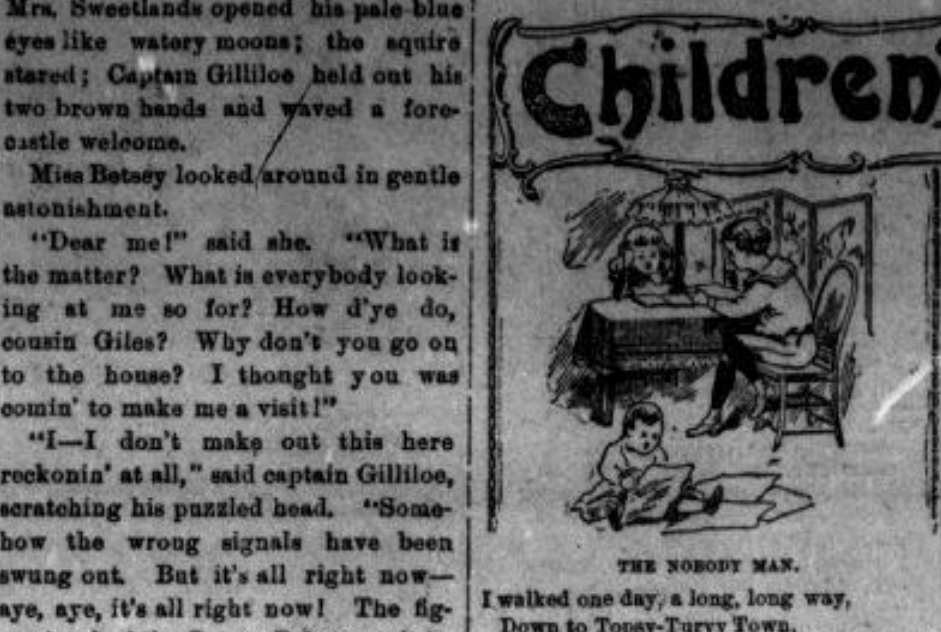

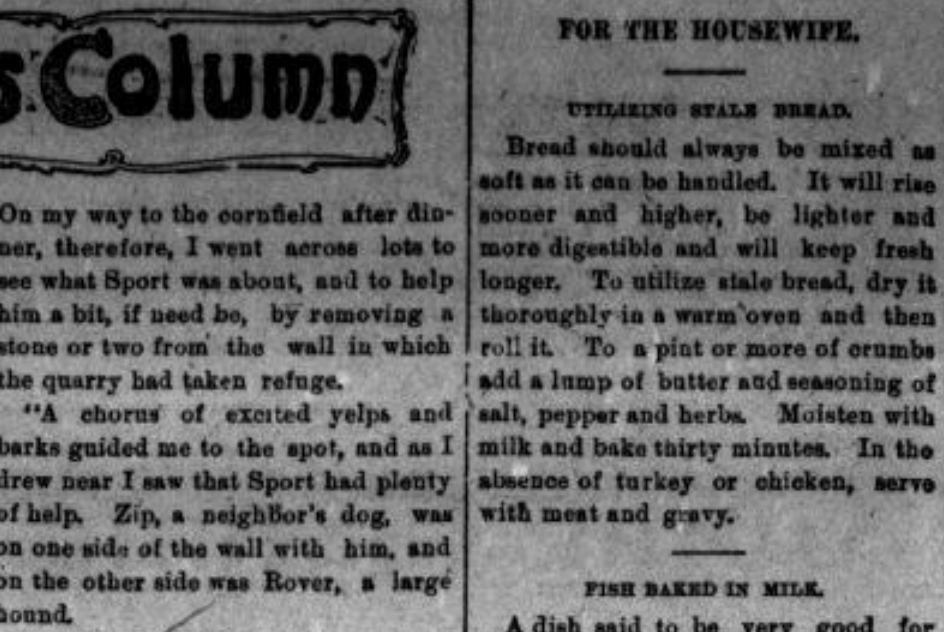

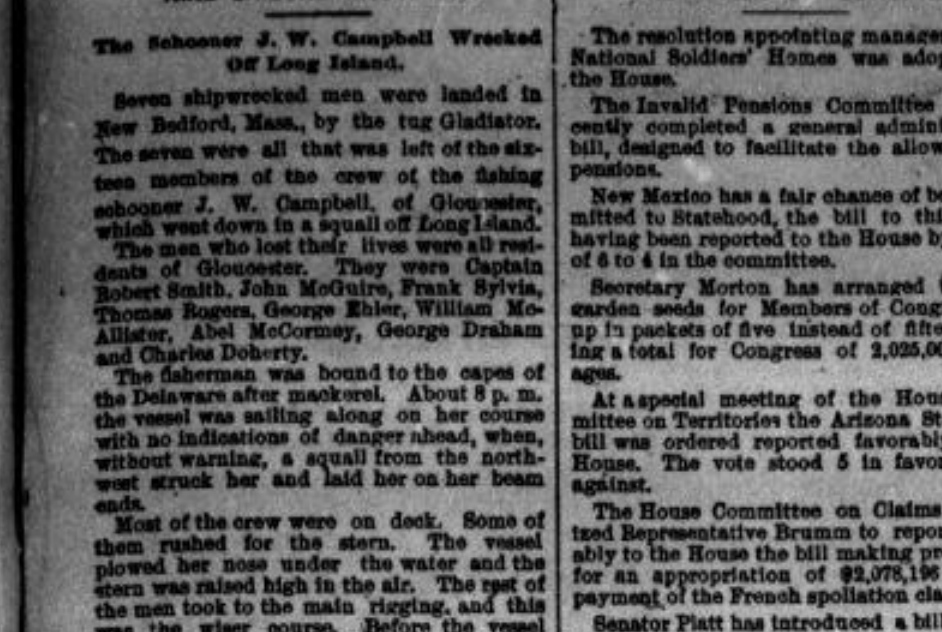

SOLDIERS SUCUMBING TO HEAT.
