HELPS FOR HOUSEWIVES. White lace curtains very often turn a sickly, starchy shade after they have been laundered. To prevent this, prepare the boiling starch in the usual manner. In a little clear water put a tablespoonful of yellow ochre, and add a pinch of soda. Add the ochre to the starch and mix well. Stretch the curtains in the usual way, and the suggestion of ochre will be sufficient to color the white to a healthy tint.

How to Iron Napkins. Napkins should be pressed, not ironed, as a time, smoothly, and ironed all over, then folded and ironed into whatever size is desired. No time is saved by ironing napkins doubled before first ironing them single over, if the primary consideration be a glossy, rich appearance. Damask requires a great deal of ironing to bring out its beauty. If you have napkins of heavy or thin linen look its very best should iron it until not a particle of dampness can be detected. Damask which the iron has often disappointed when unfolded, because linen holds dampness a long time and creases easily when not thoroughly dry.

"Poverty Luckless." Poverty is the economical feast which groups of people give from time to time. A company of eight women have found it possible to give in turn simple and appetizing luncheons to a large number for the sum of two dollars. A little discretion in marketing and a little care in the selection of the little card that a simple dish is perfectly cooked and served in plain dishes have proved gastronomic successes as well as pleasant occasions of friendly intercourse. One of the hostesses says that until she had looked into it, it is not understood how much the non-essentials of a luncheon cost - the salted almonds and bonbons and various similar trifles when ordered carelessly from a caterer. For example, most grocers sell the ordinary almonds shelled at about thirty-five cents a pound. Half a pound salted at home is worth an advance for a luncheon of eight, and the cost is eighteen cents, the few drops of oil and the pinch of salt costing little to the hostess. The cost of the flowers was a serious one with the poverty lunched hostesses, but it was solved by choosing Japanese and other flowers, which are very little for one occasion. The luncheons served consisted of four courses - bonillon, cold broth, or something similar, with a meat, vegetable, and dessert course. - New York Post.

A Lesson in Boiling. Sally Joy White lays down these rules for boiling in "Cooking for Girls" in the Woman's Home Companion. "For all green vegetables use soft water, and use a little salt. Cook rapidly until soft. The time will depend upon the age or the freshness of the vegetable. Wash green peas, shell beans, green peas, celery and spinach use as little water as possible, and let it boil away, leaving just enough to moisten, and thus to save all the desirable soluble matter. Let it be drawn out. Cook cabbage and cauliflower uncovered, in a large kettle of rapidly boiling water, salted, and with a teaspoonful of soda. Let the water boil away and change the water twice. All other cook in water enough to cover, and drain it off after cooking. Green peas and cauliflower should be pressed in a cloth or strainer, and well drained. Many who attempt to cook are apt to forget that there is a wide distinction between 'boiled water' and 'boiling water,' and that the freshness is lost by long boiling, so that the sooner the vegetables are cooked, the better the boiling point the more satisfactory the cooking will be. If water stands after boiling it loses its vitality, and is not so good for cooking as the water which is fresh from the tap. It is why tea and coffee are so frequently flat and lifeless, without sparkle or vigor; not because the leaves of the berries are not fresh, but because they are improperly made with 'boiled water' instead of freshly 'boiling water.'"
